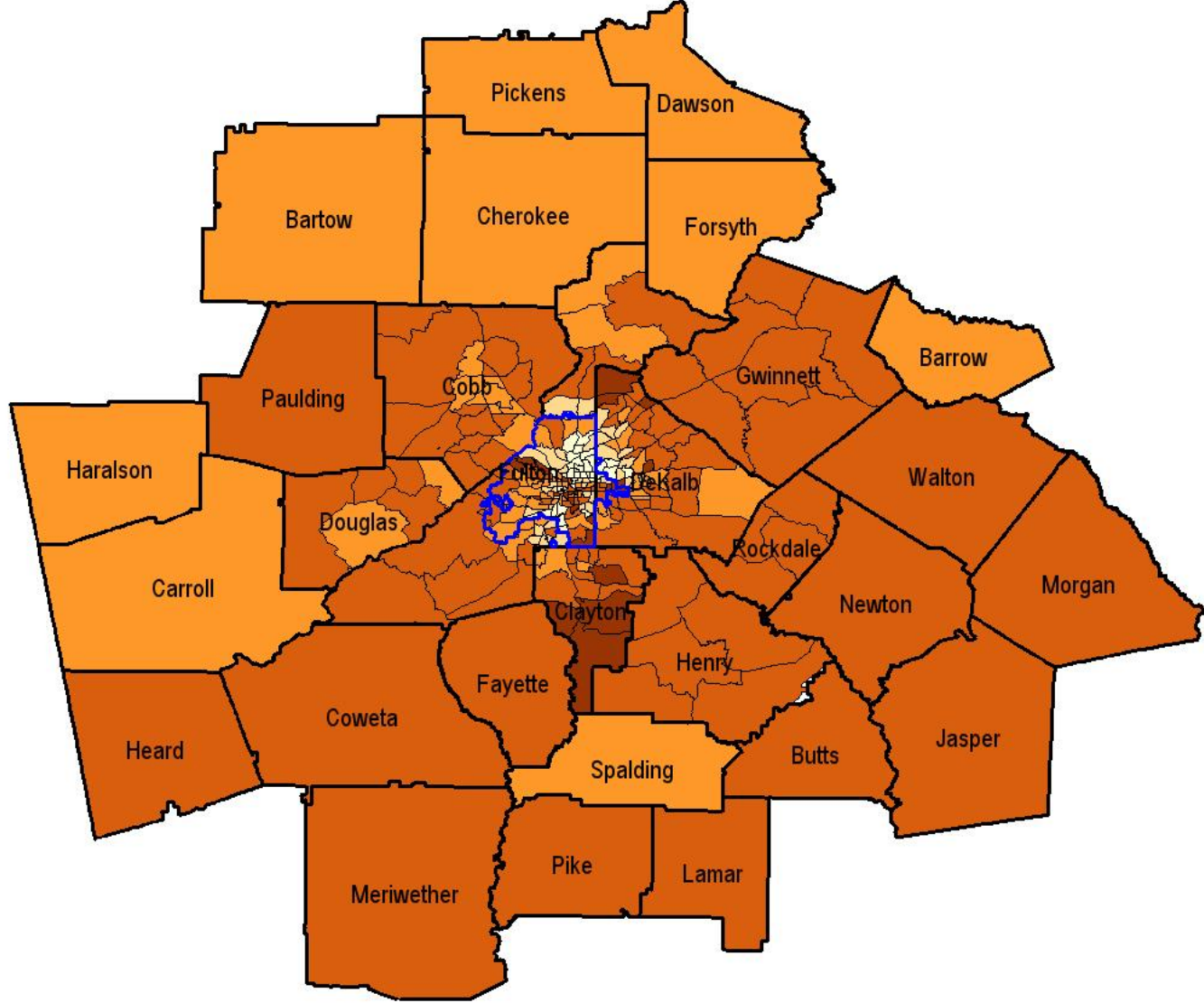

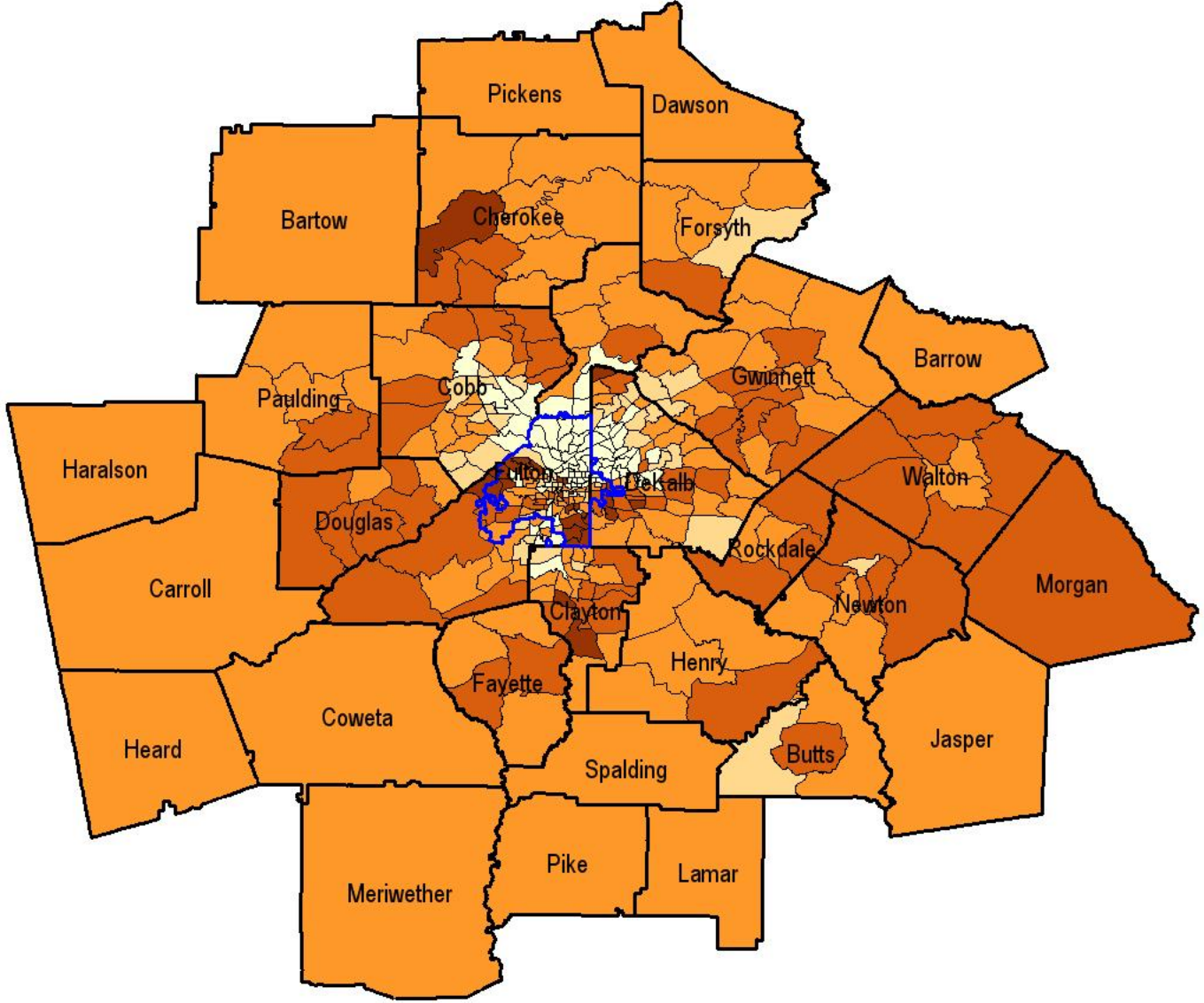


% Population of Age 0-17 1970

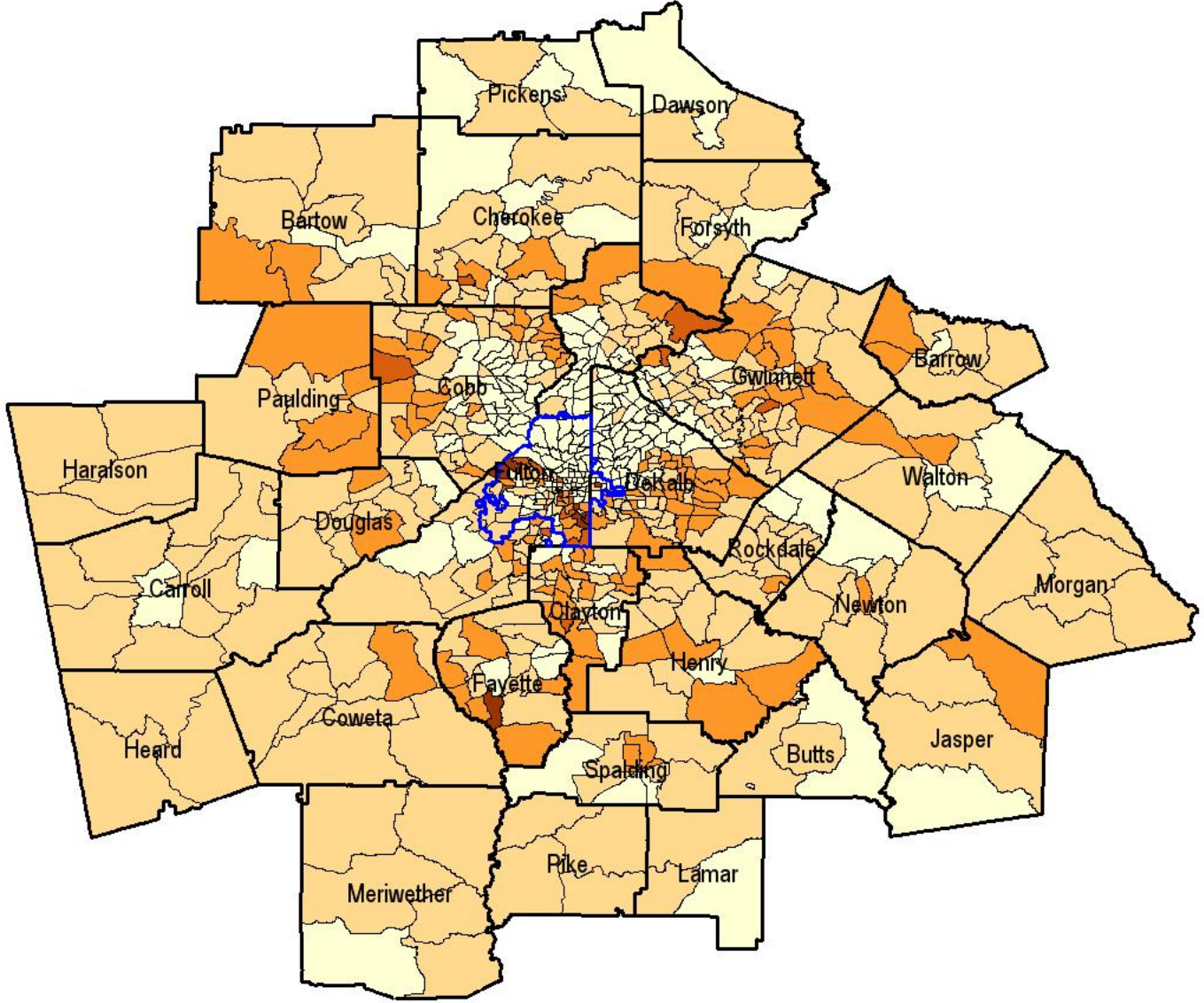


% Population of Age 0-17 1980

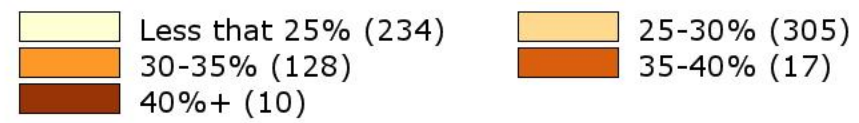

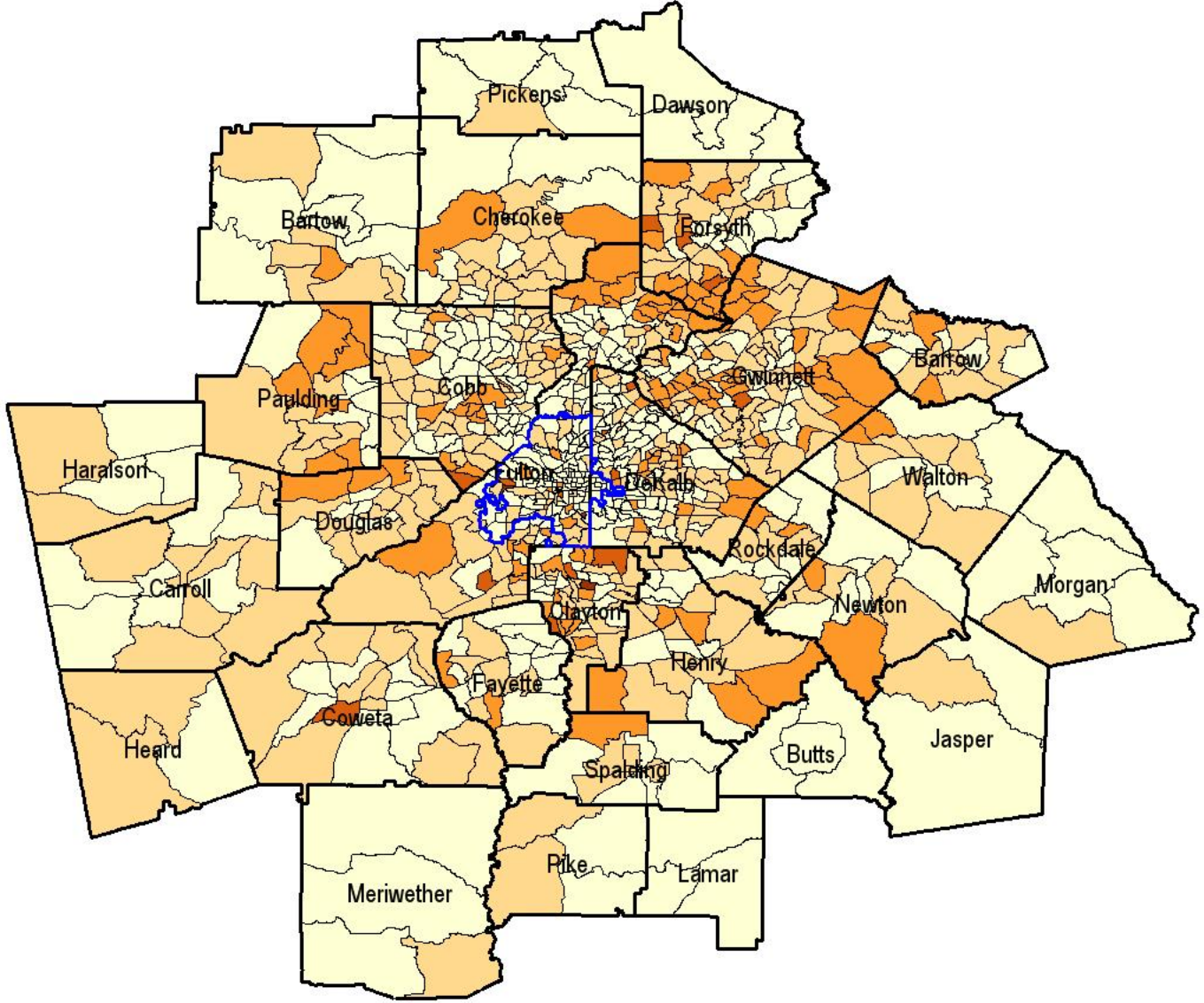


% Population of Age 0-17 2000

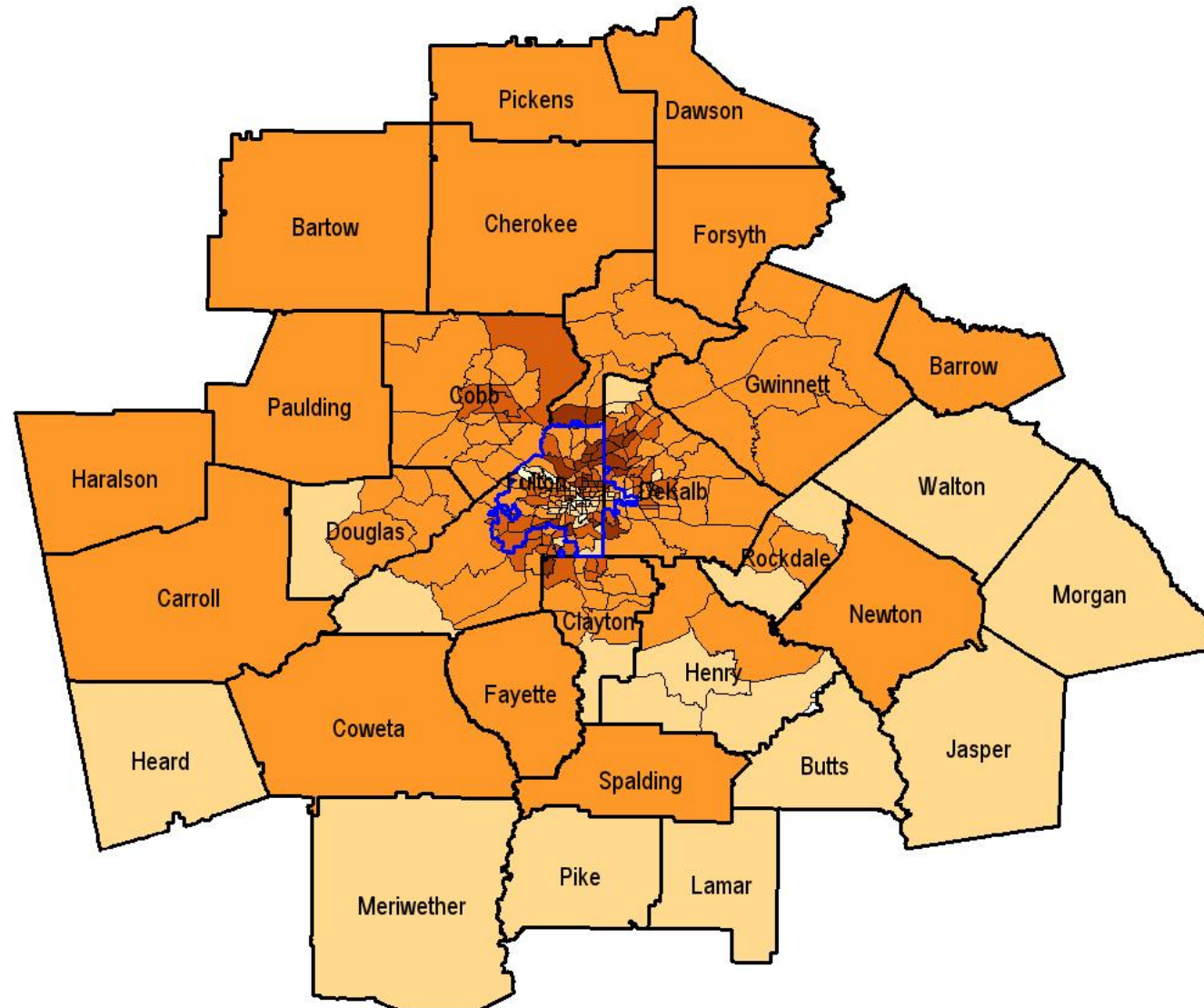


% Population of Age 0-17 2015

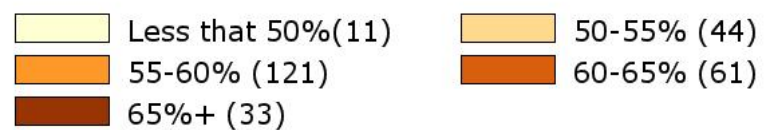

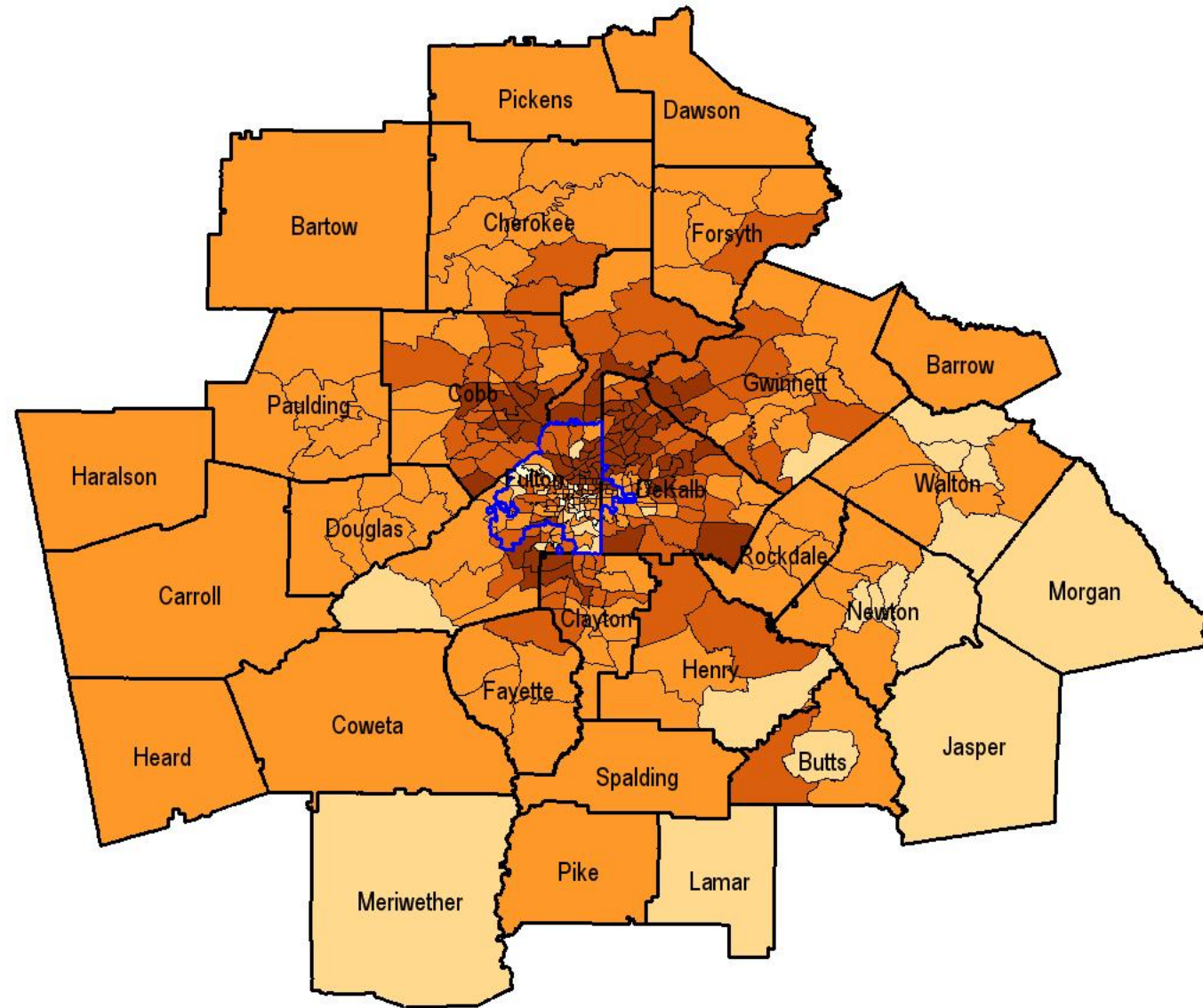


% Population of Age 18-64 1970

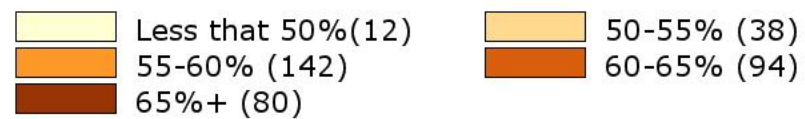

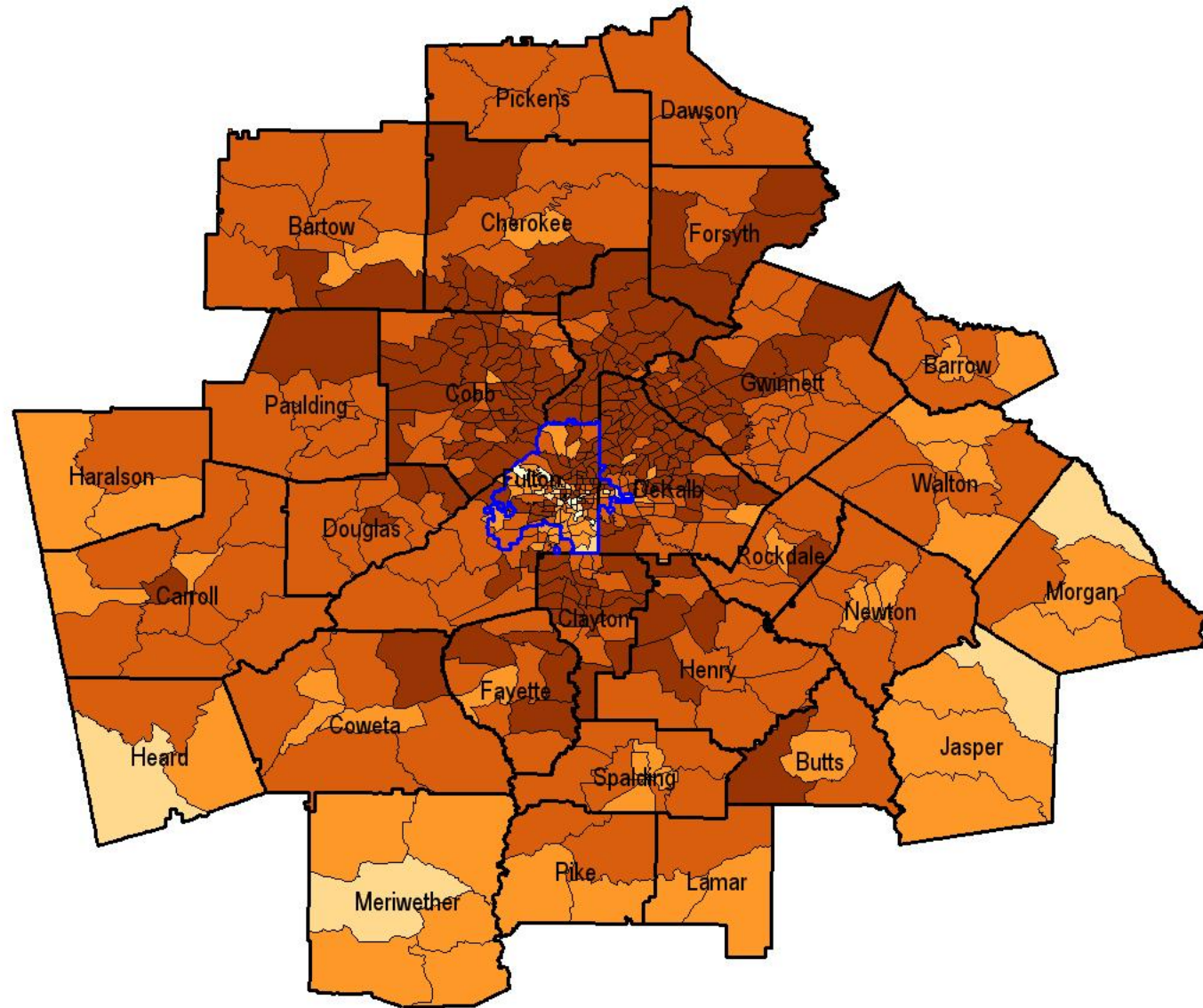


% Population of Age 18-64 1980

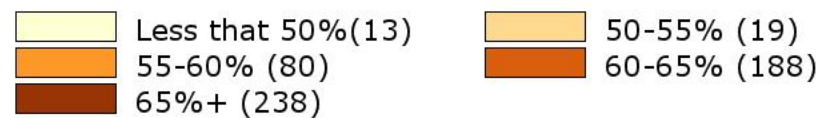

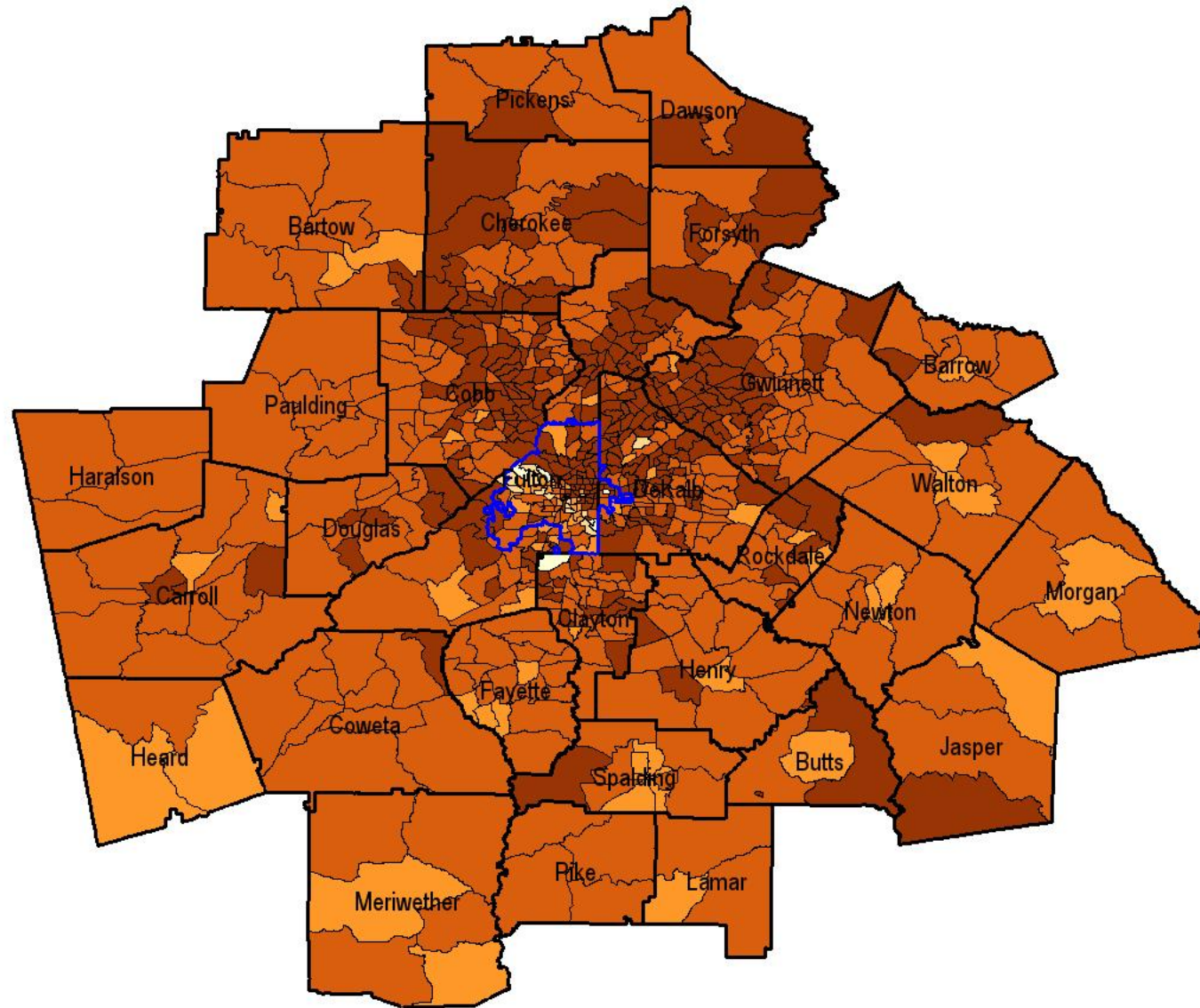


% Population of Age 18-64 1990

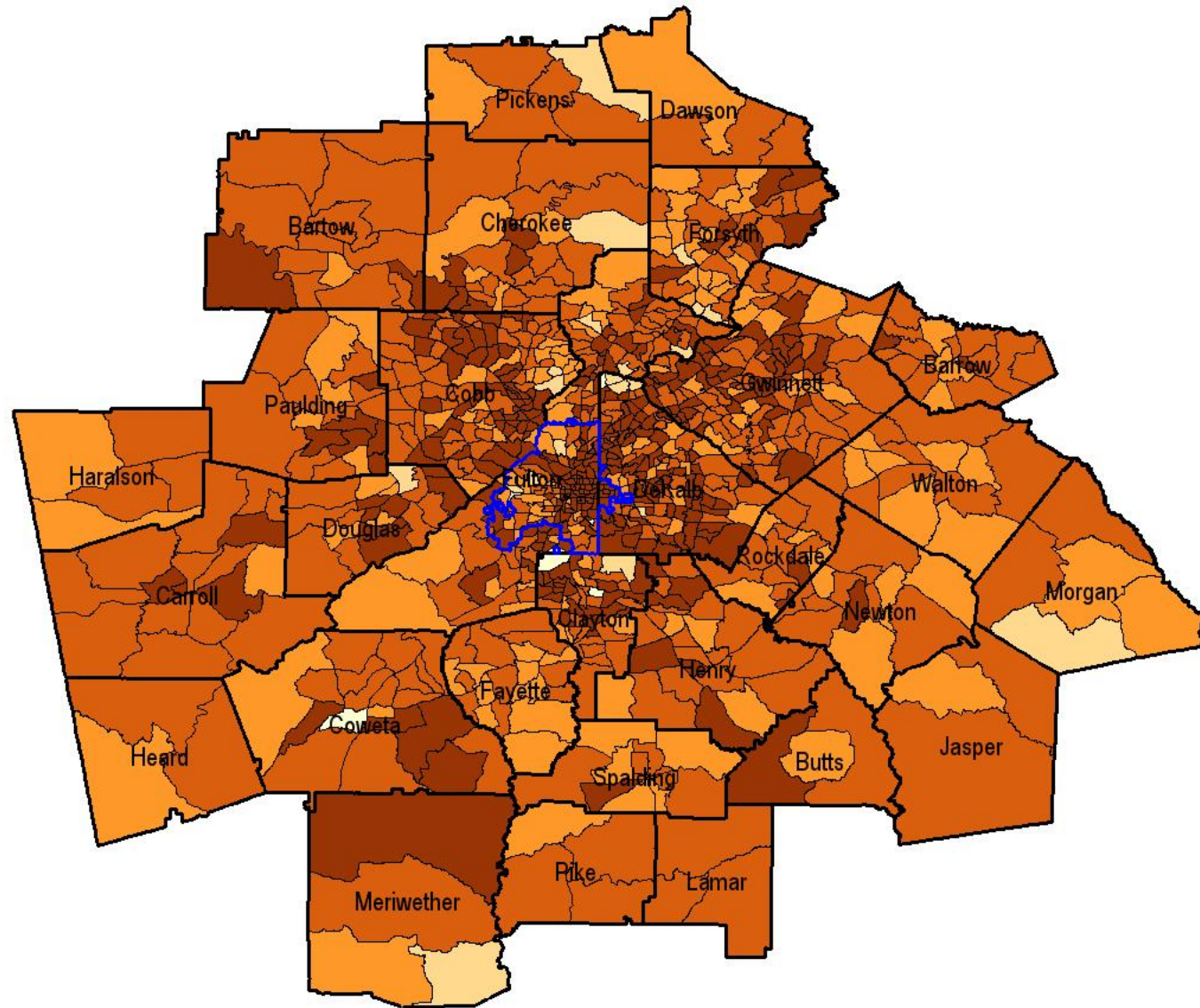


% Population of Age 18-64 2000

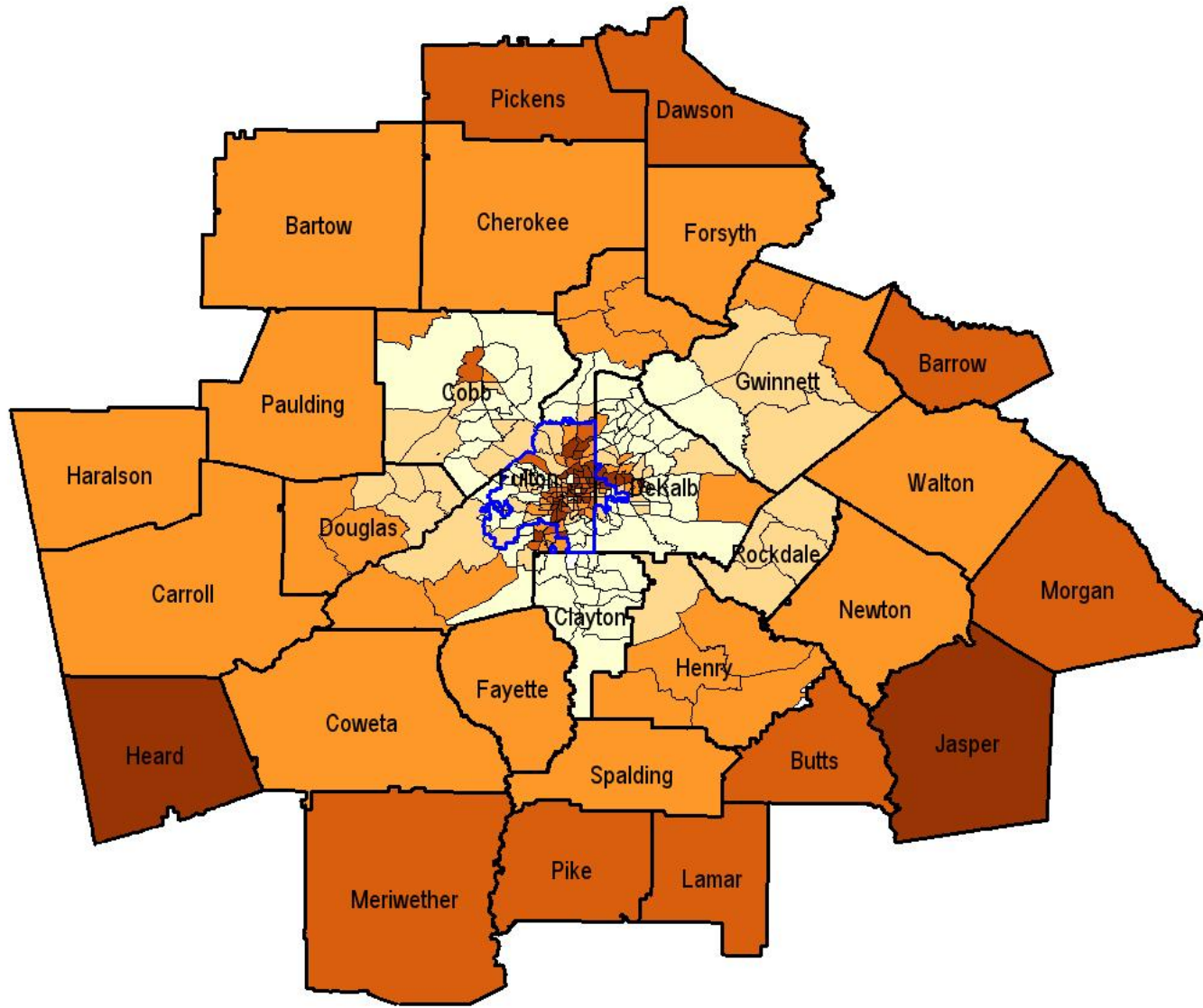


% Population of Age 18-64 2015

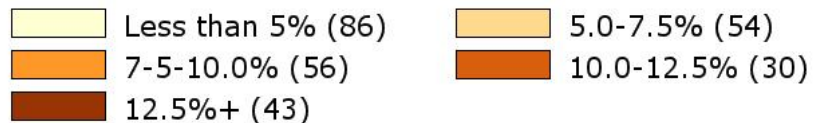

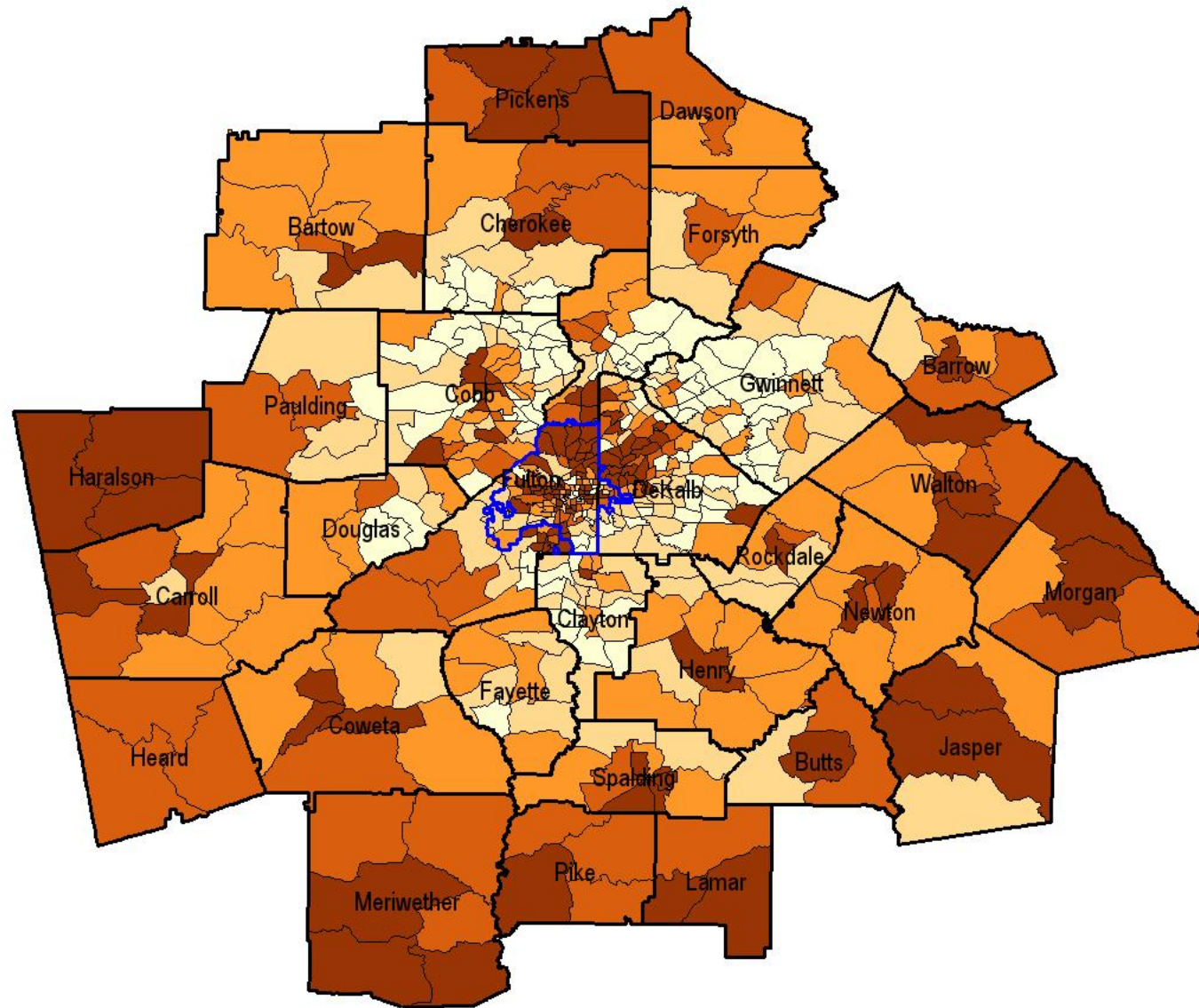


% Population of Age 65+ 1970

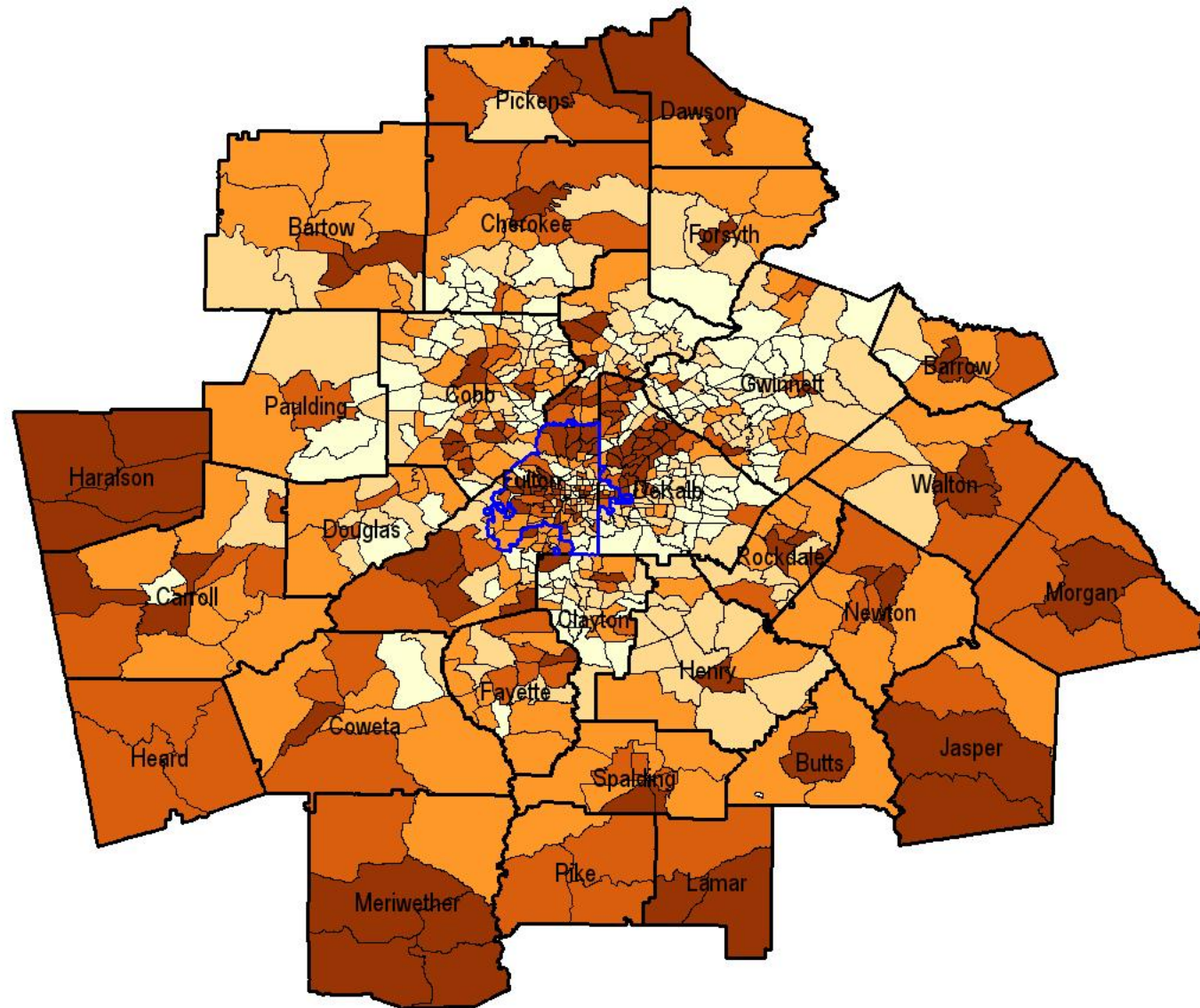


% Population of Age 65+ 1990

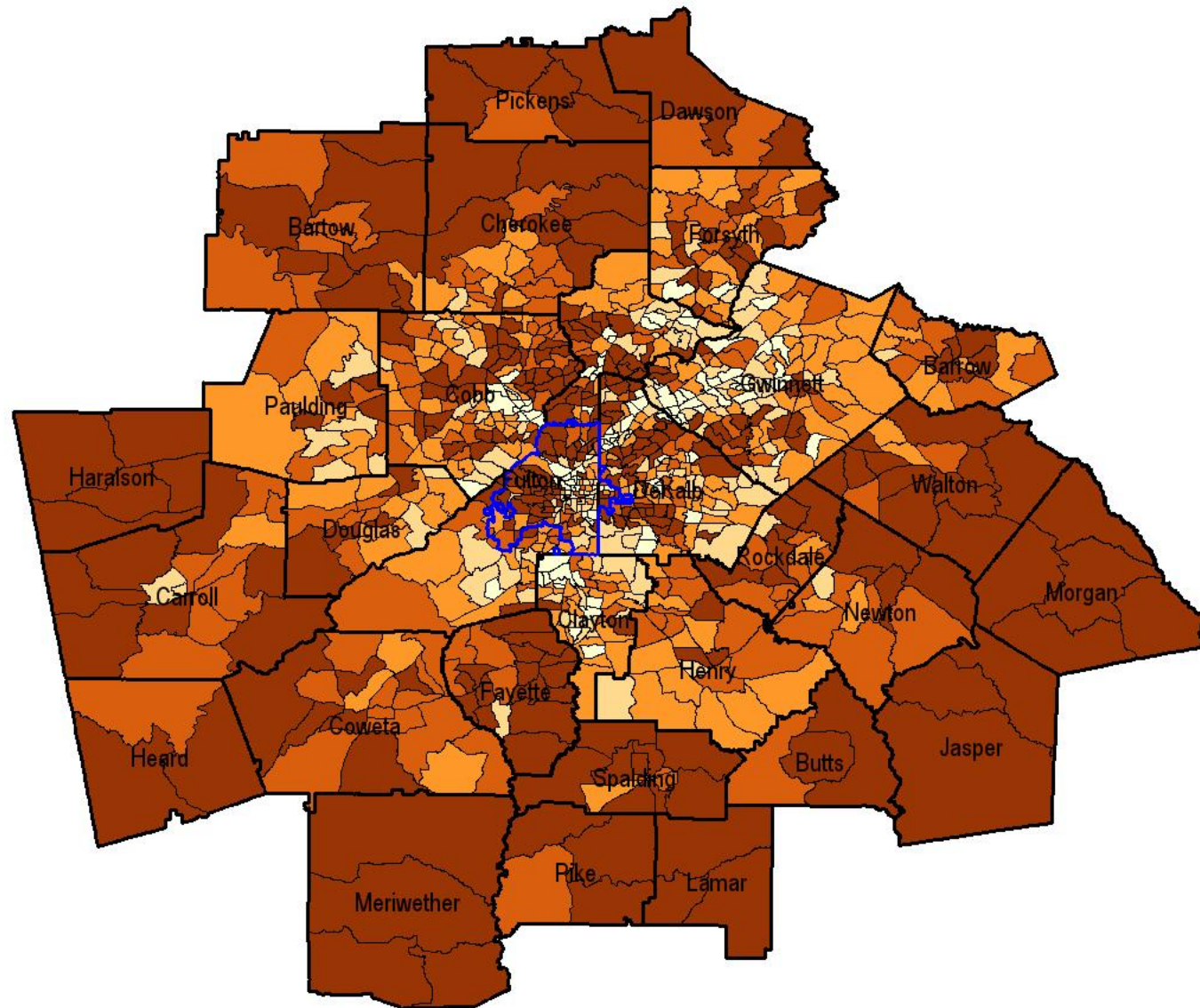


% Population of Age 65+ 2000

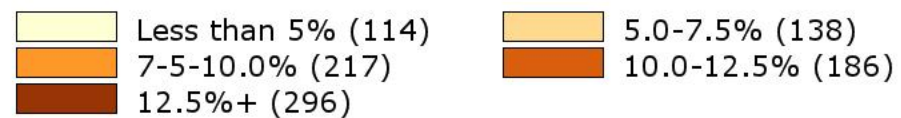

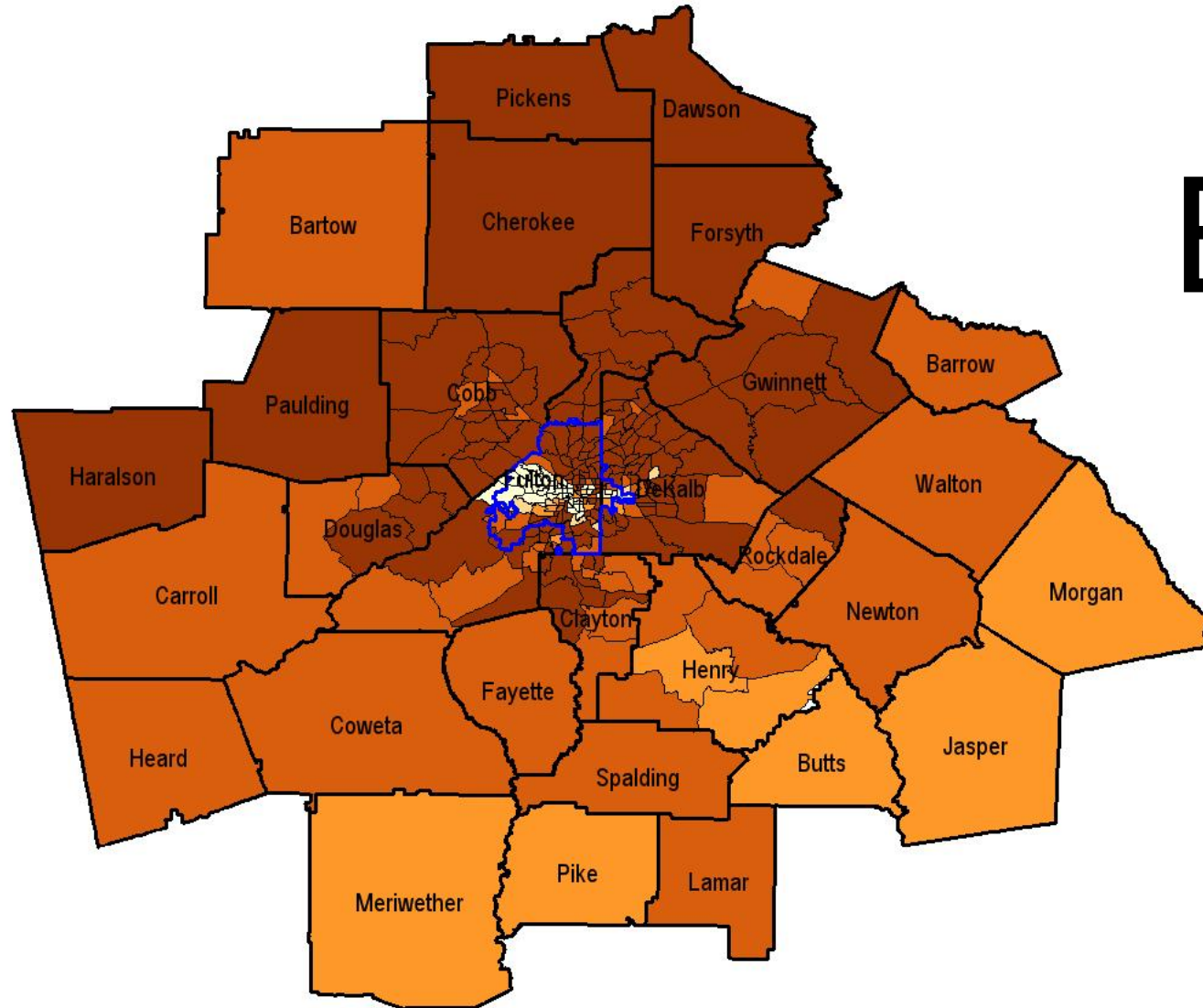


% Population of Age 65+ 2015

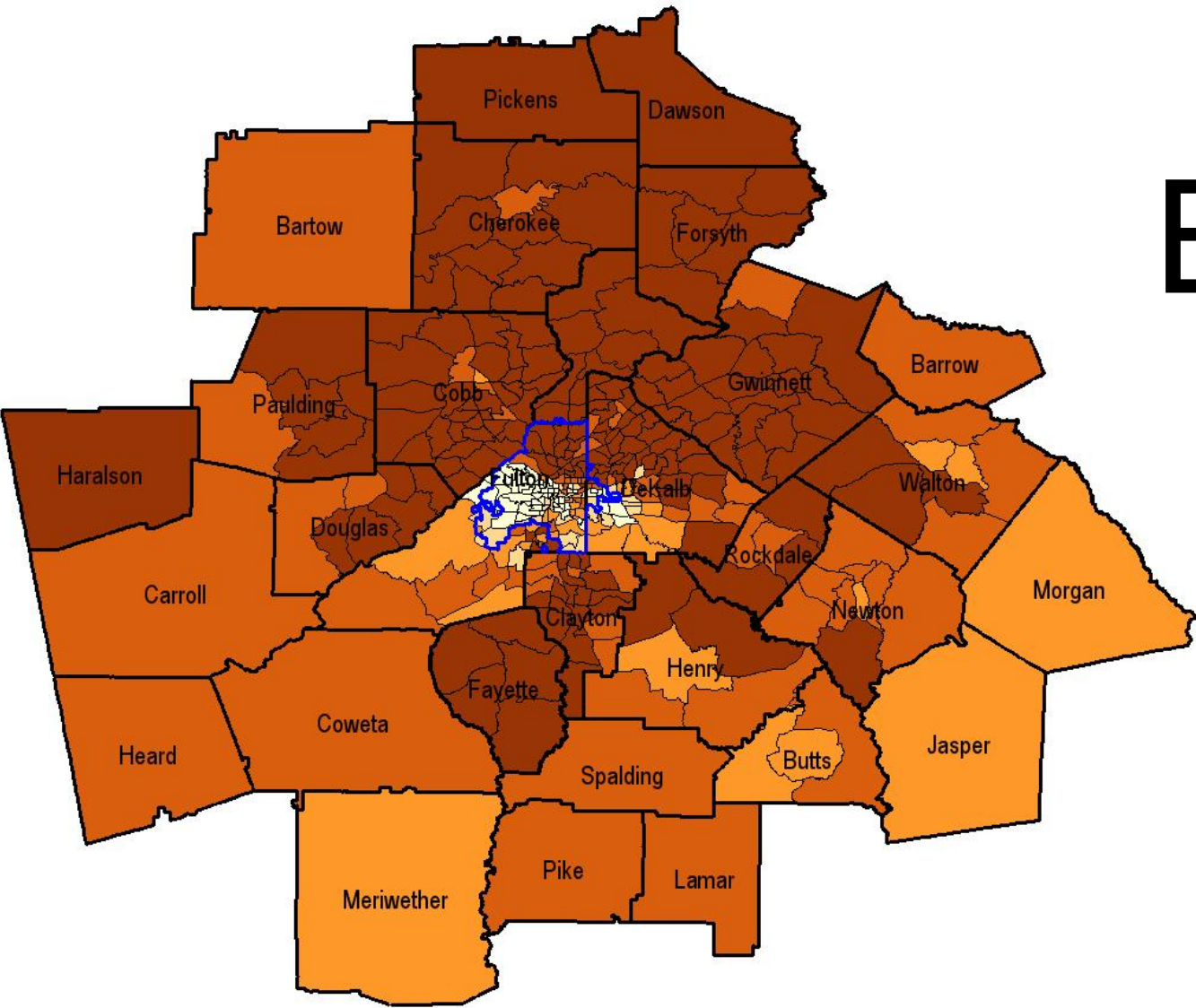


Percent White 1970

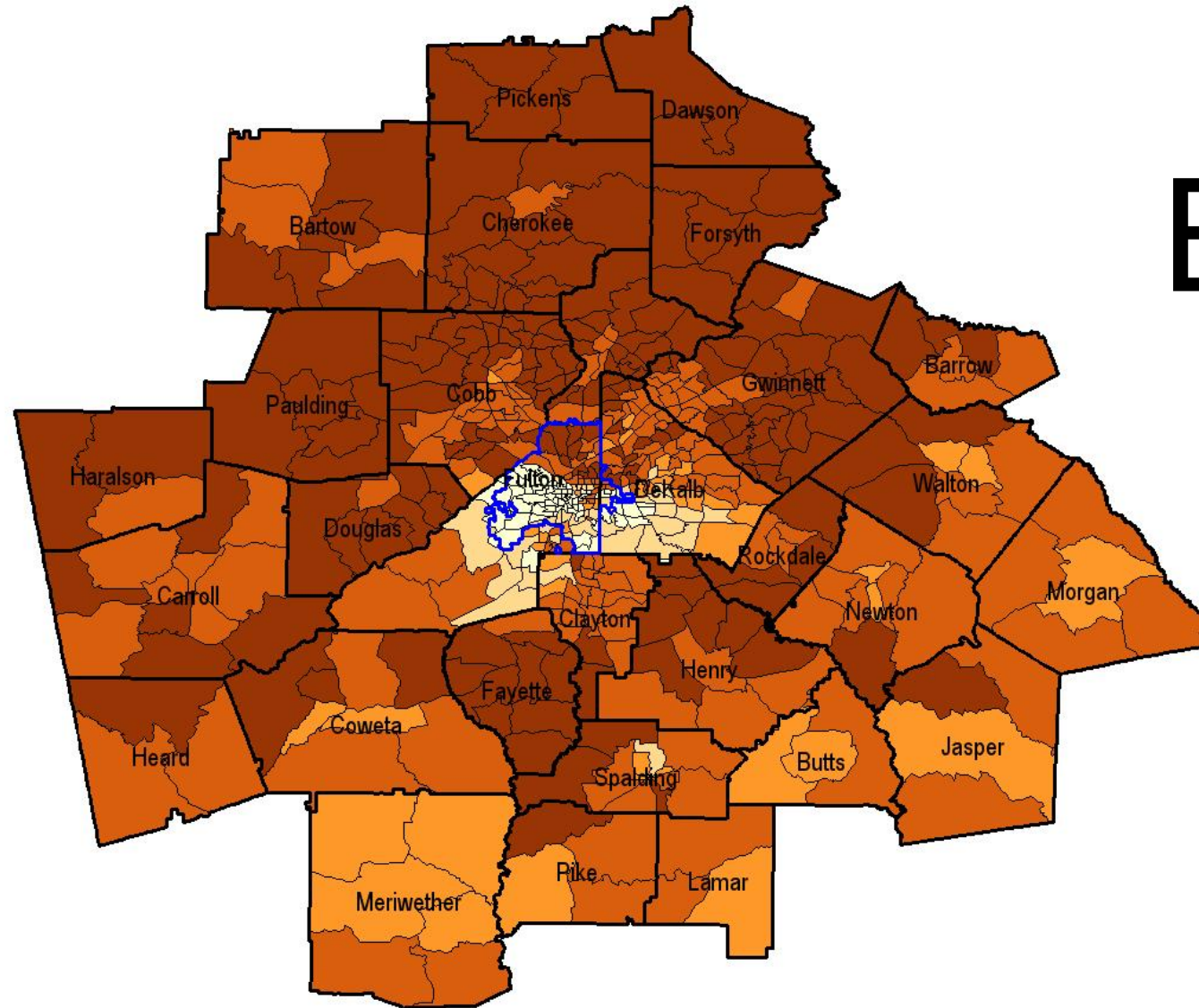

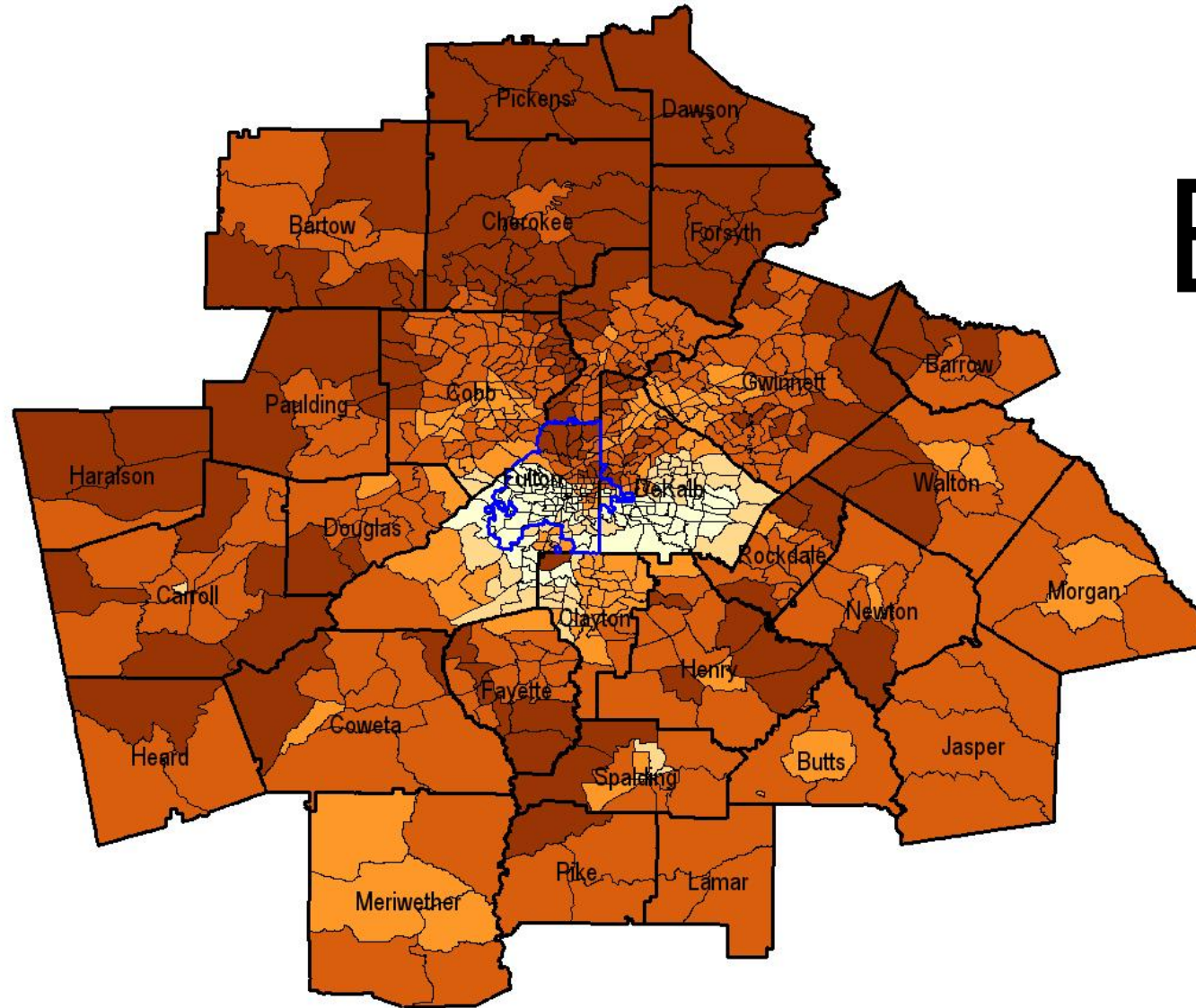

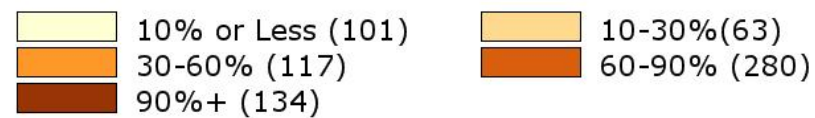

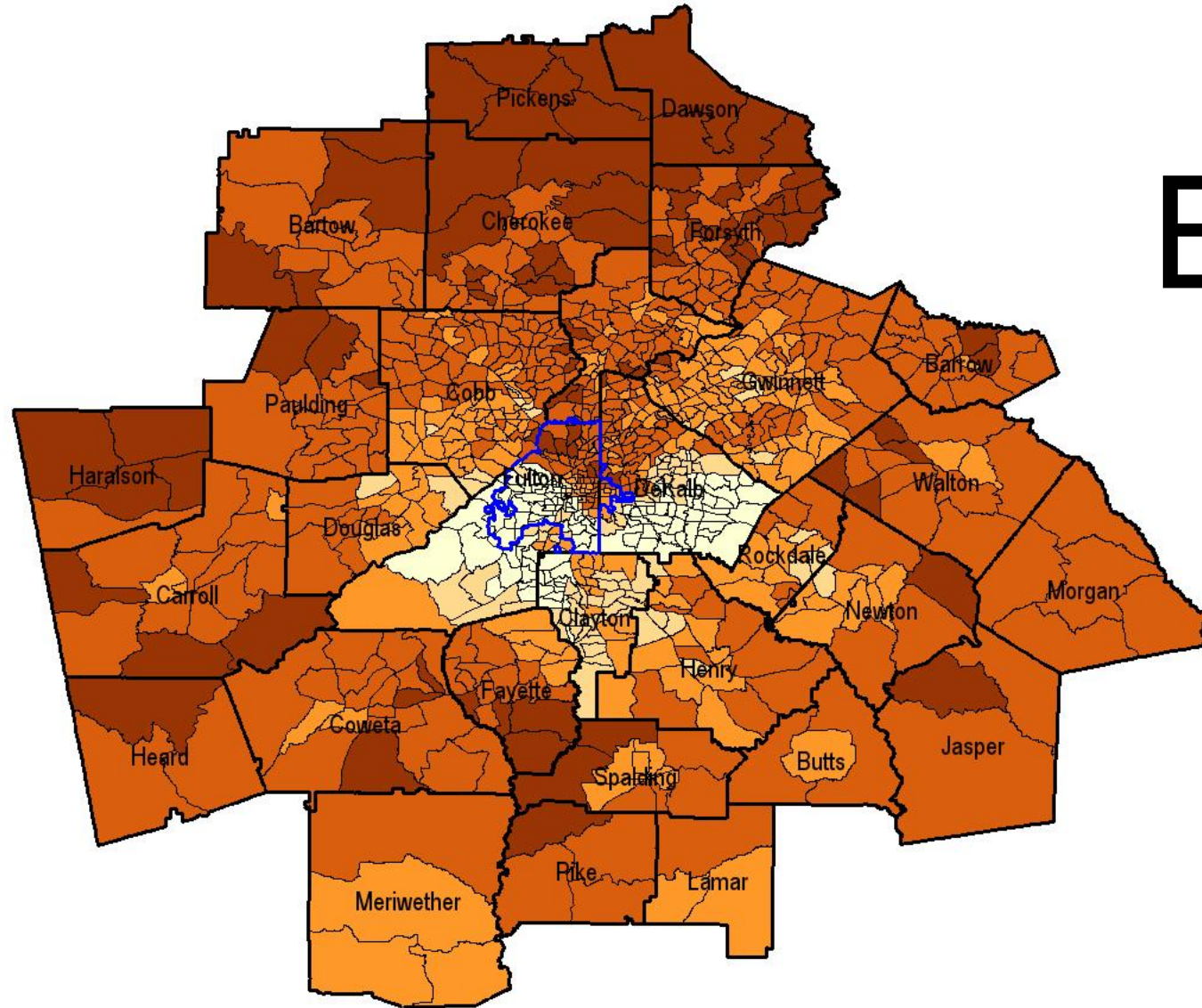


Percent White 2000

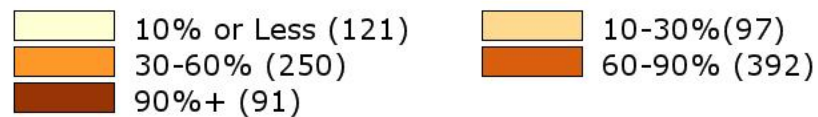

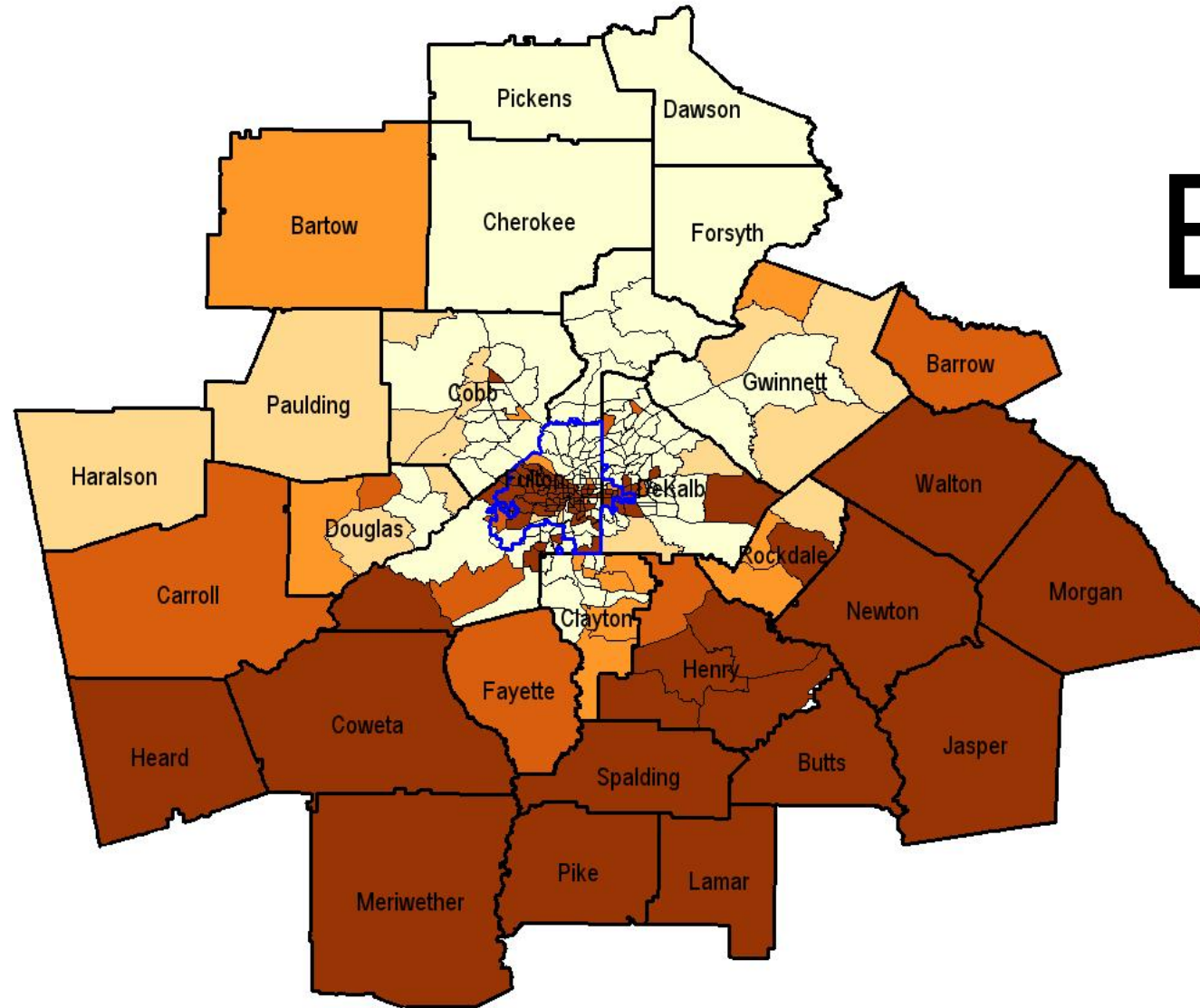


Percent White 2015

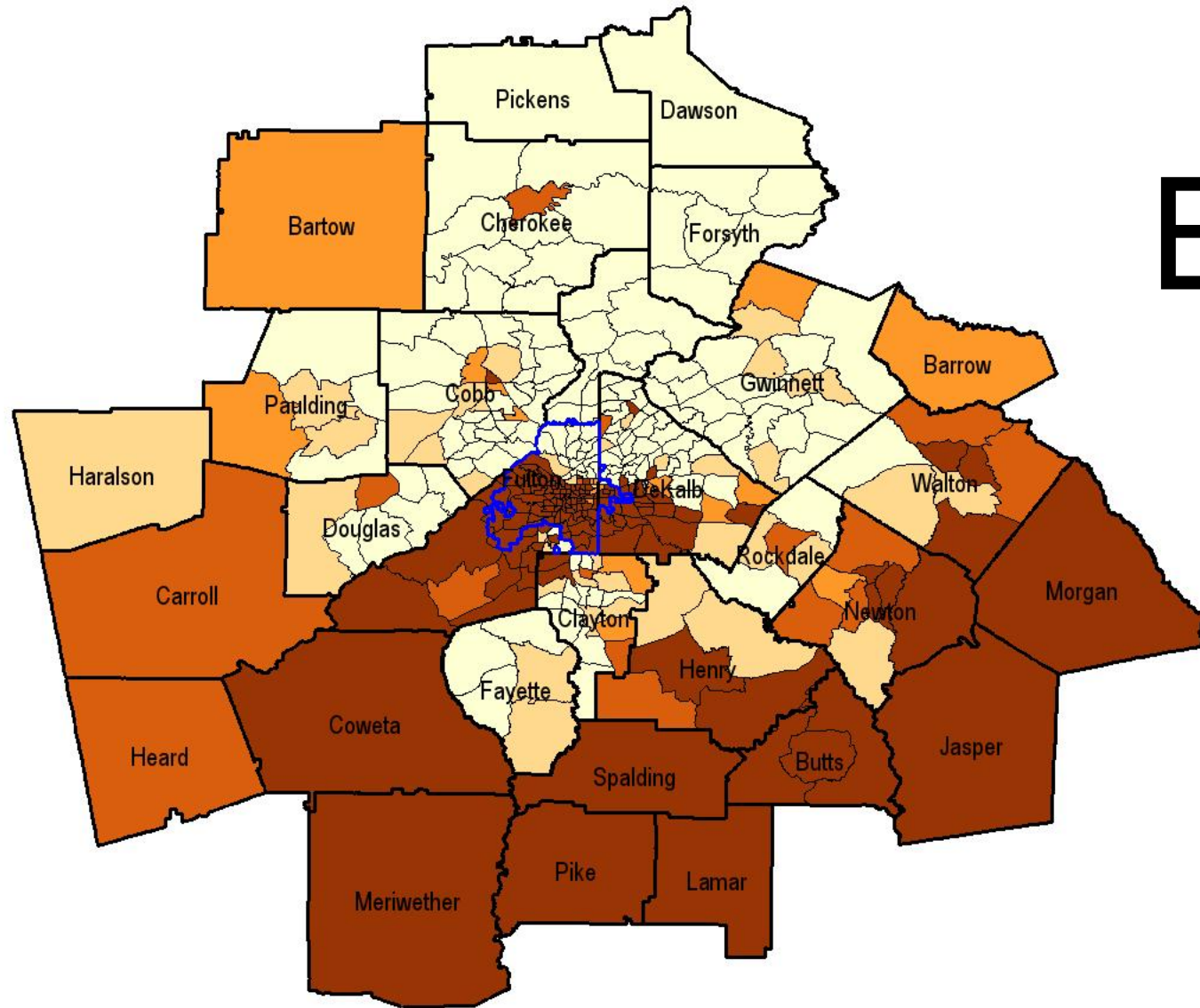


Percent African American 1970

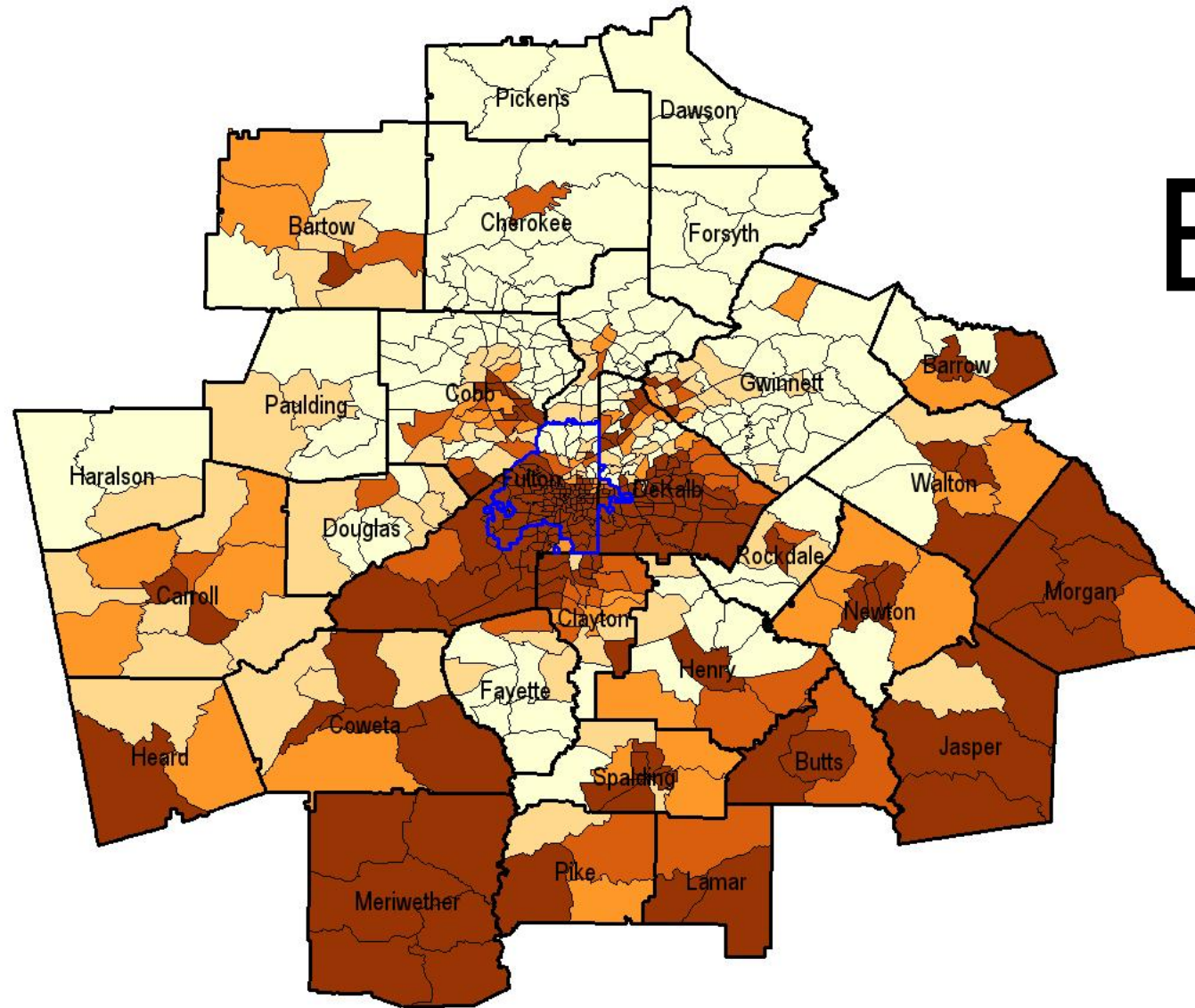


Percent African American 1980

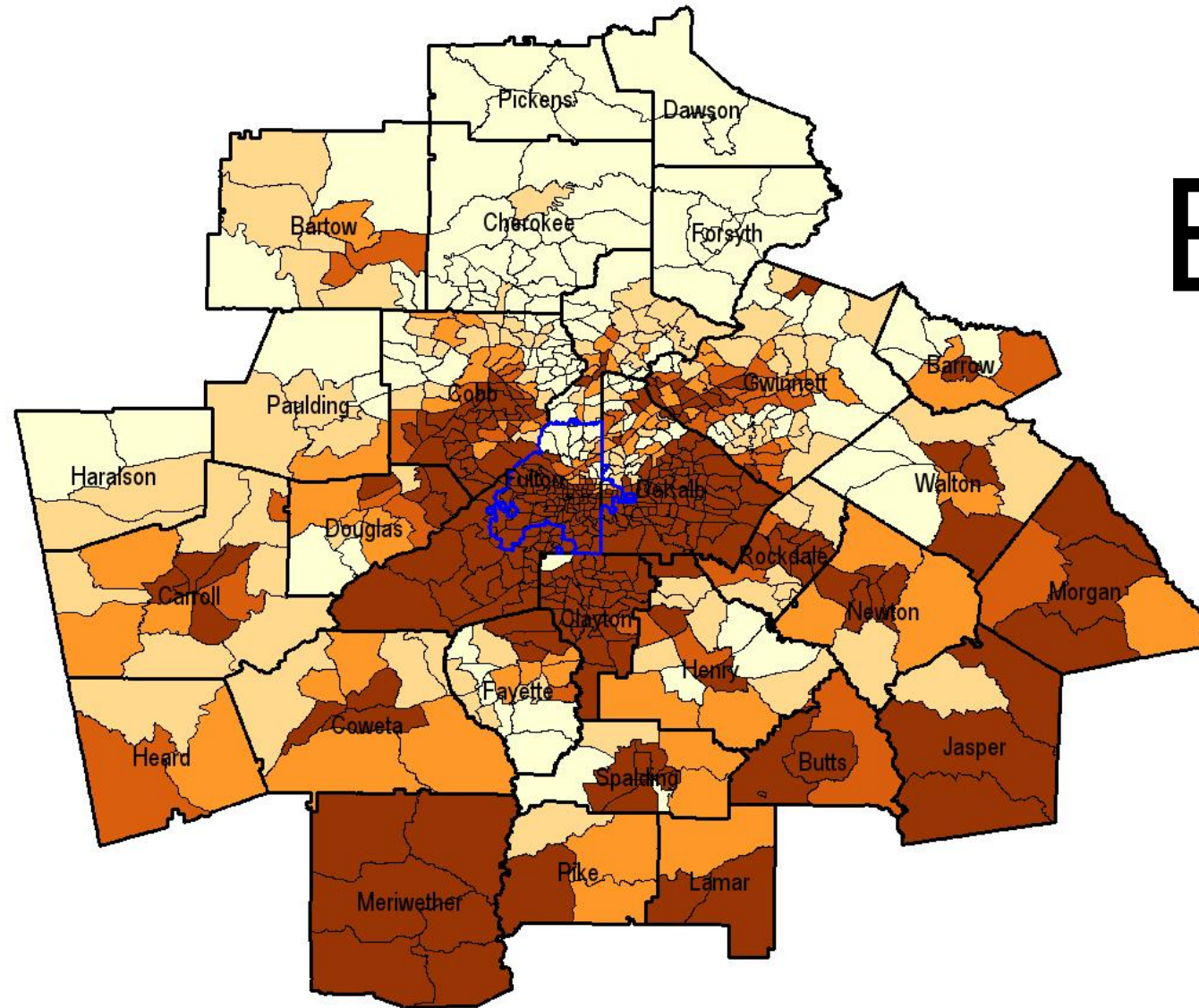


Percent African American 1990

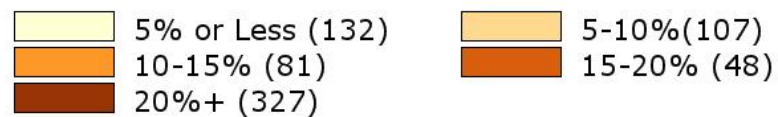

(African-American, 2000)

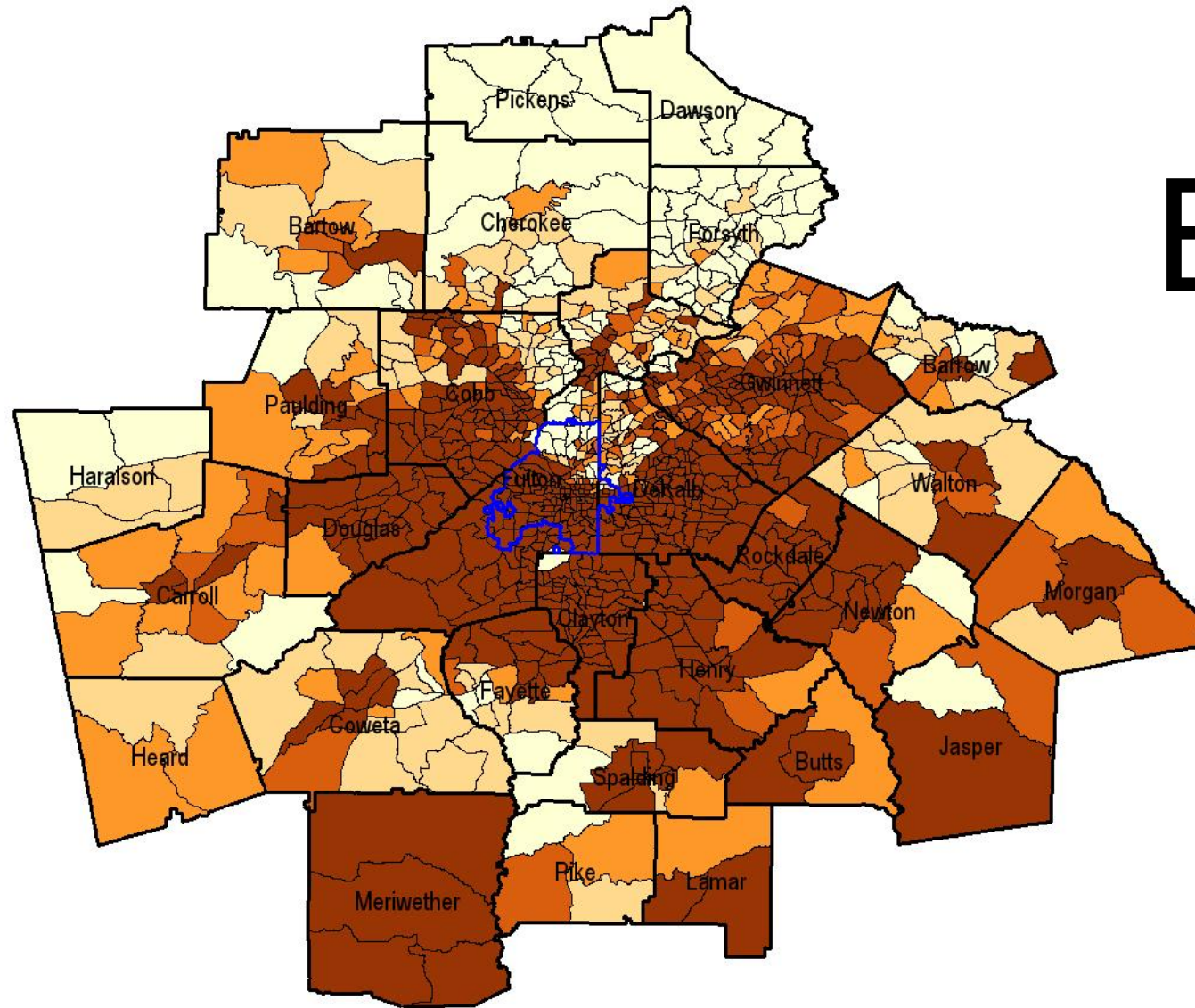


Percent African American 2000

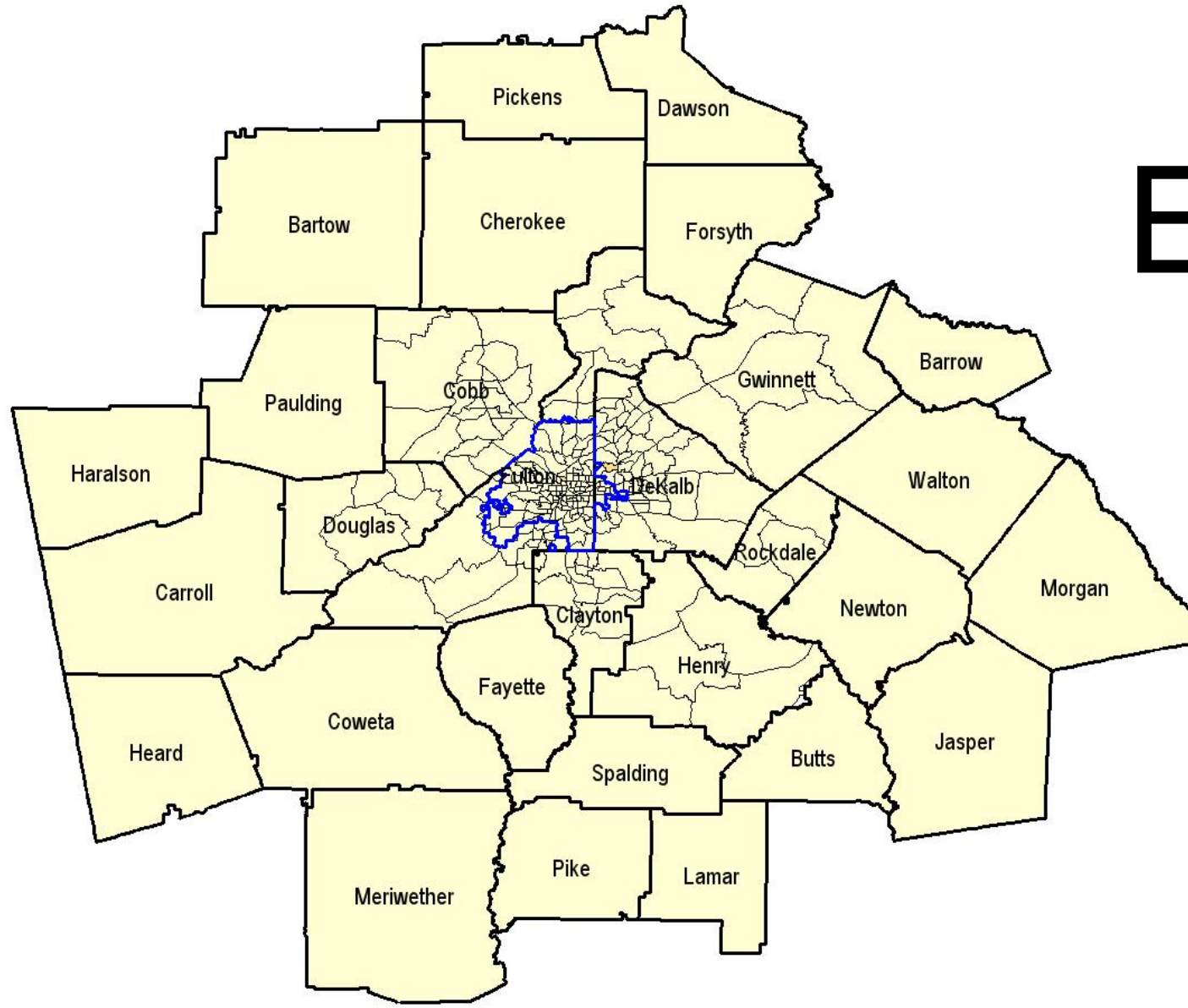


Percent African American 2015

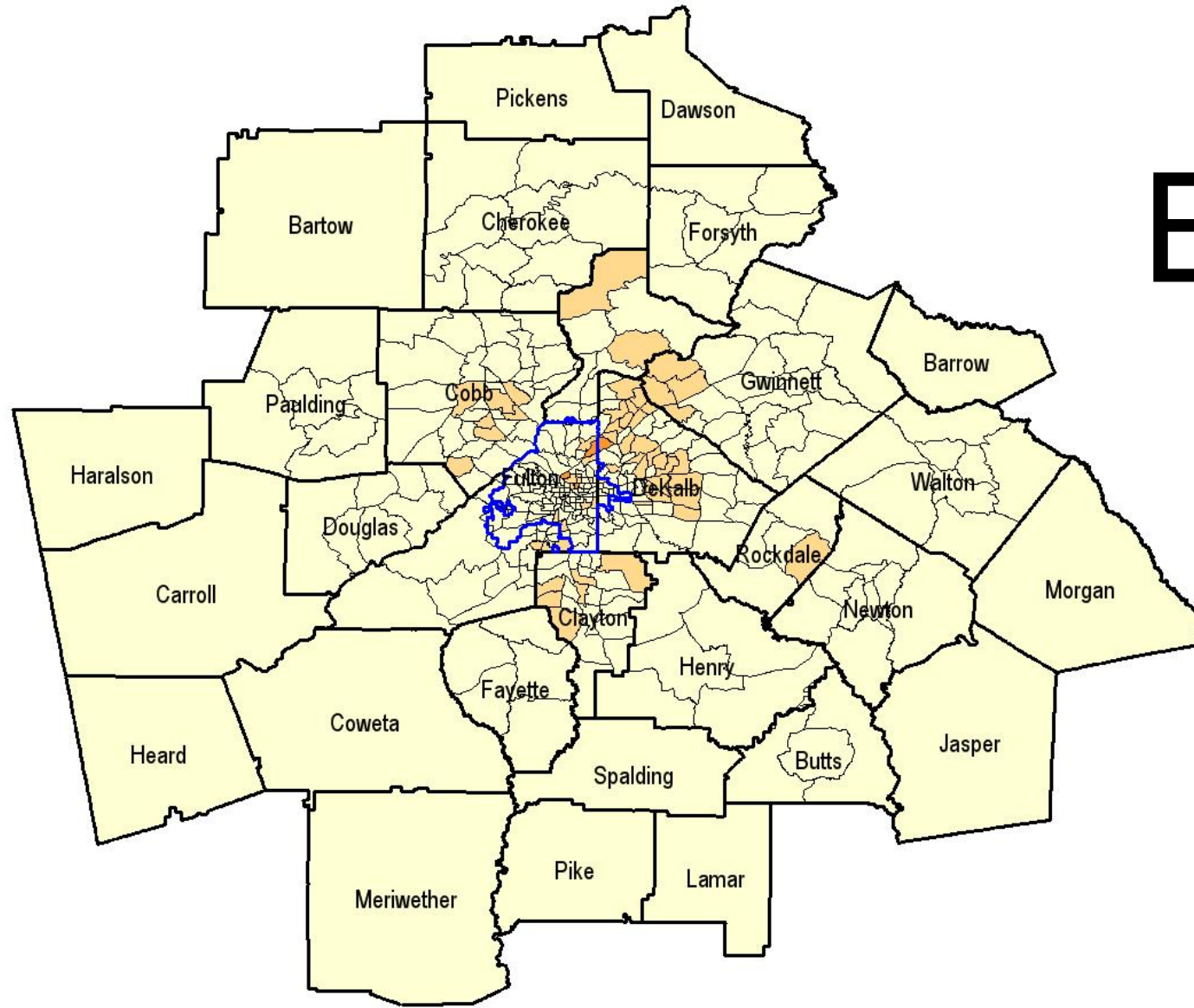


Percent Asian 1970

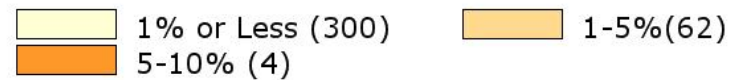

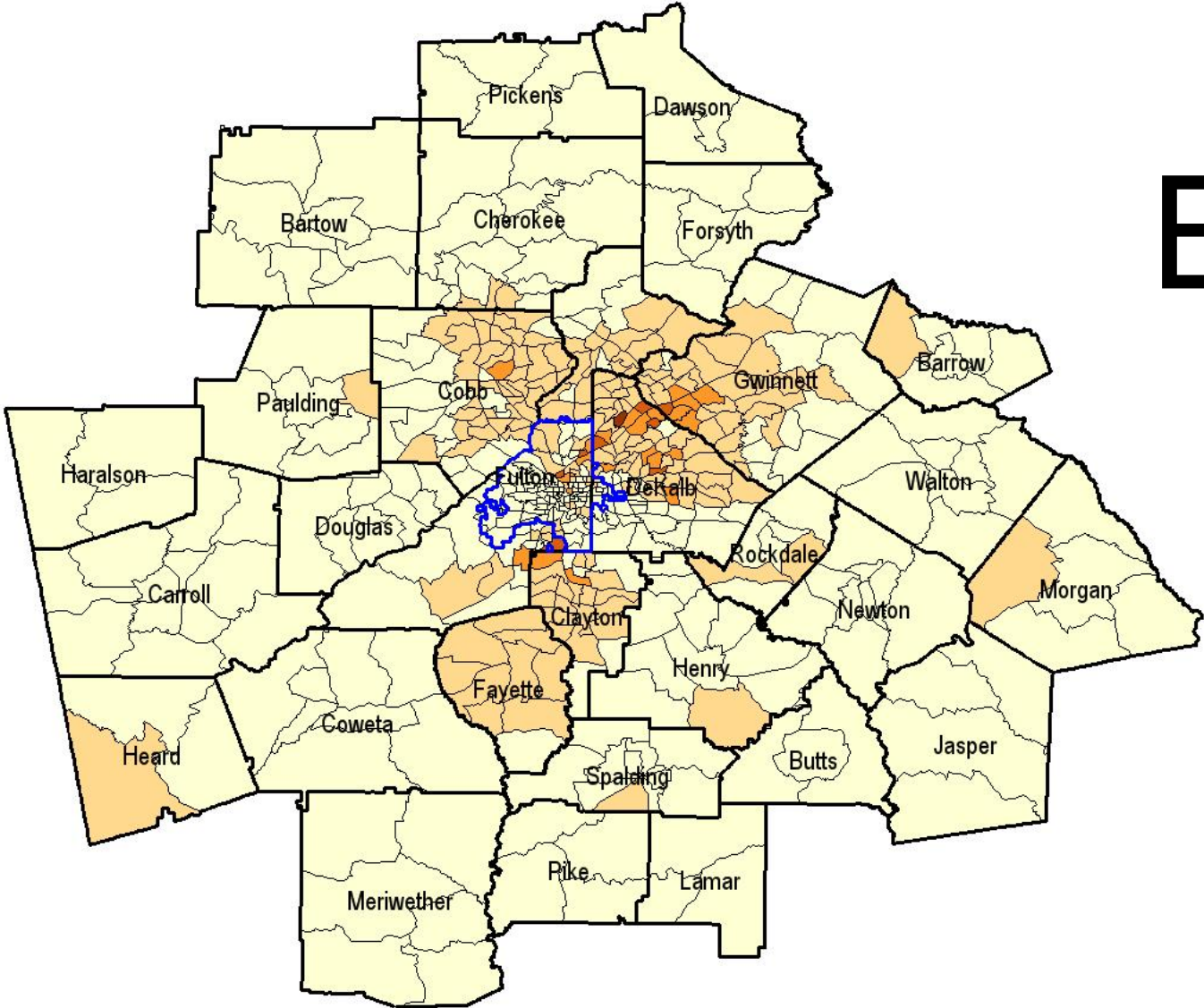


Percent Asian 1980

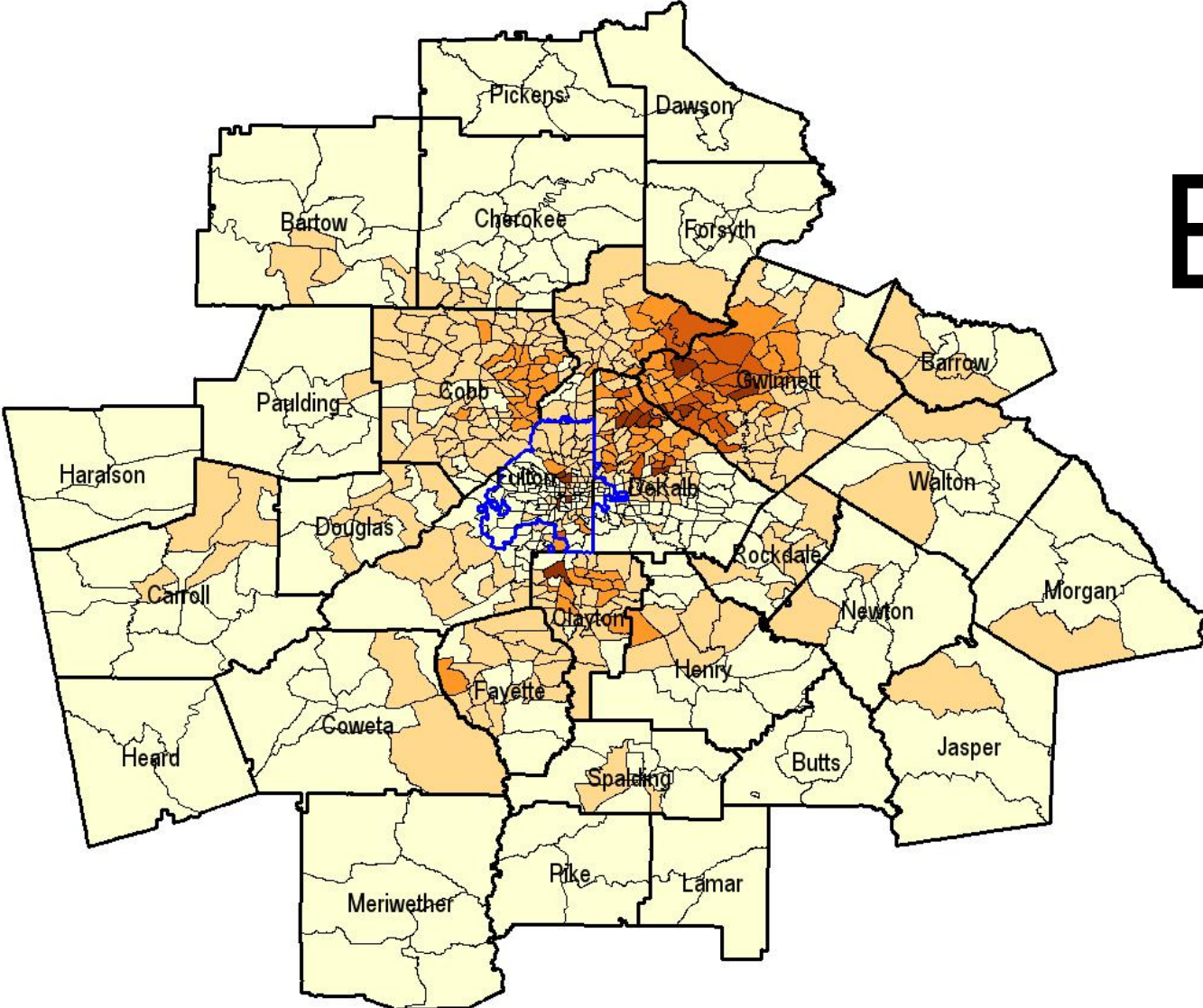

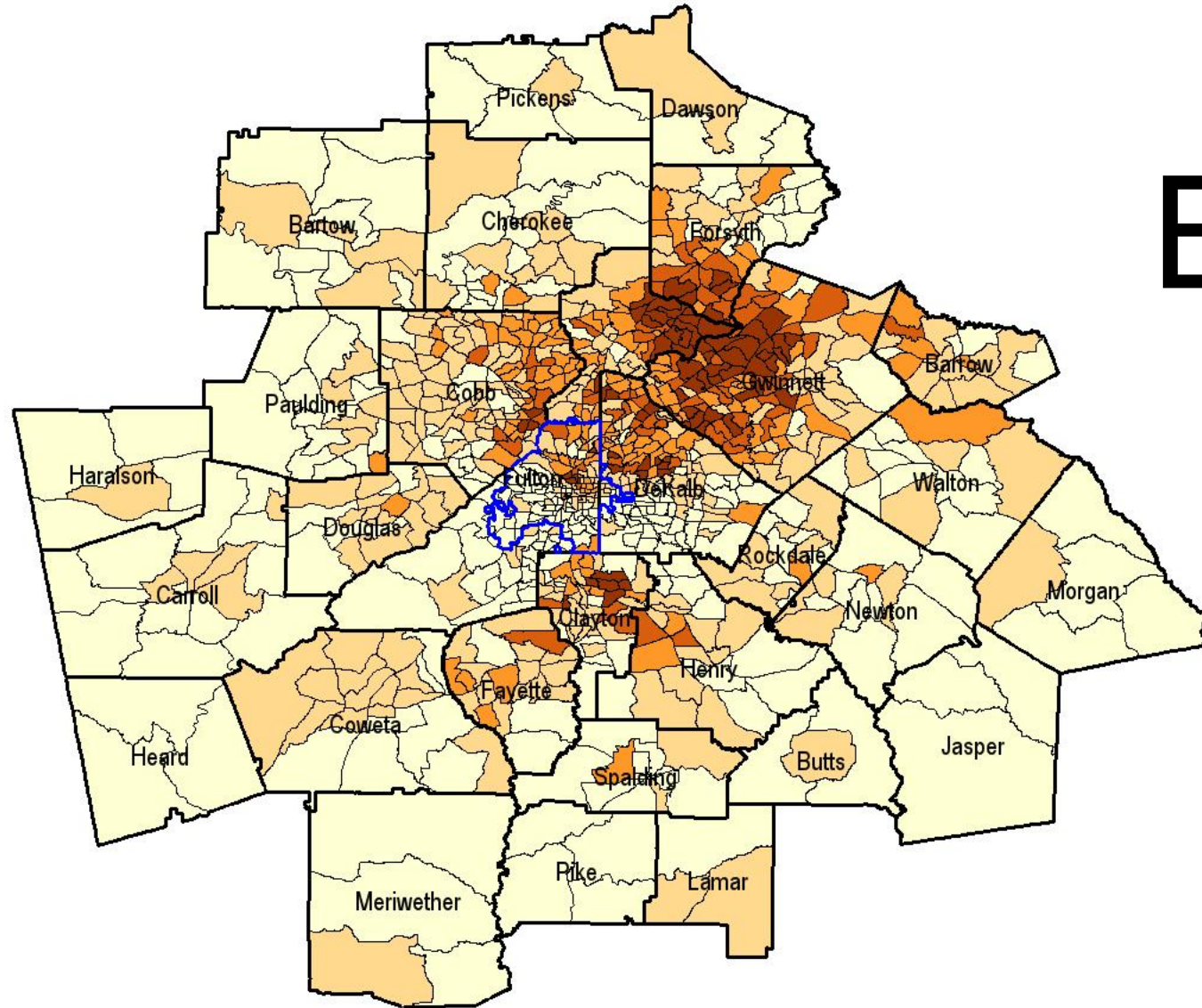

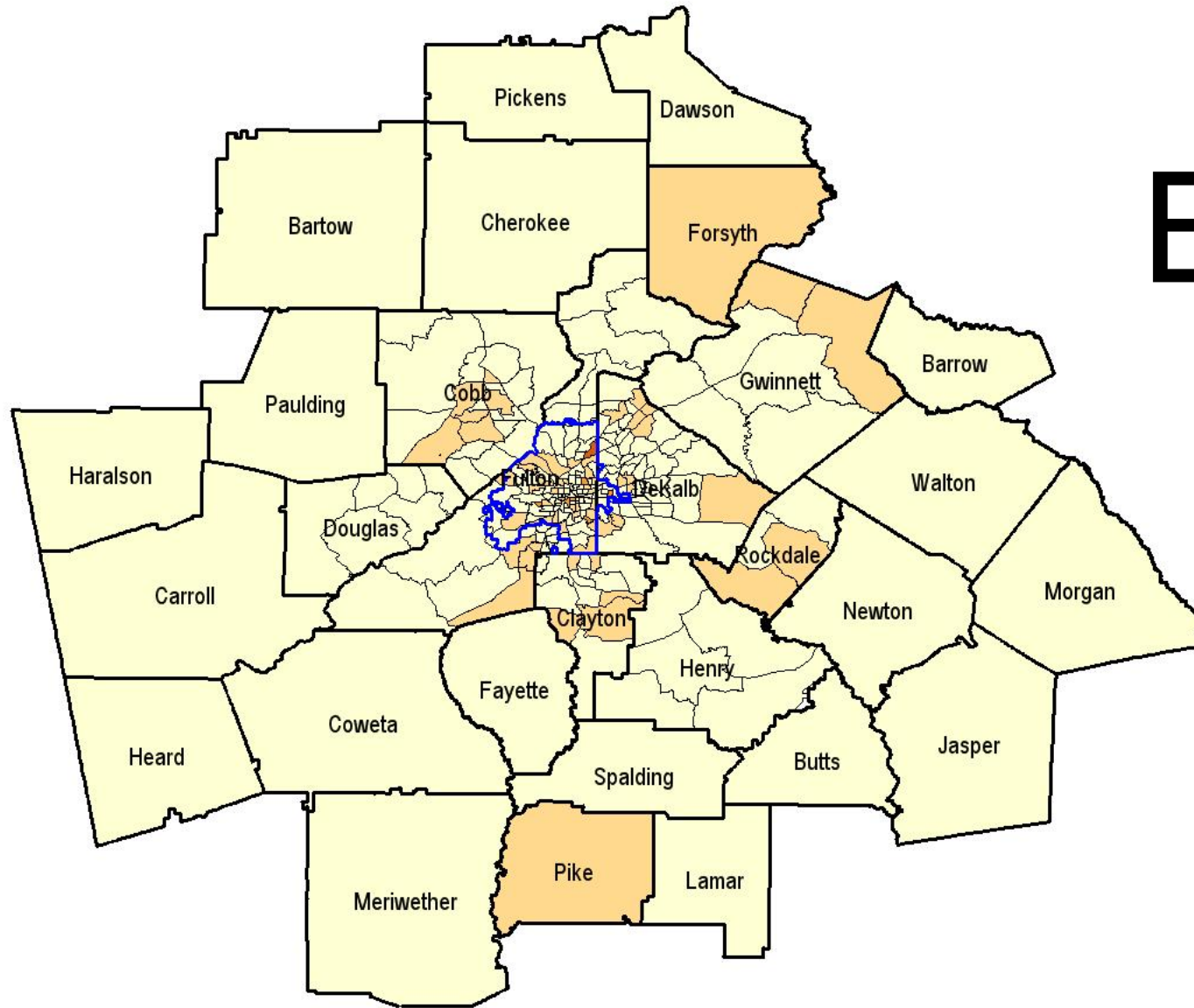


Percent Asian 2015

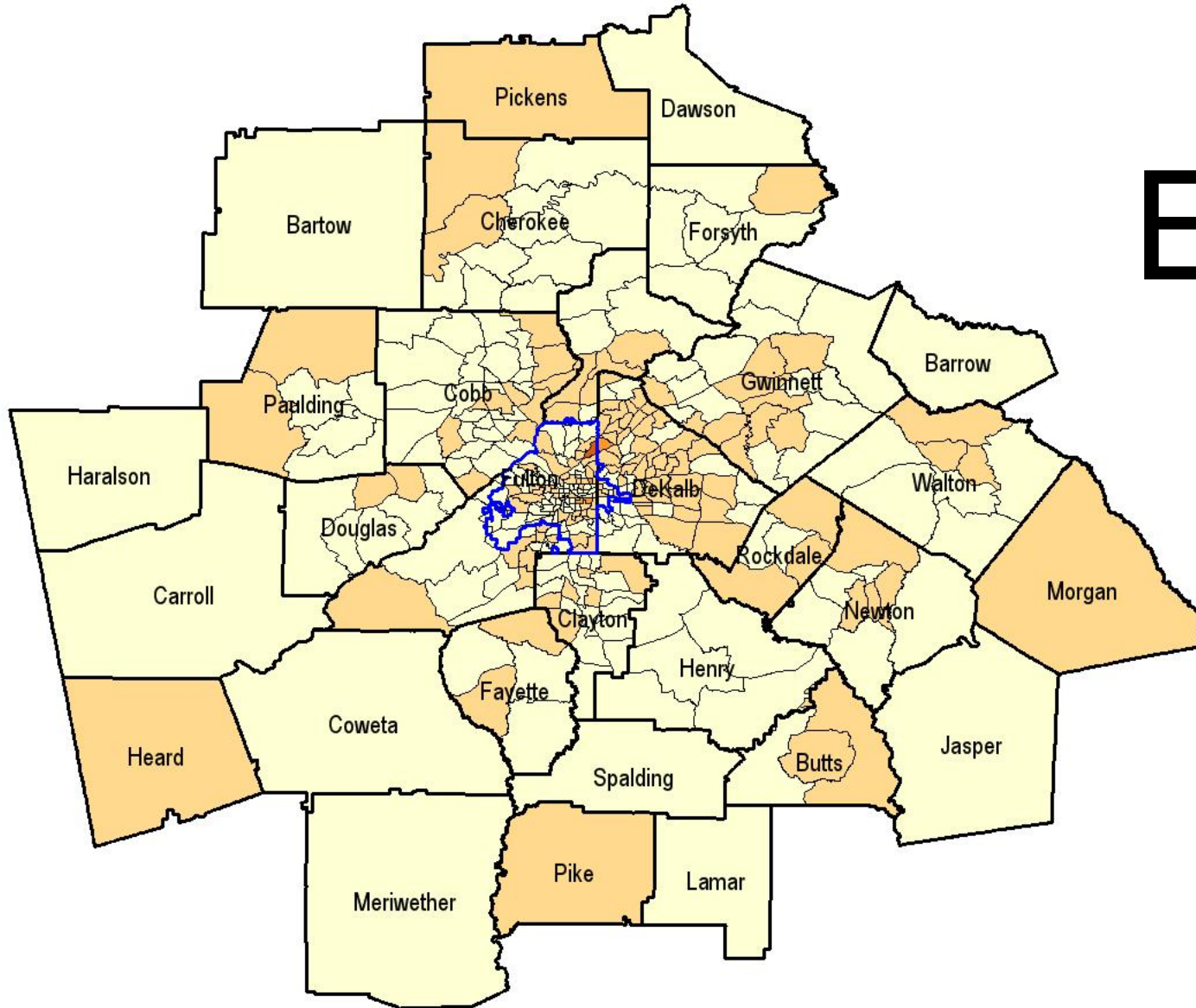


Percent Hispanic 1970

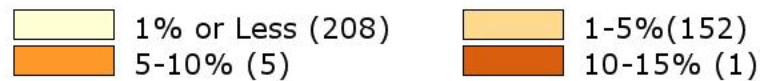

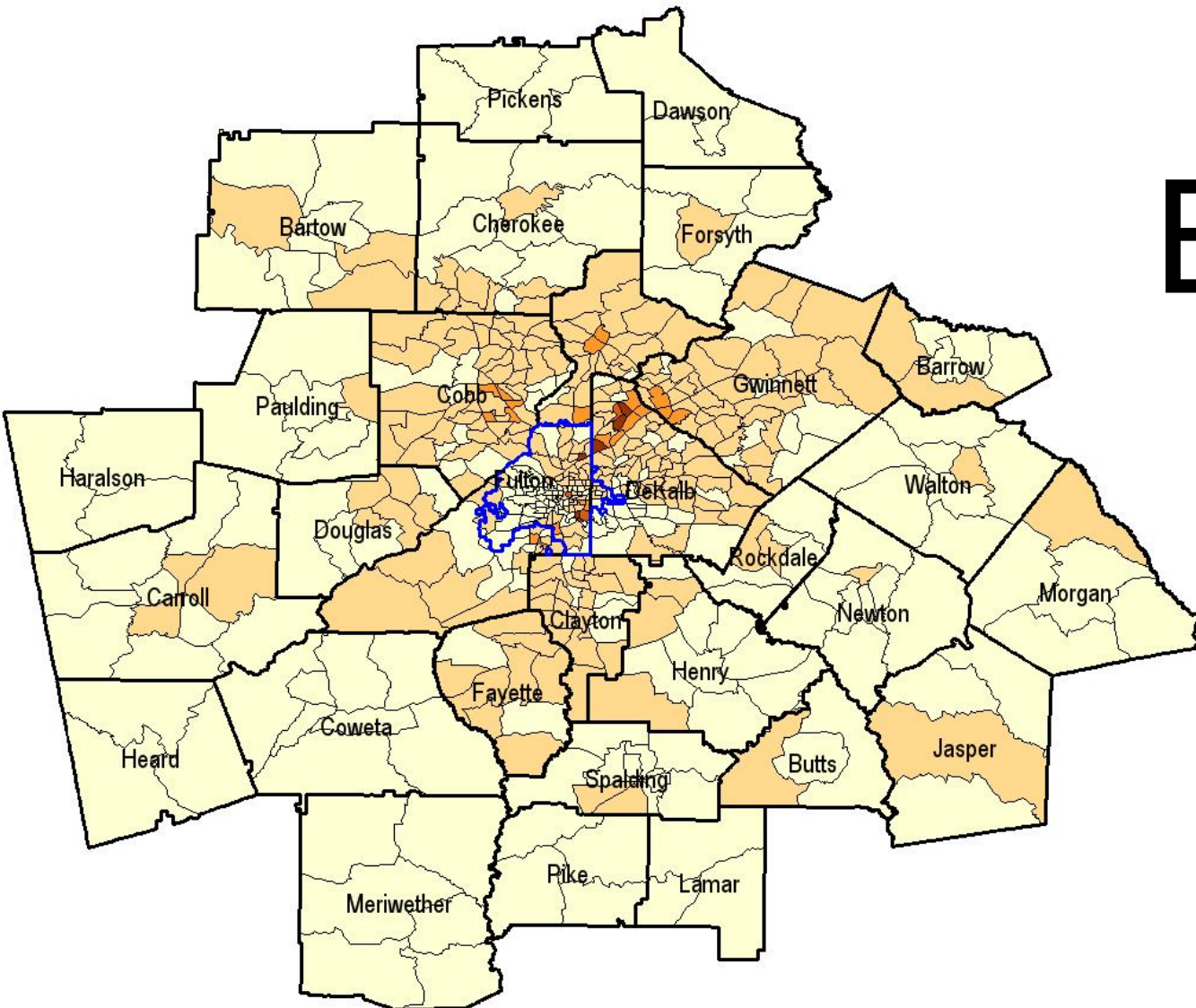


Percent Hispanic 1980

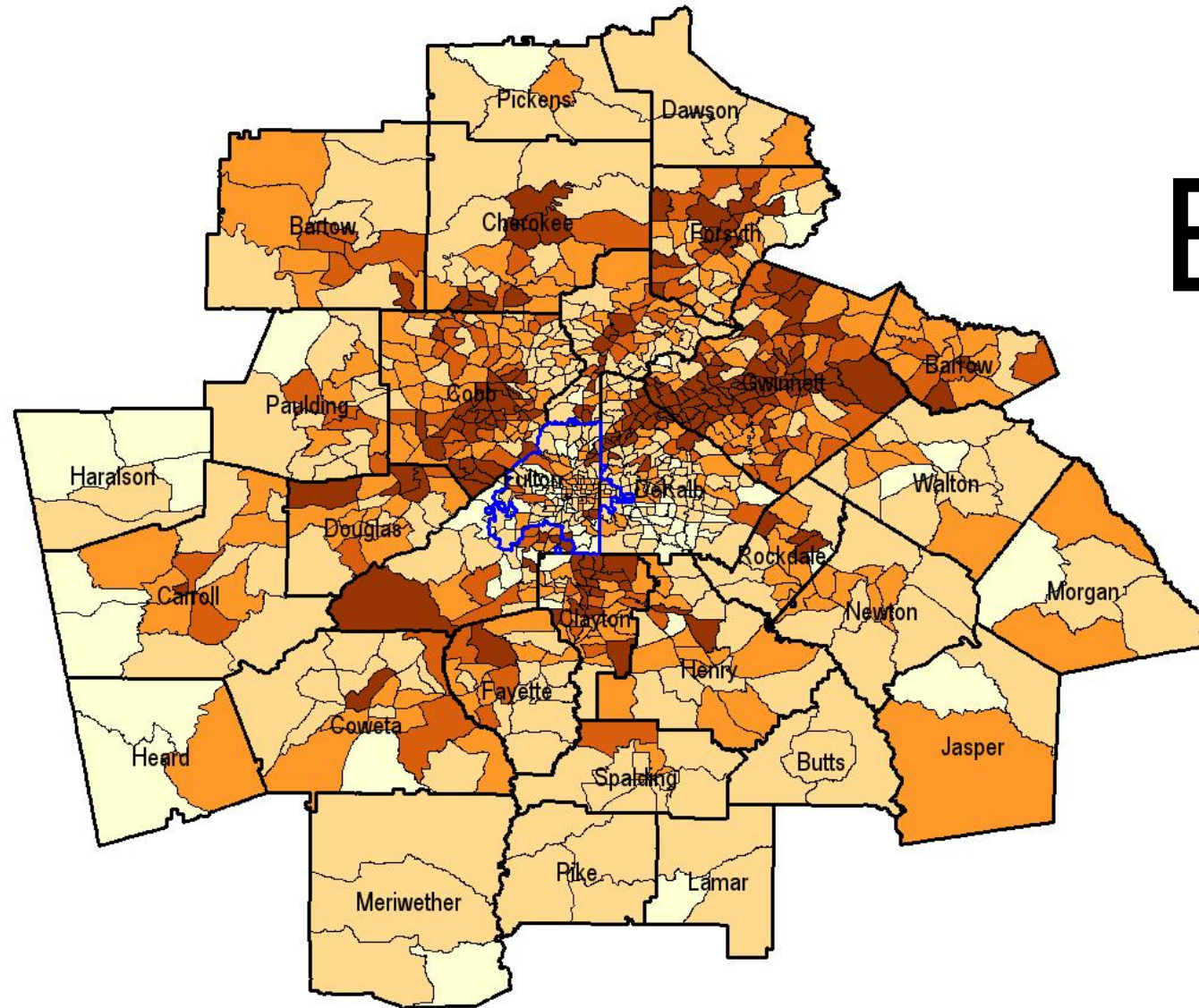


Percent Hispanic 1990

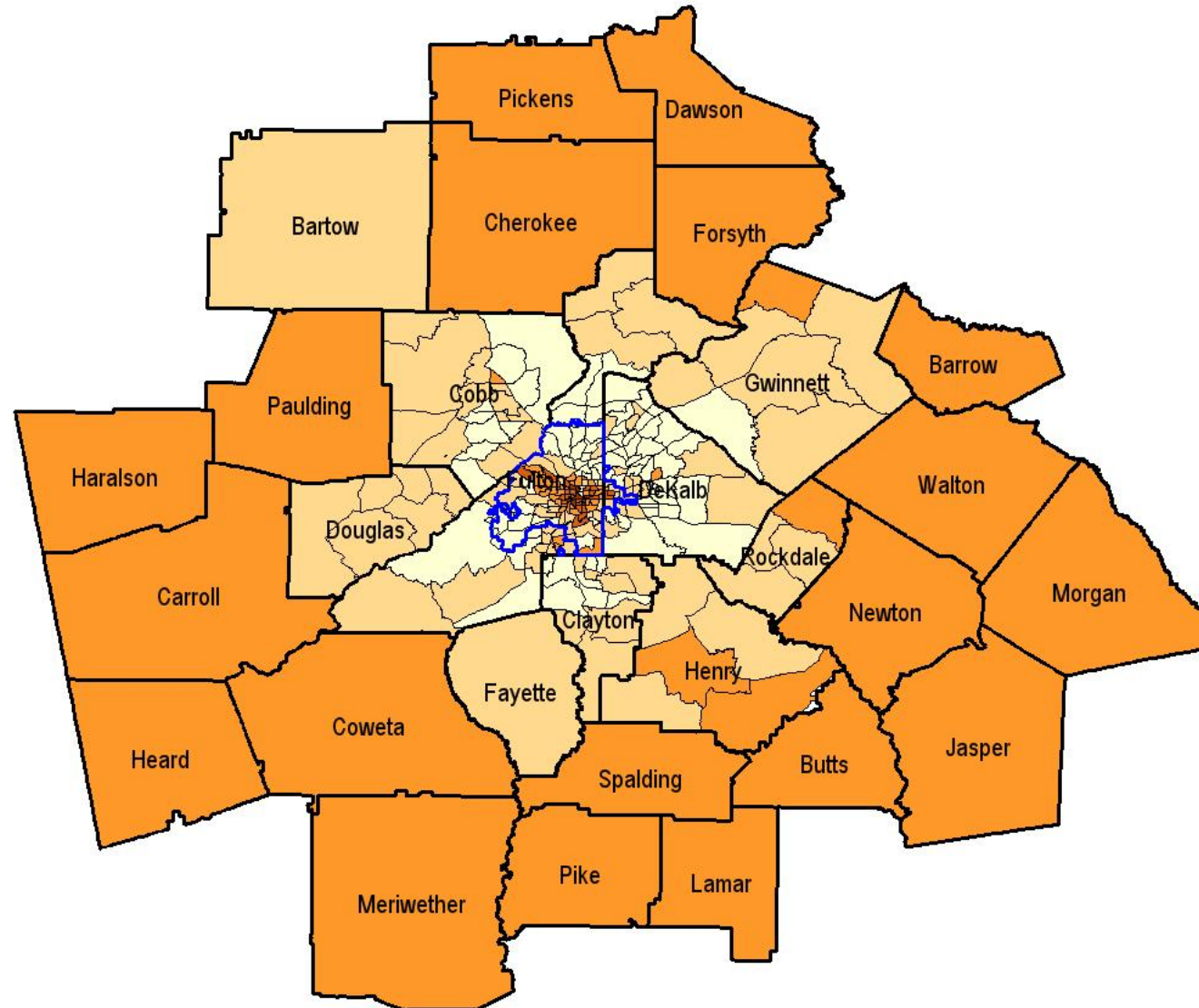


Percent Hispanic 2015

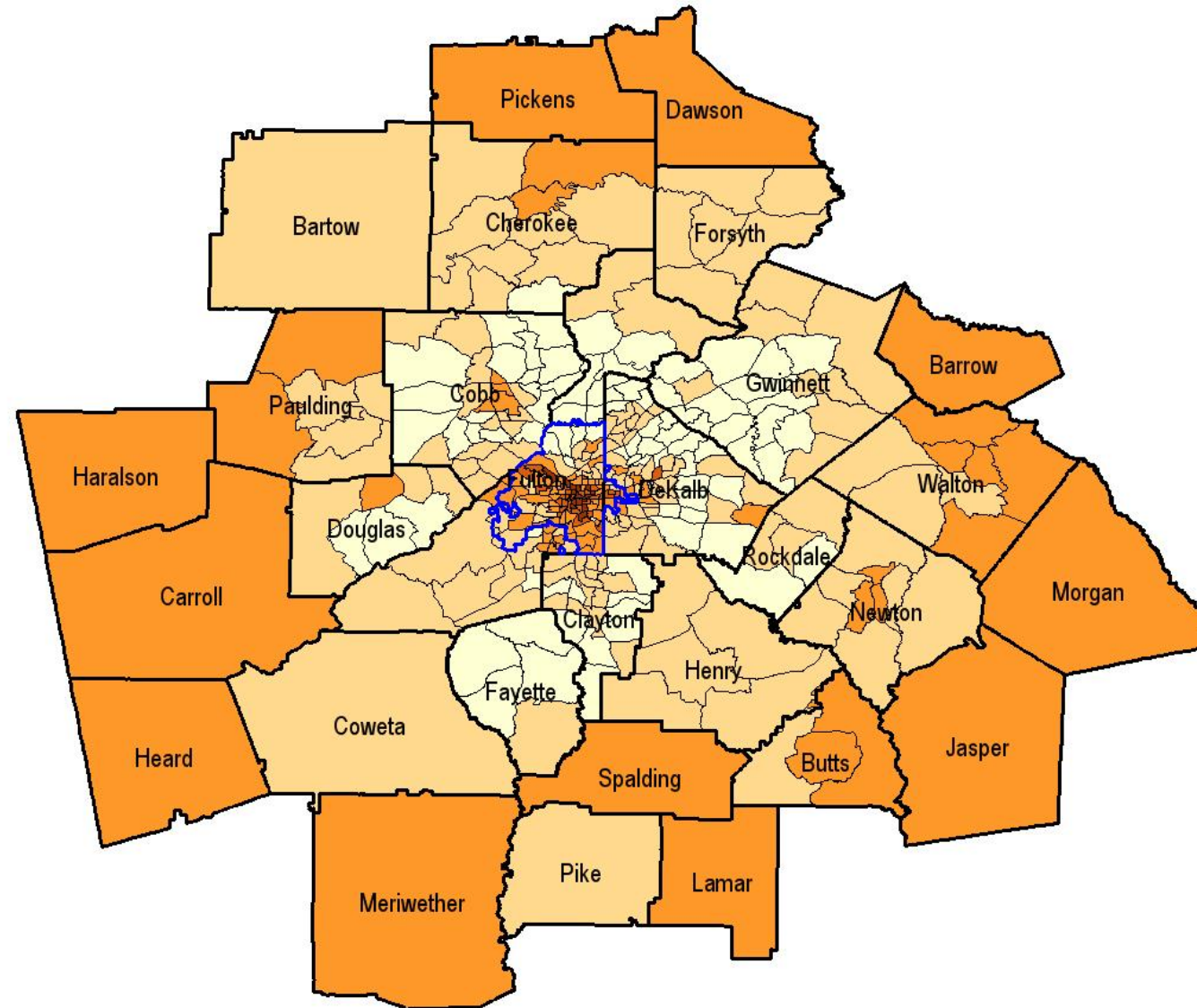


% Low Income Families 1970

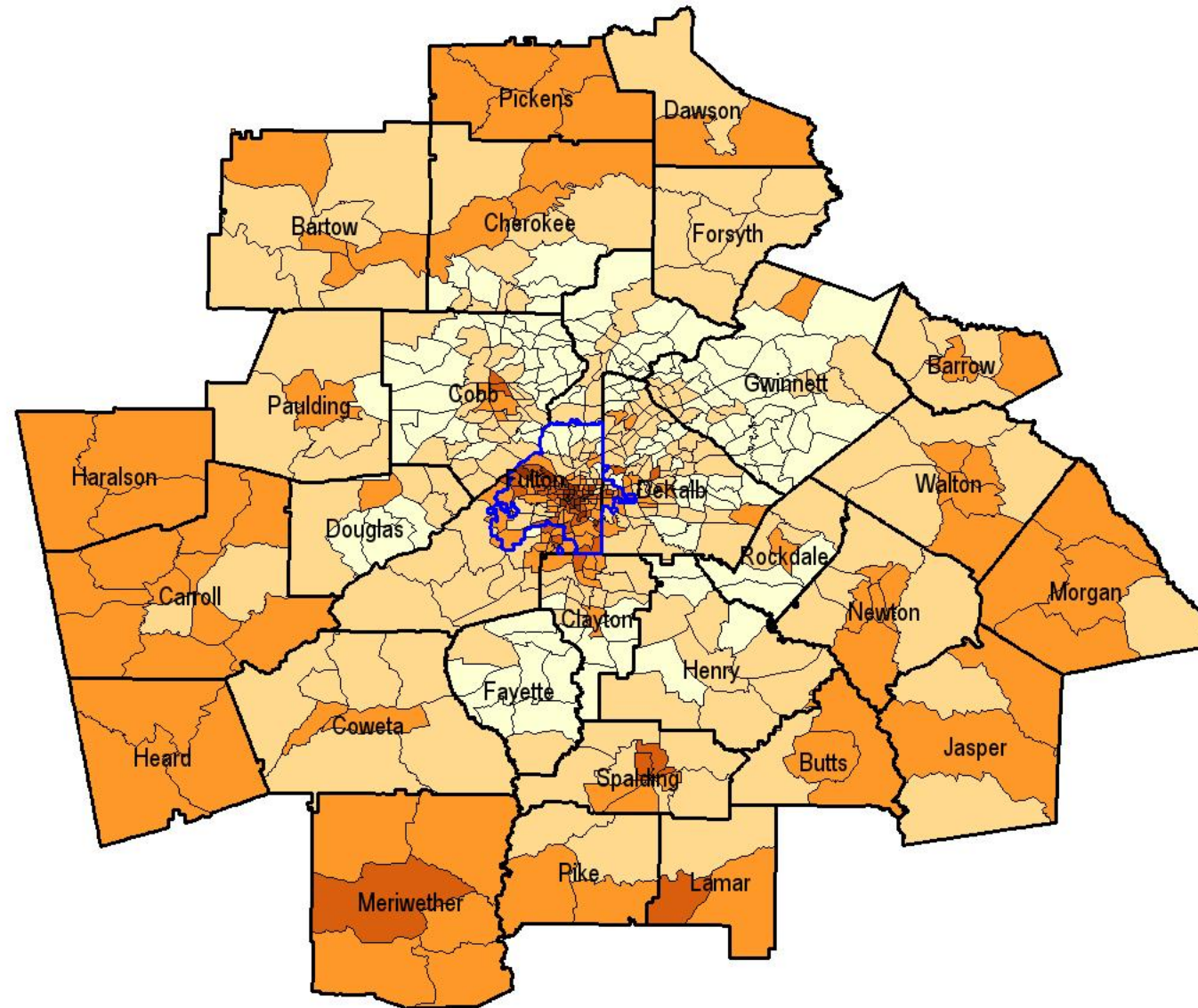


% Low Income Households 1980

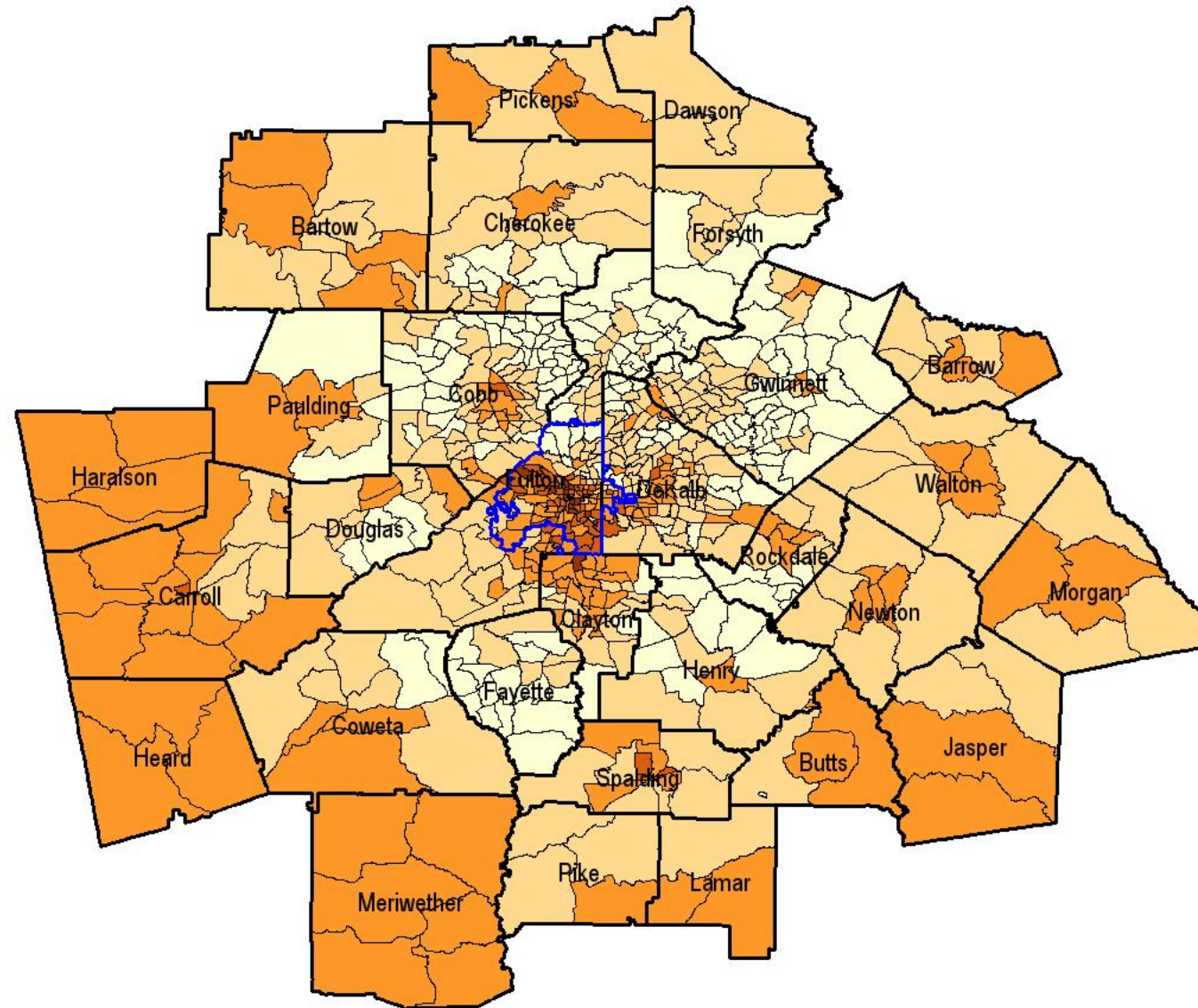


% Low Income Households 1990

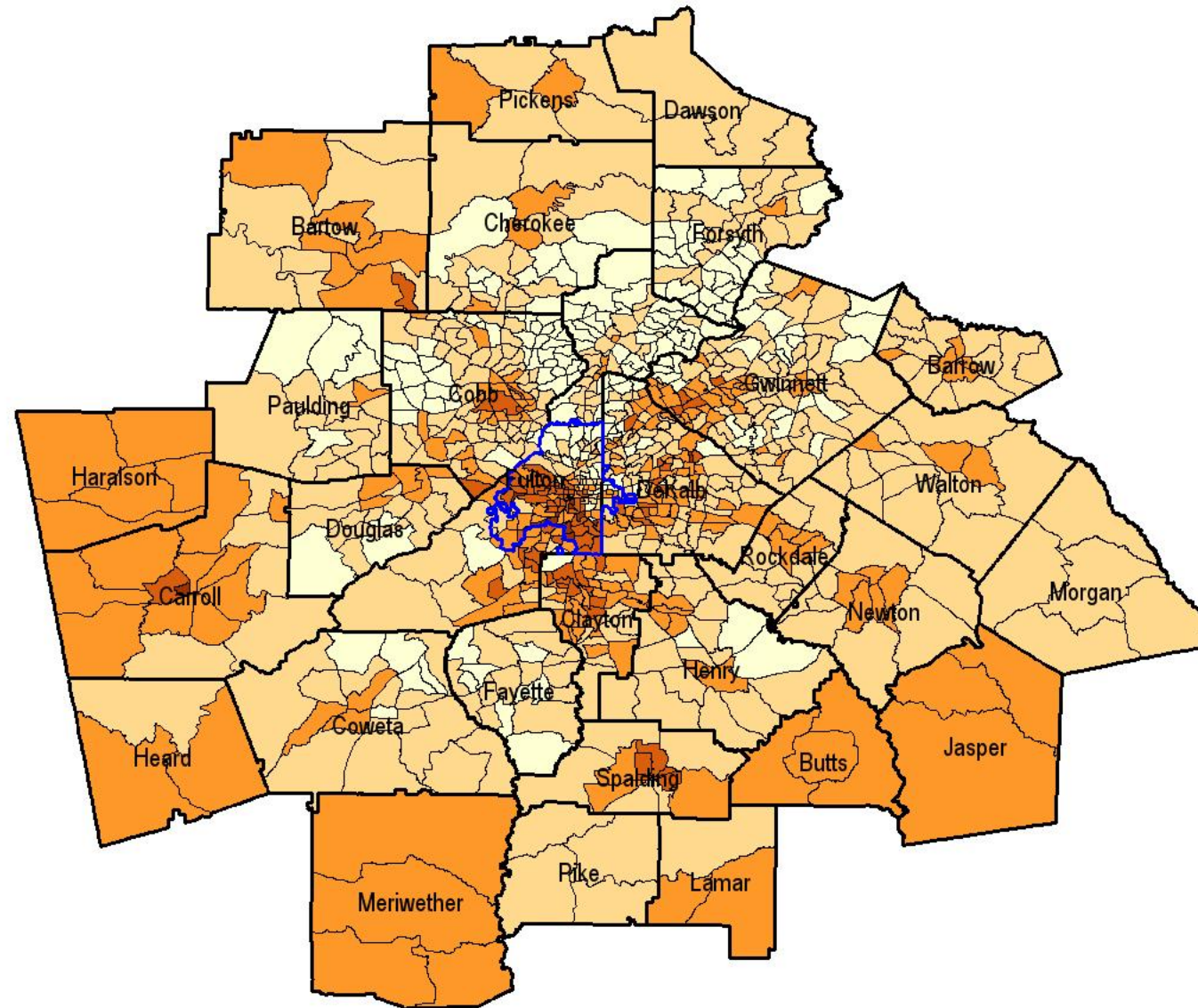


% Low Income Households 2000

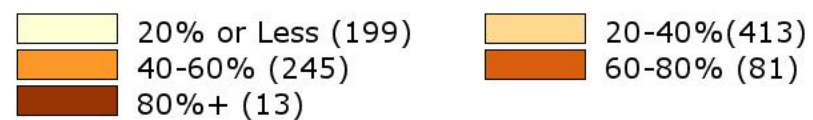

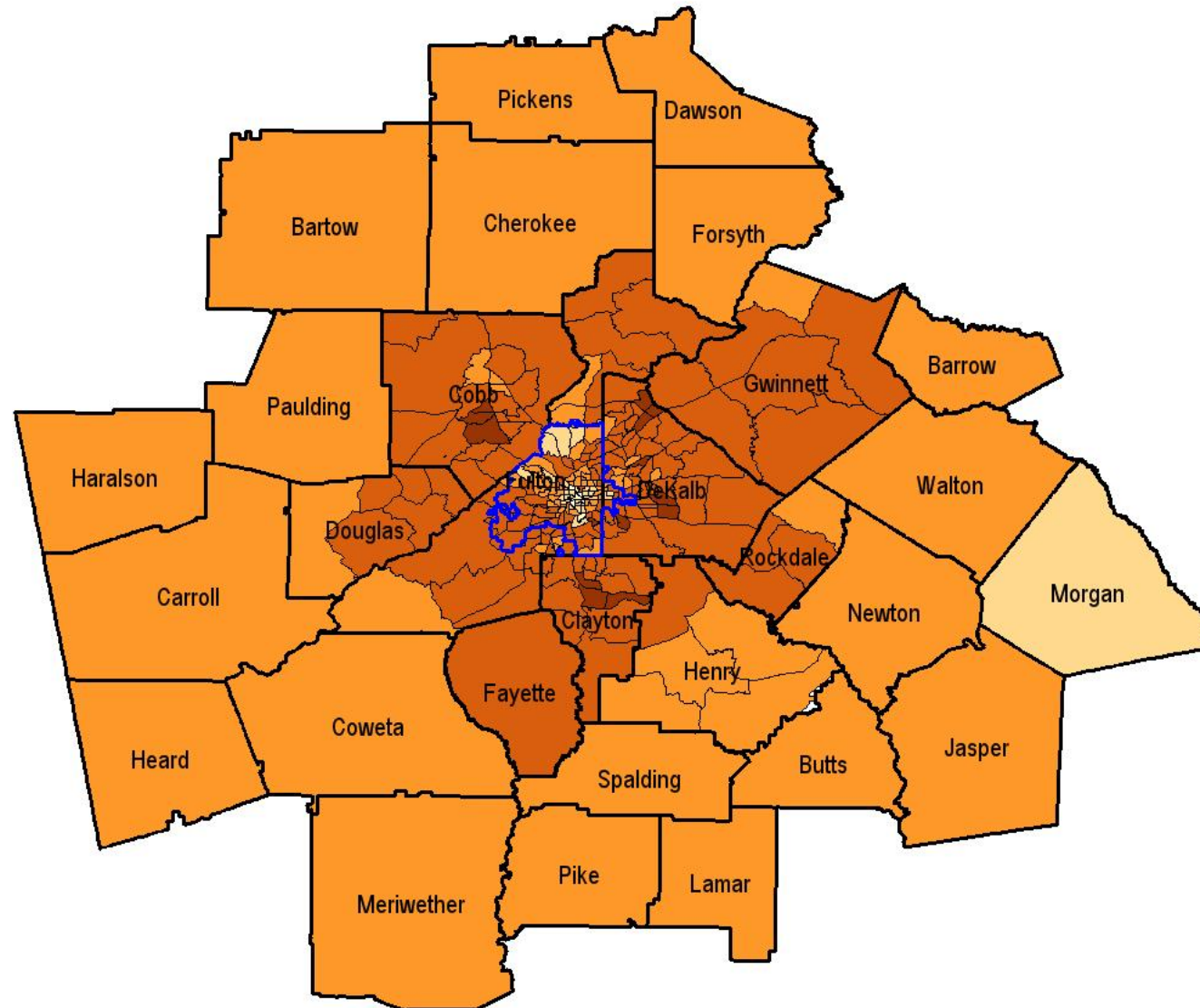


% Low Income Households 2015

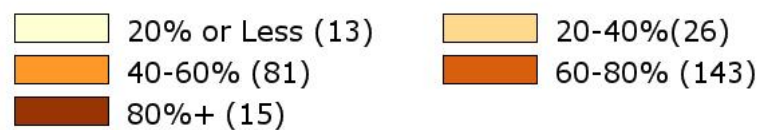

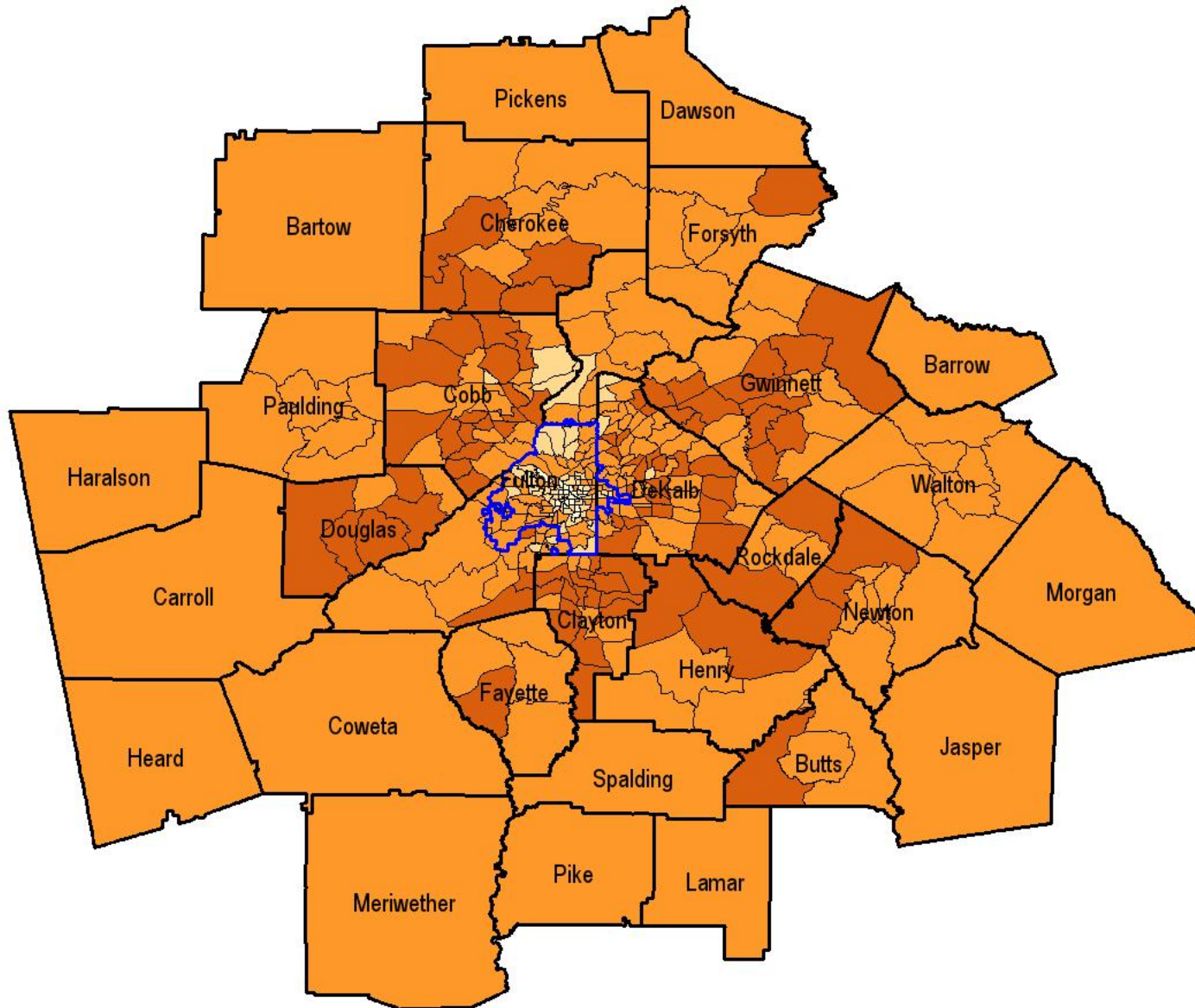


% Middle Income Families 1970

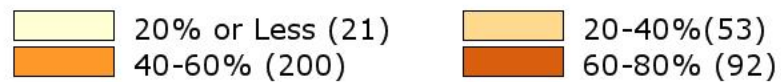

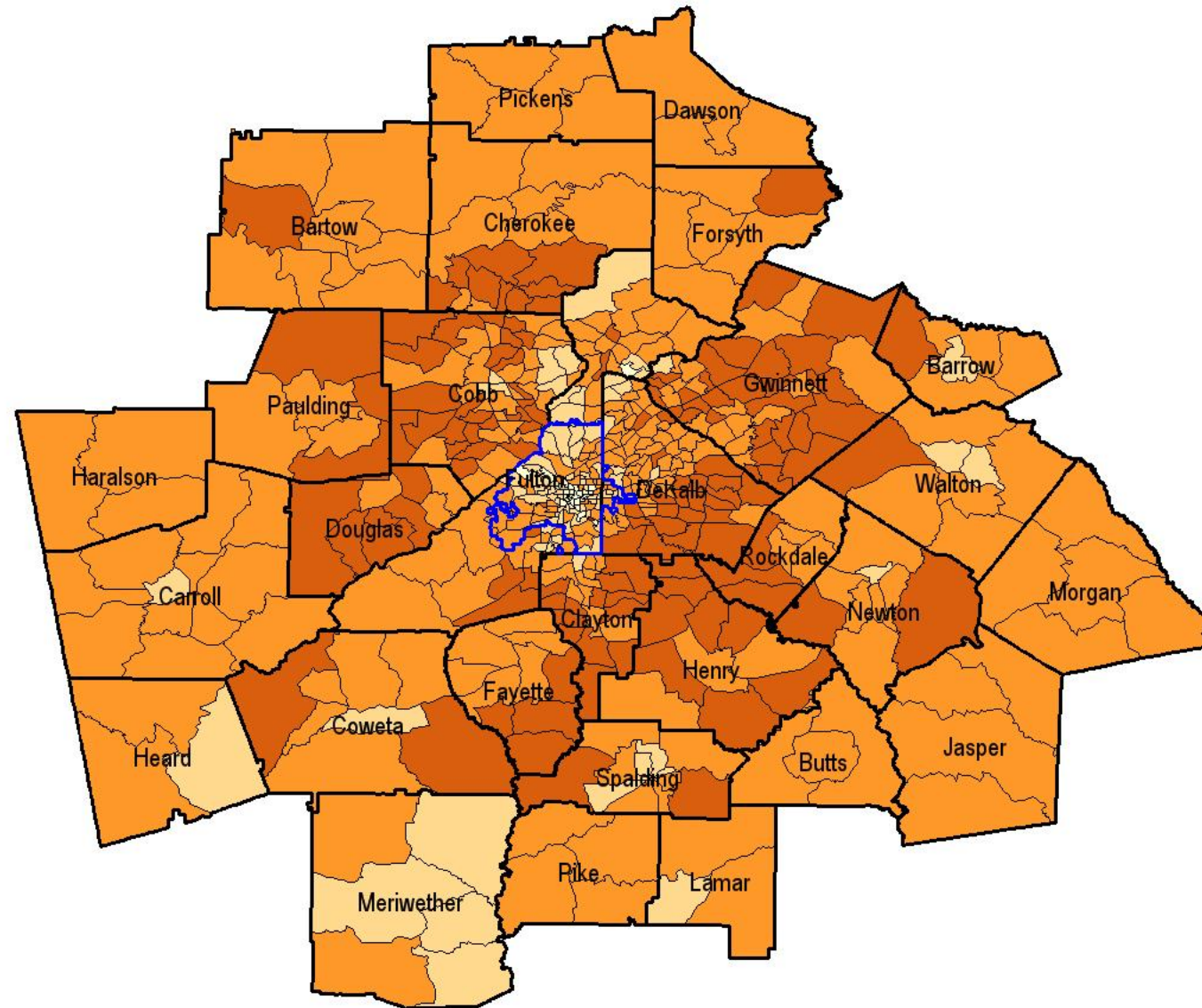


% Middle Income Households 1980

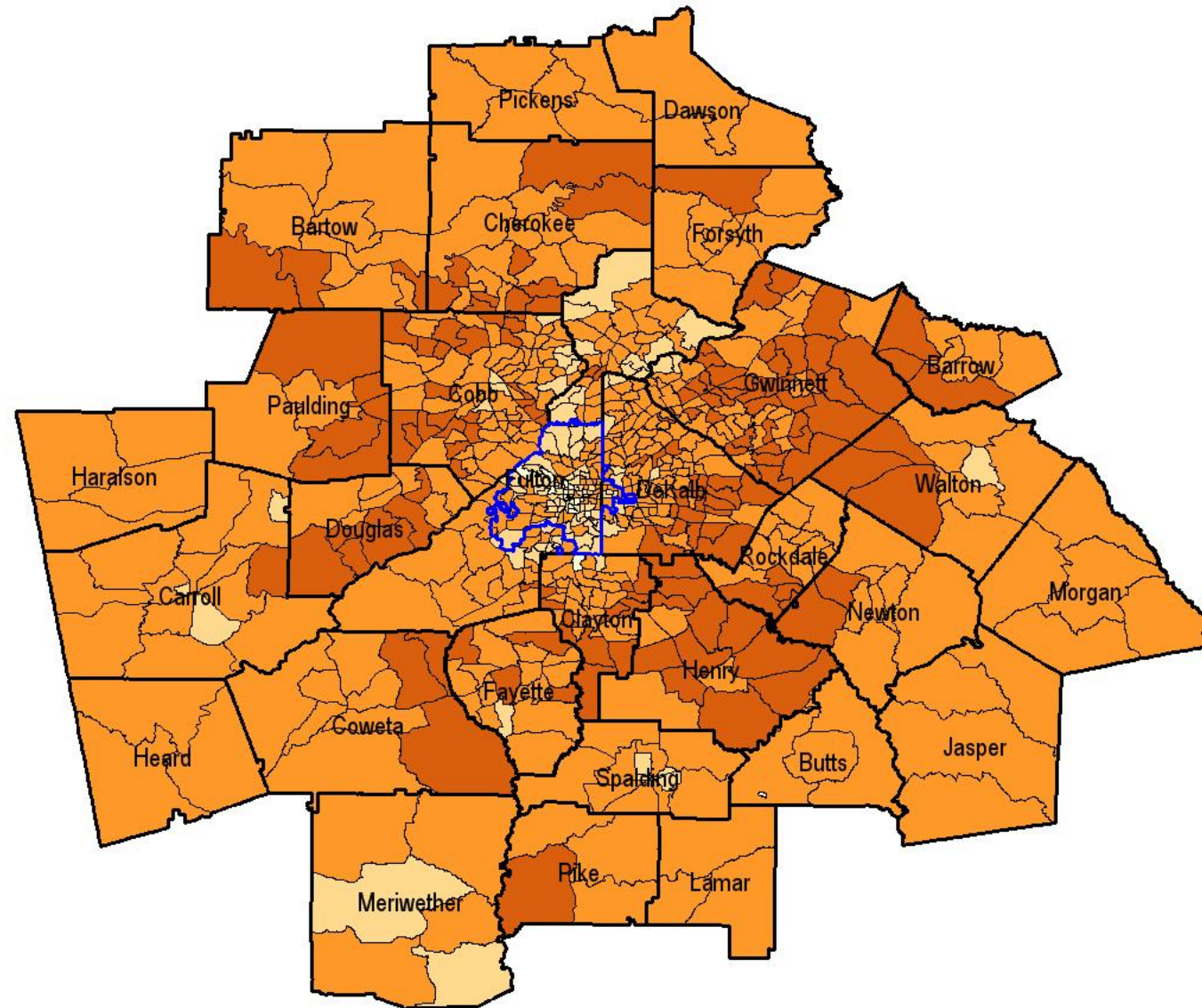


% Middle Income Households 1990

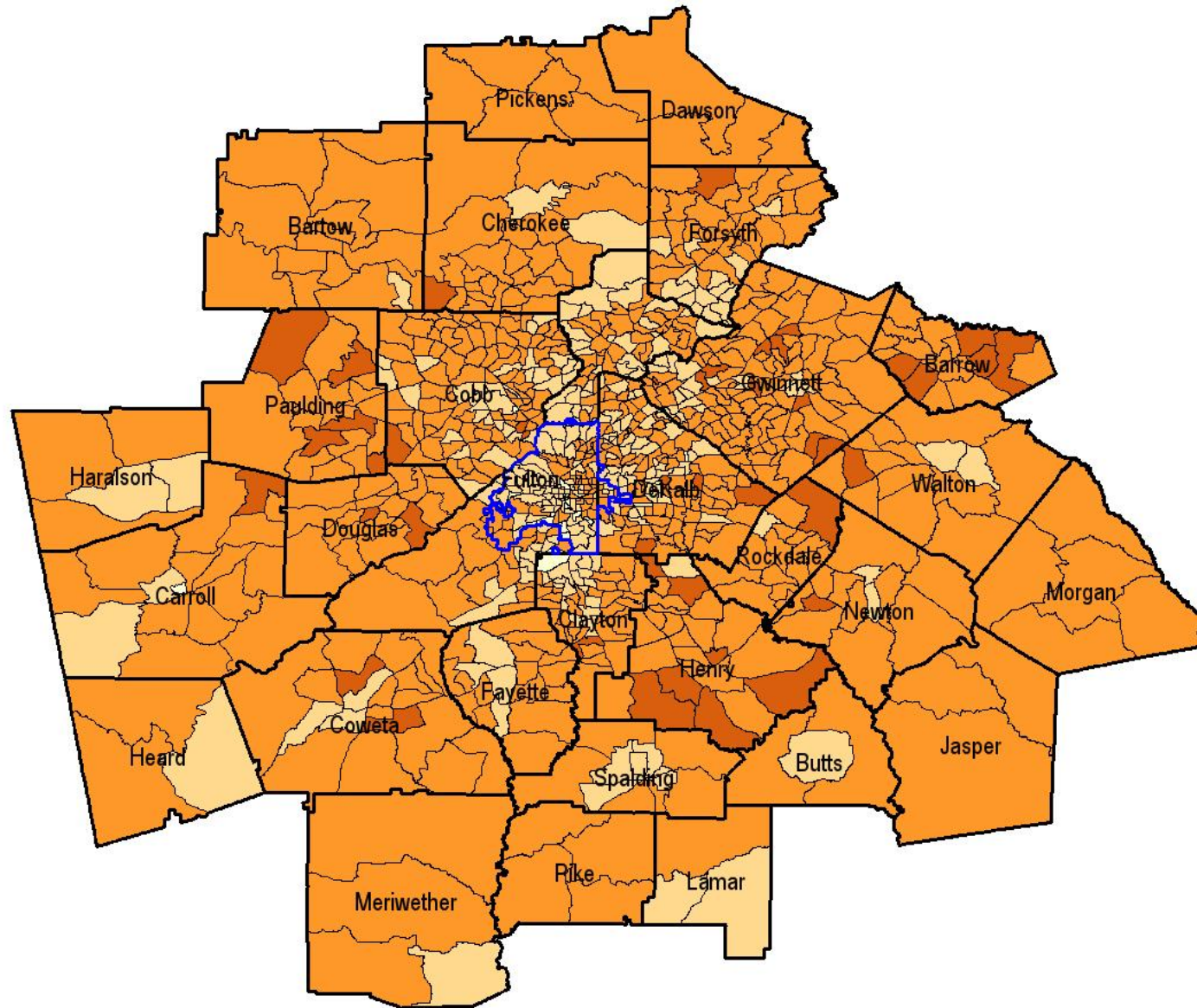


% Middle Income Households 2000

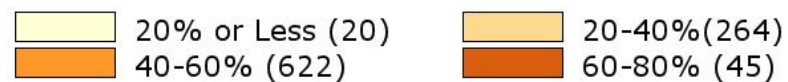

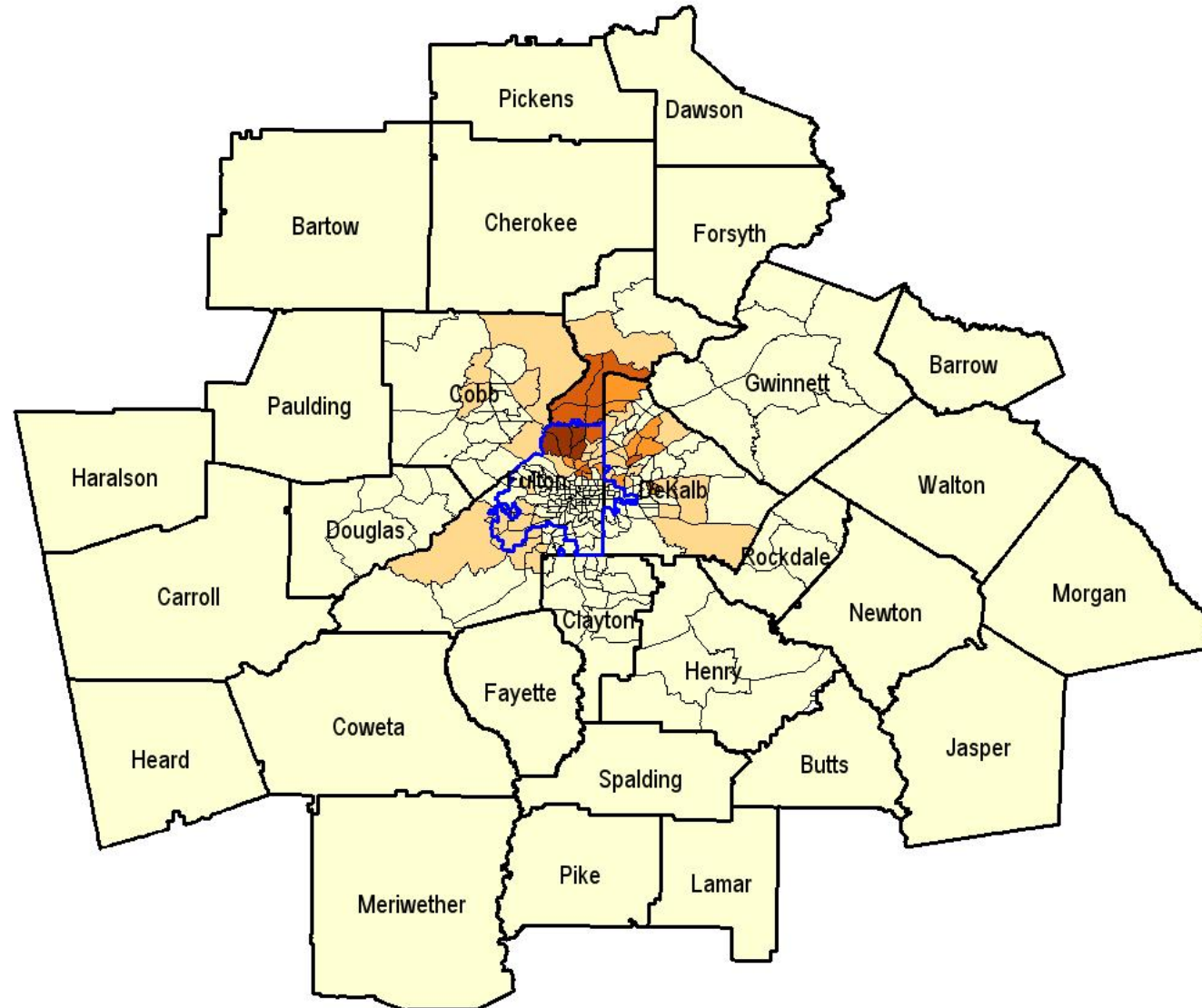


% Middle Income Households 2015

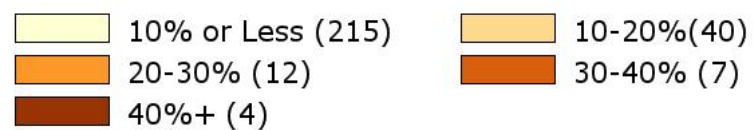

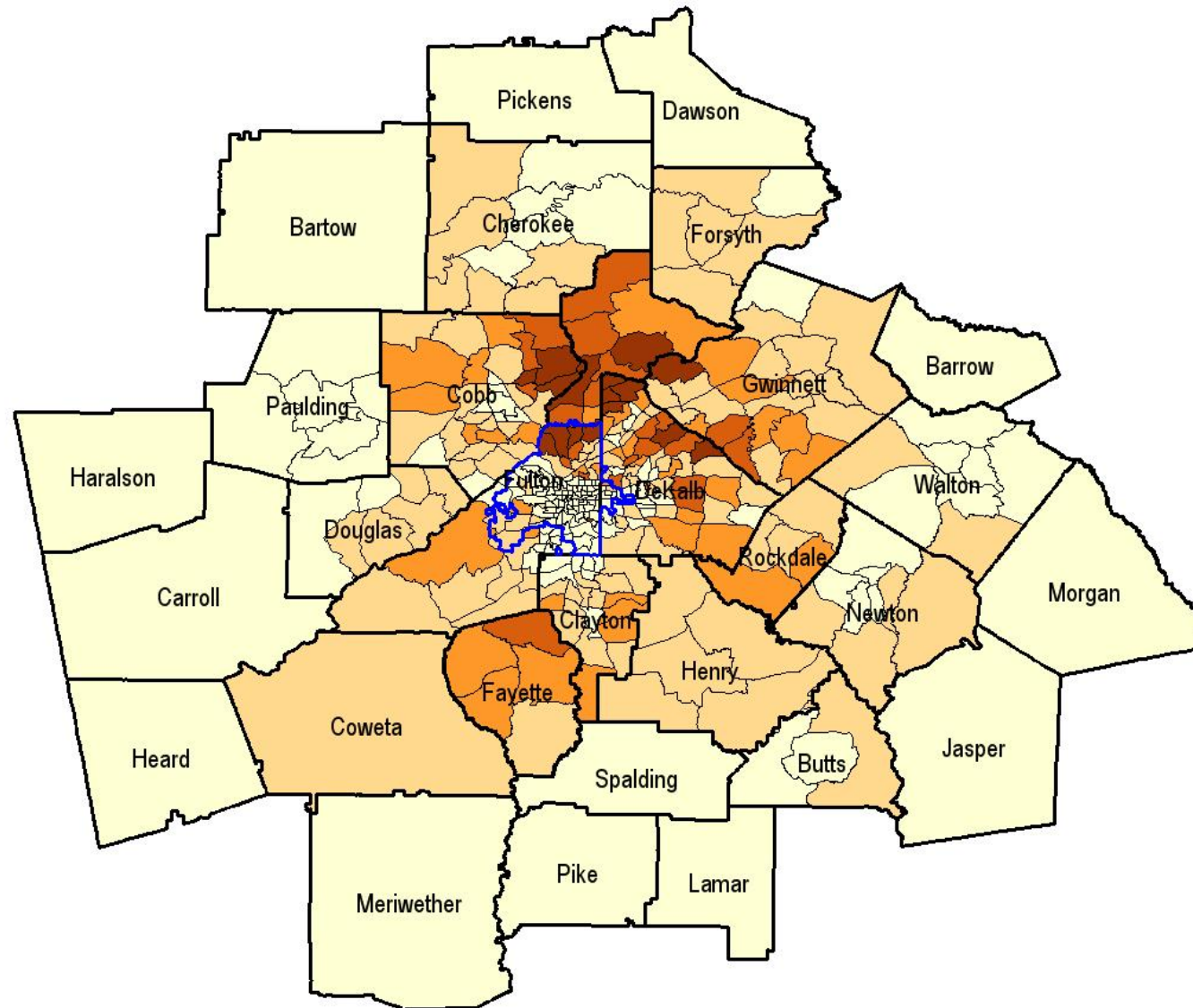


% High Income Families 1970

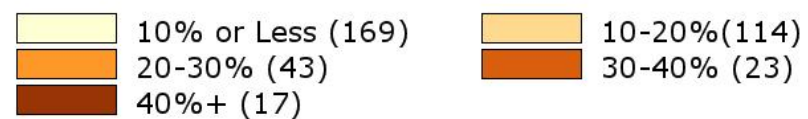

(High-Income, 1980)

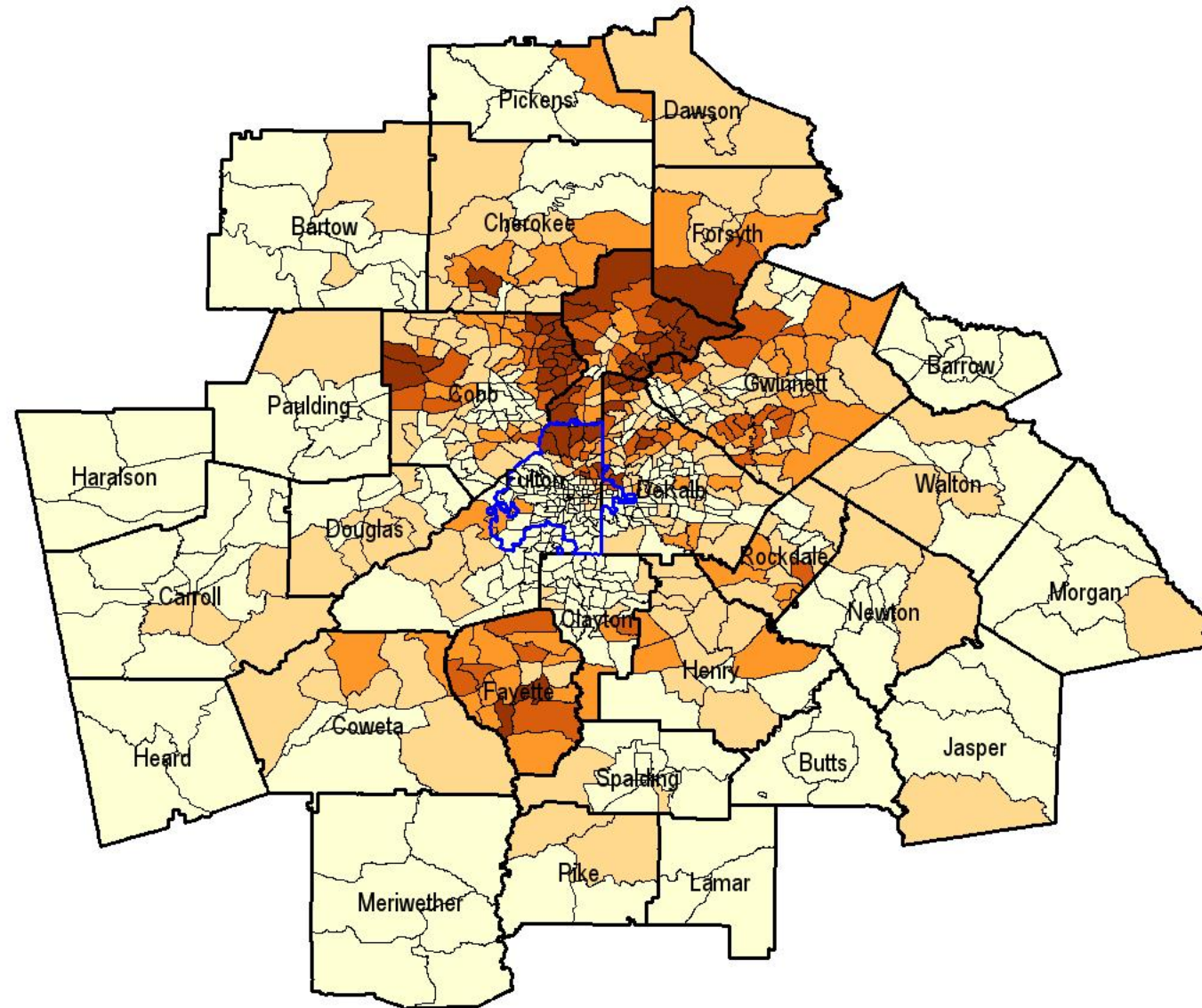


% High Income Households 1980

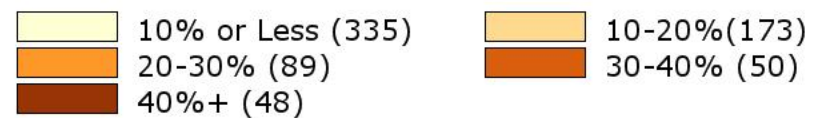

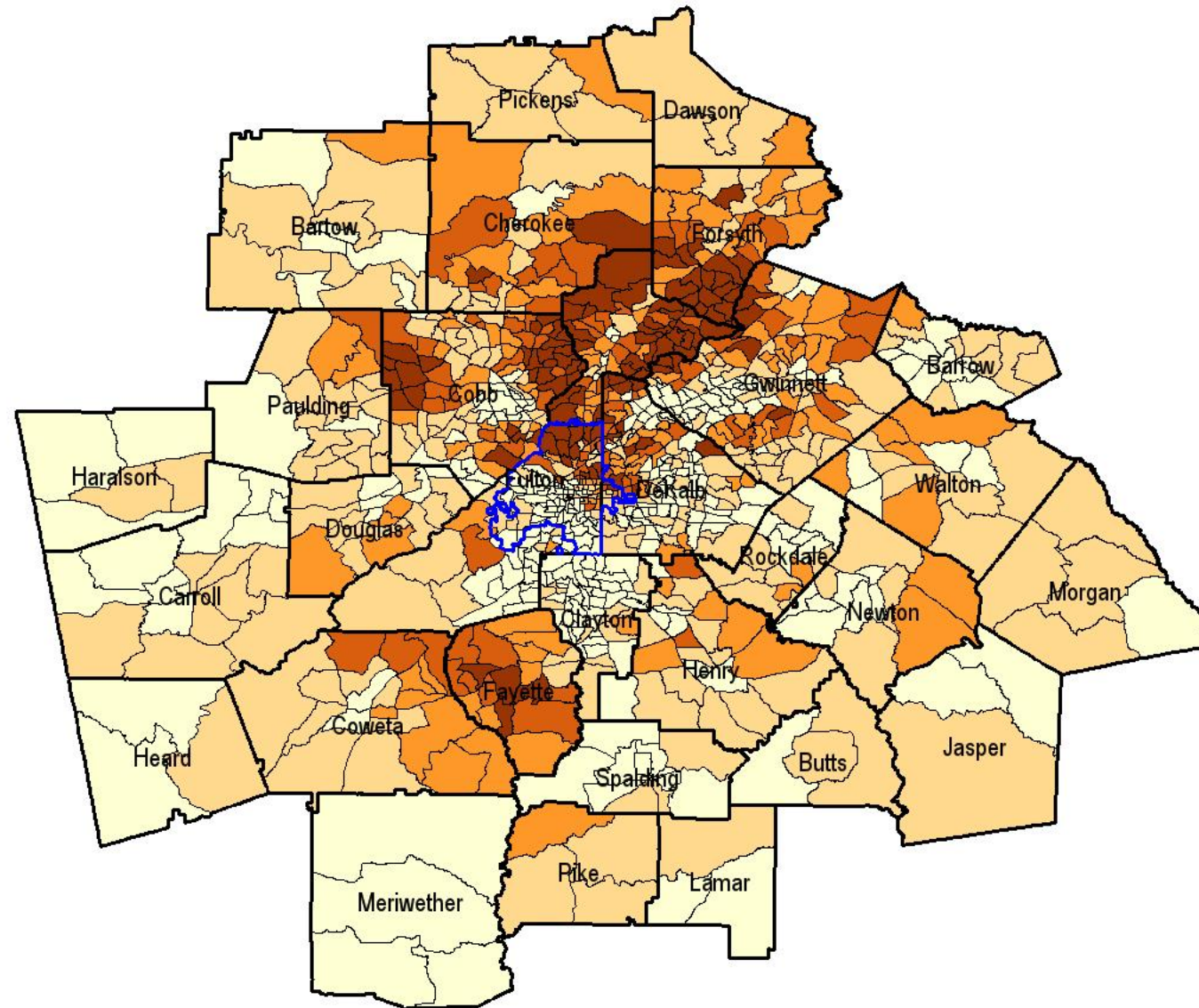


% High Income Households 2000

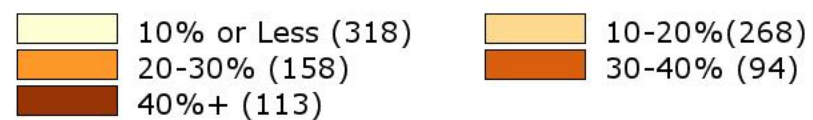

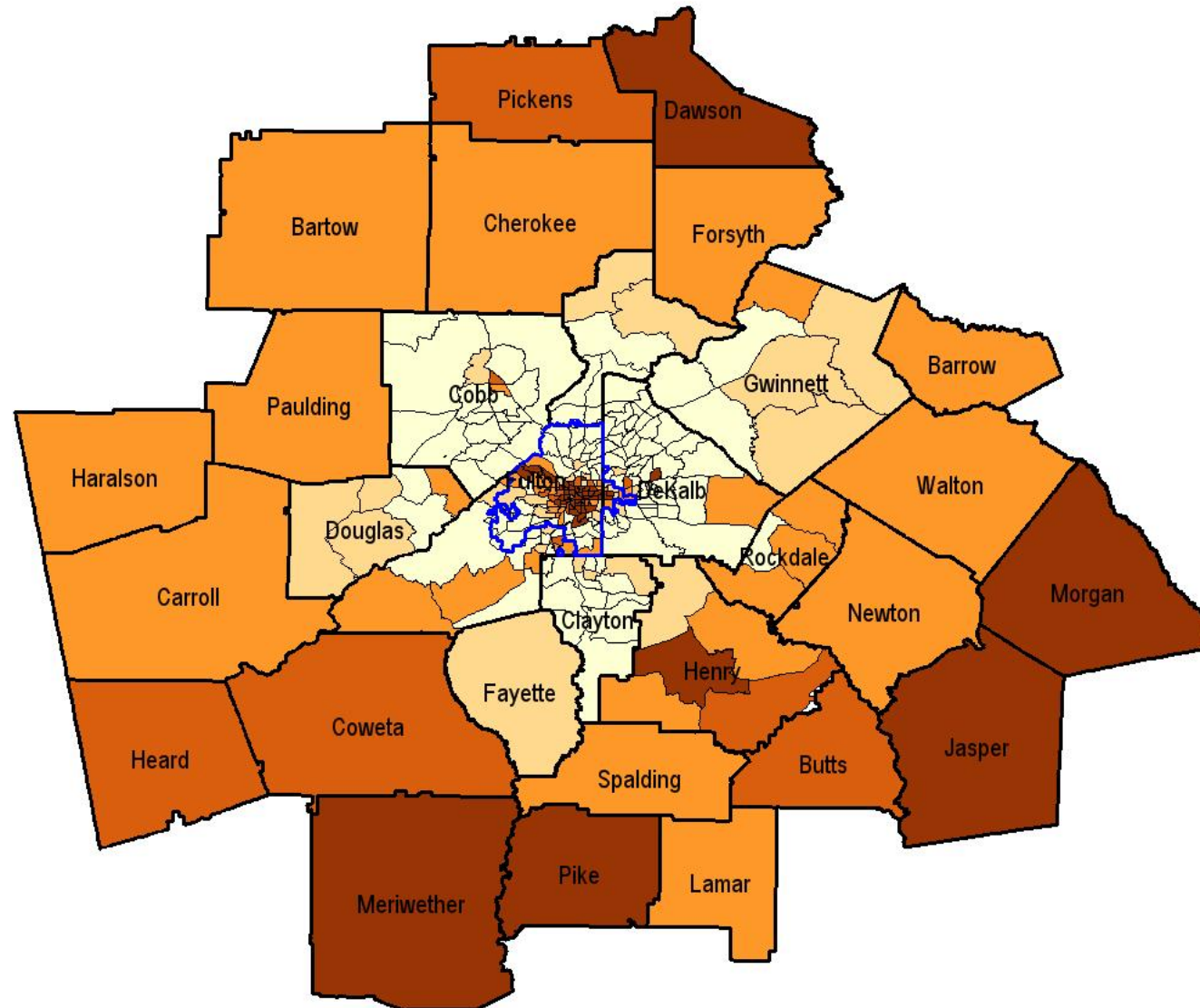


% High Income Households 2015

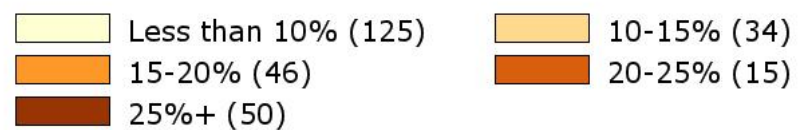

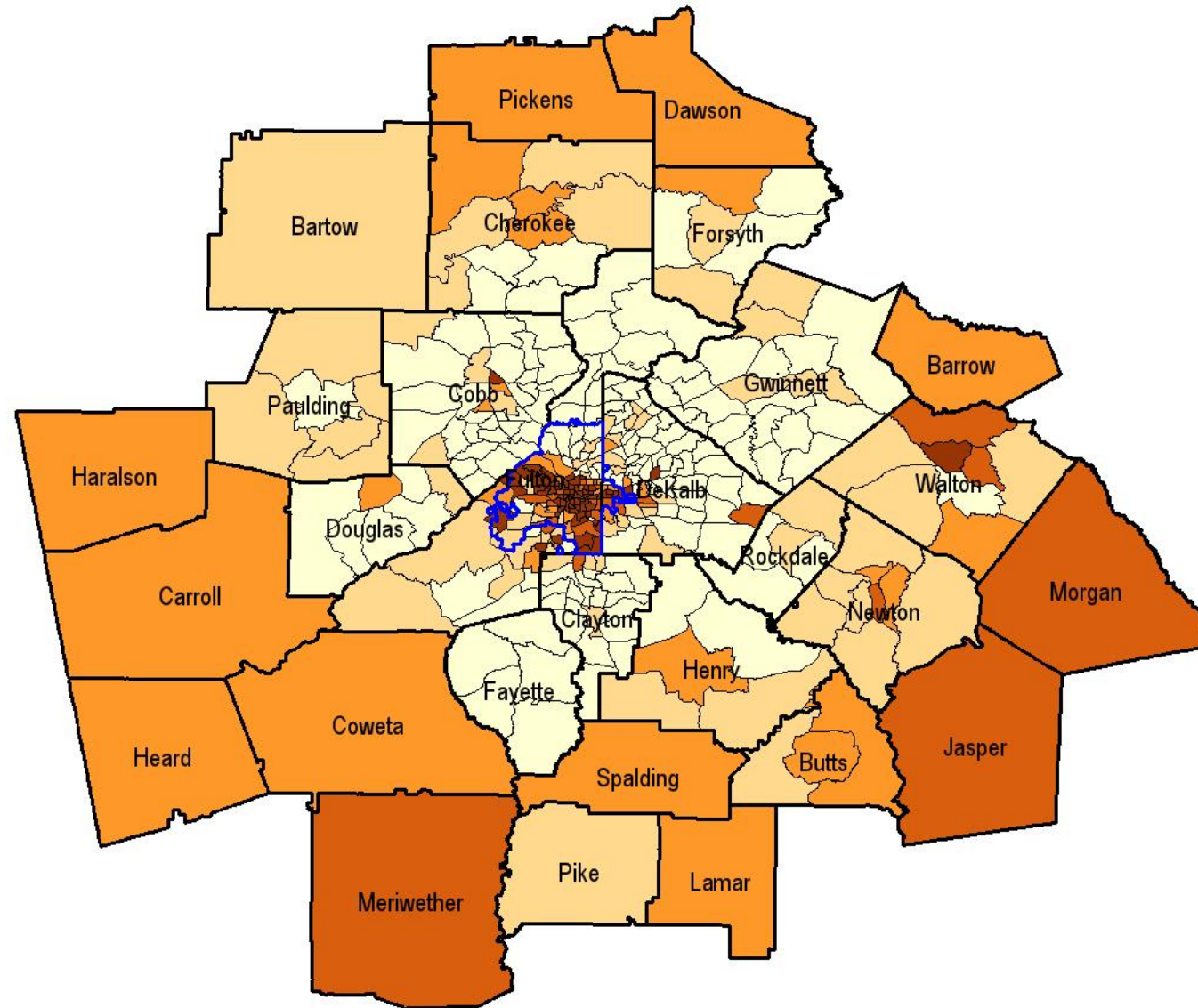


% Population below Poverty 1970

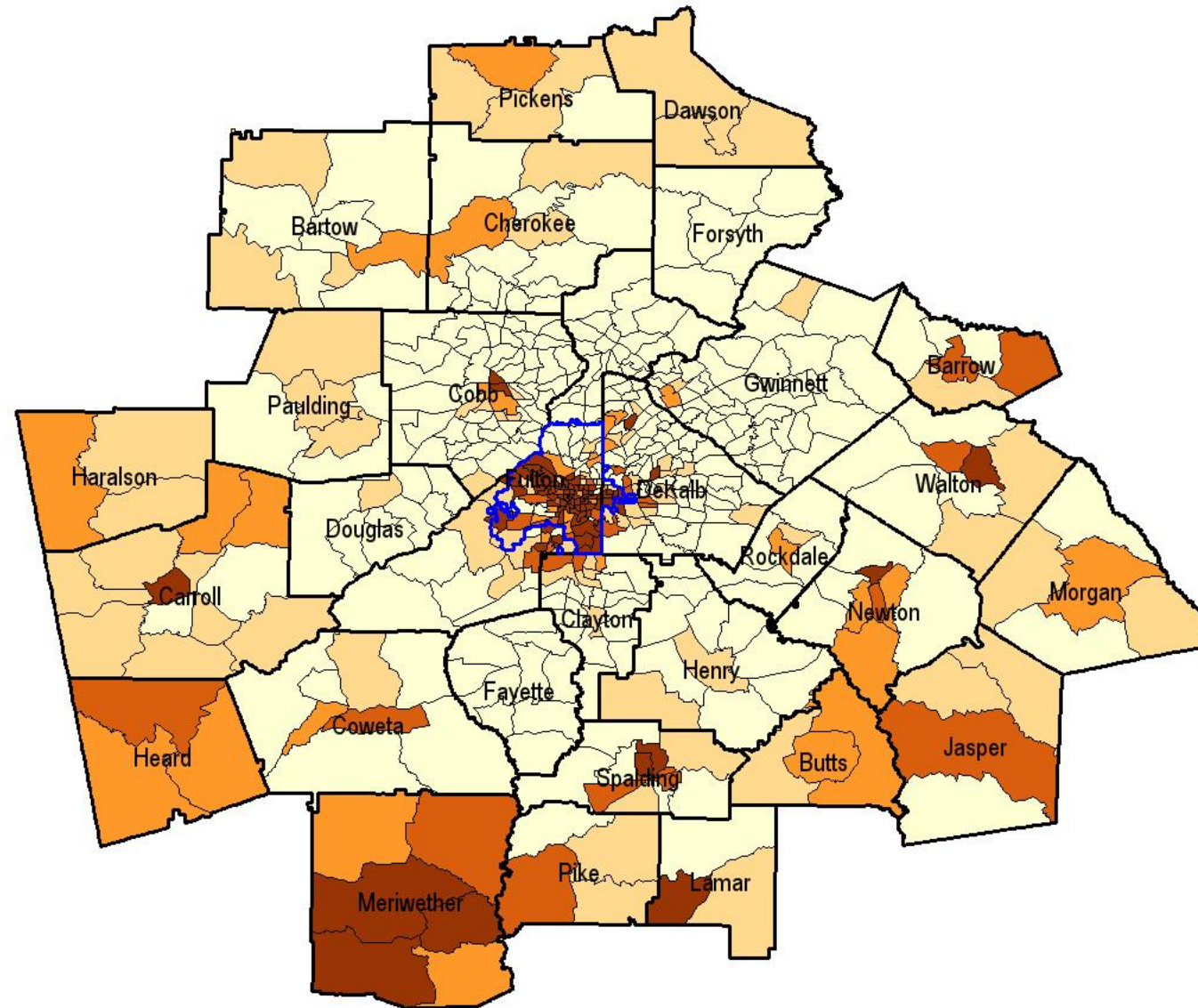


% Population below Poverty 1980

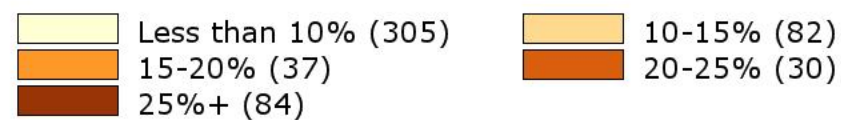

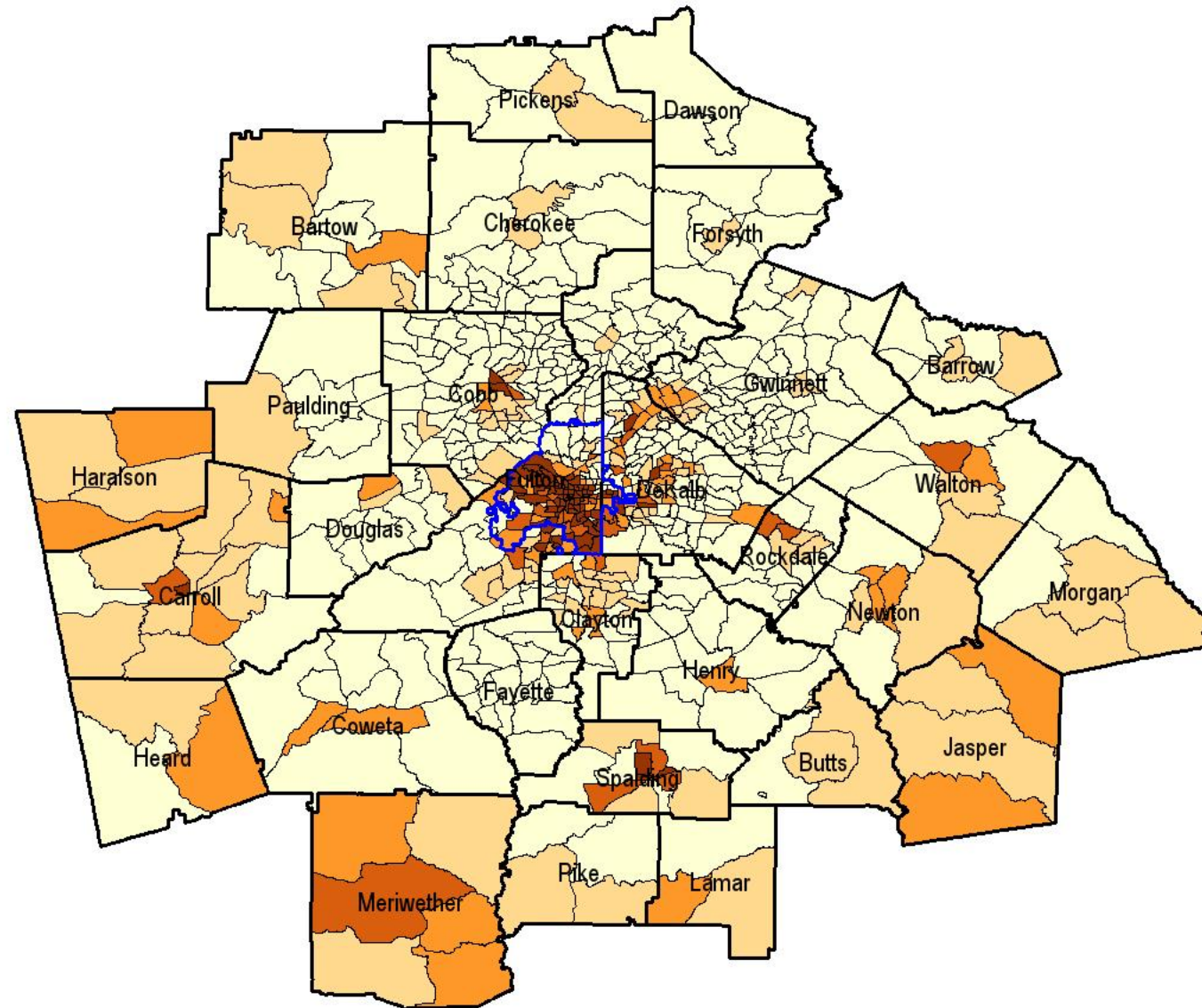


% Population below Poverty 1990

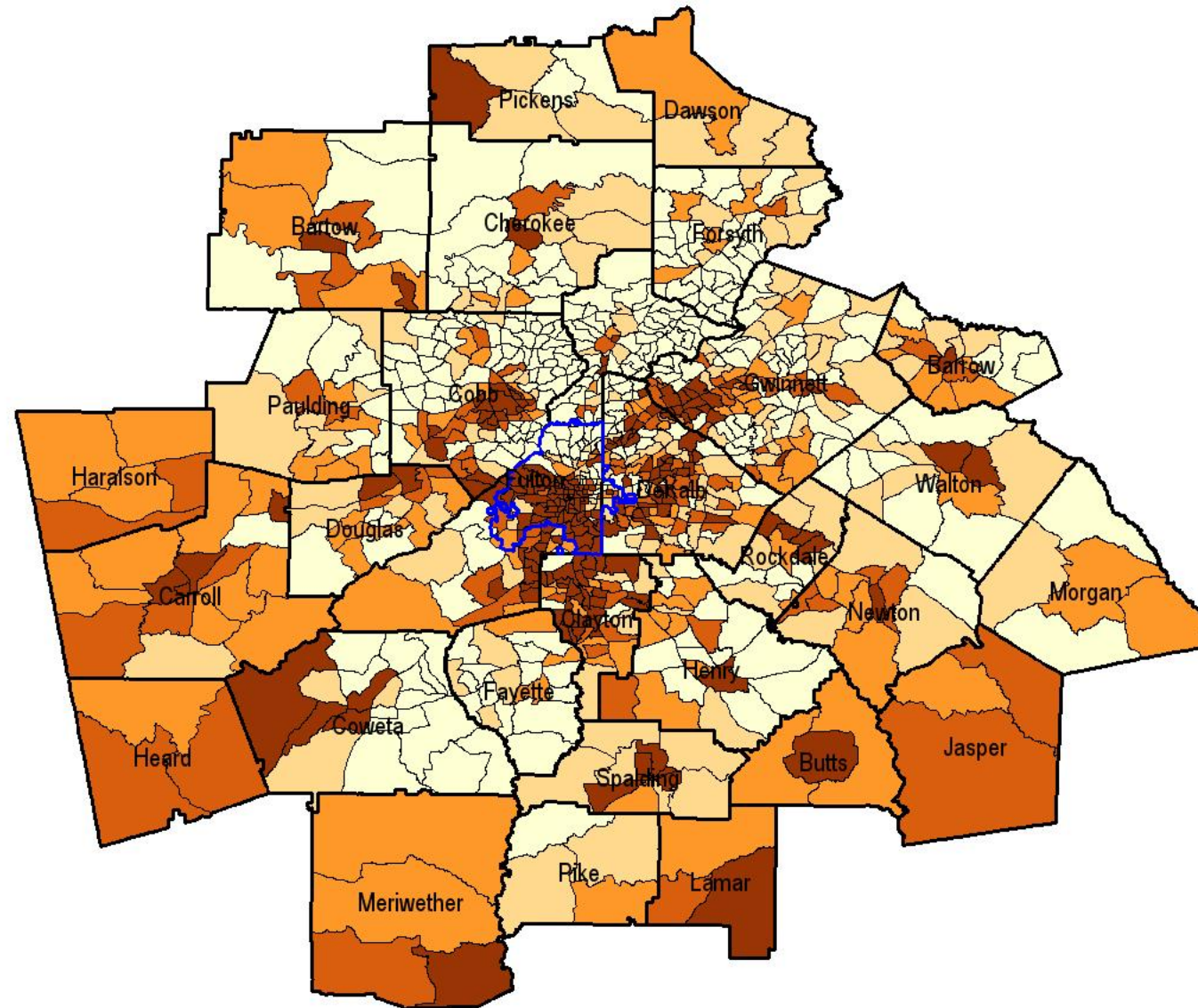


% Population below Poverty 2000

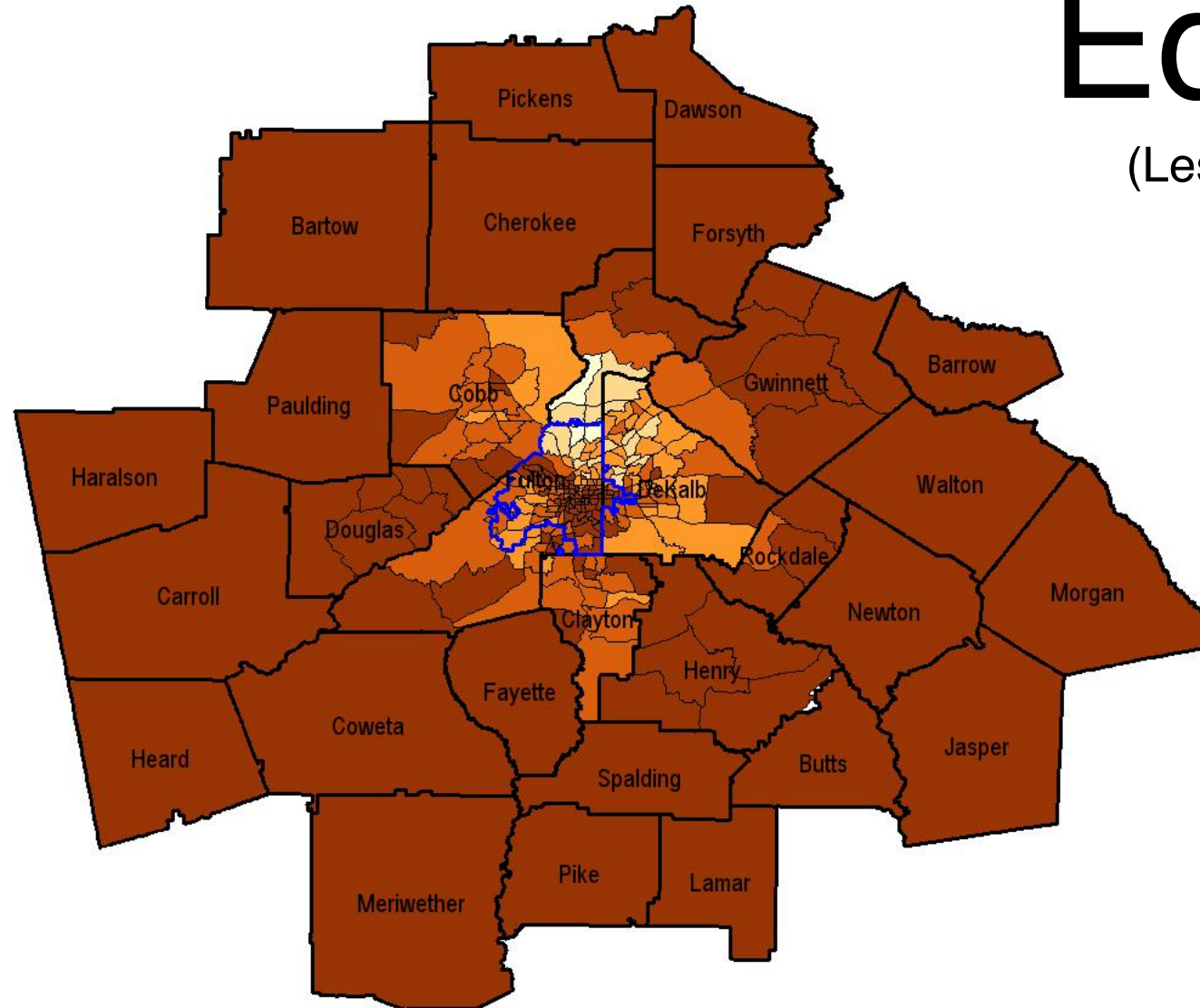


% Population below Poverty 2015

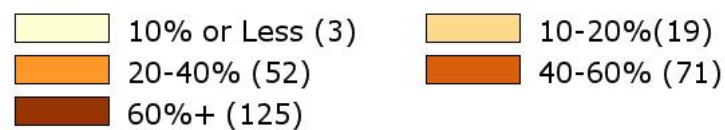

(Less than high school, 1970)

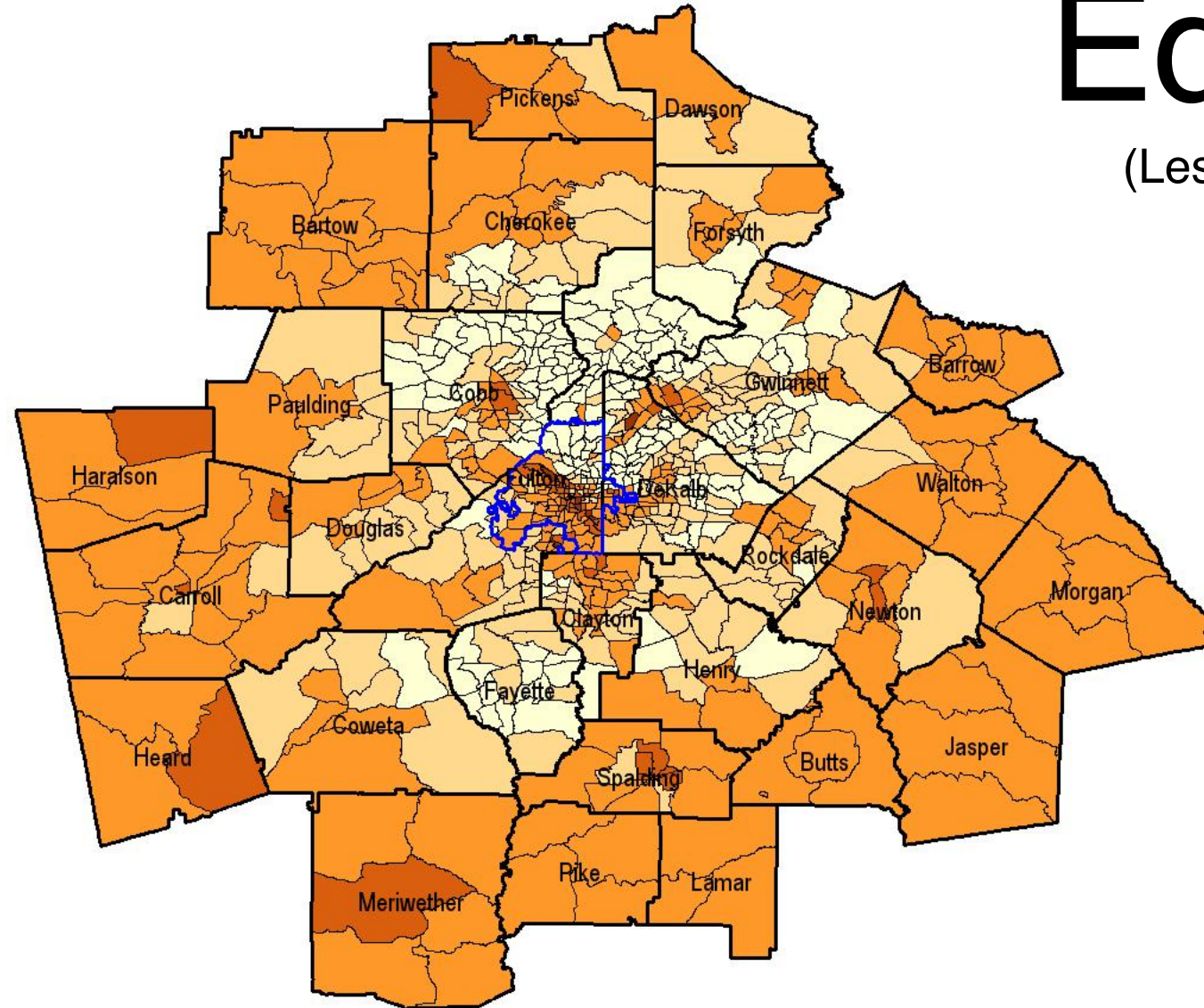


Percent Population of Age 25+ with Less than HS Education 1970

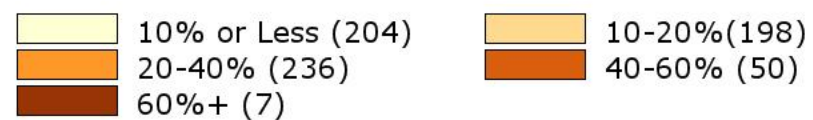

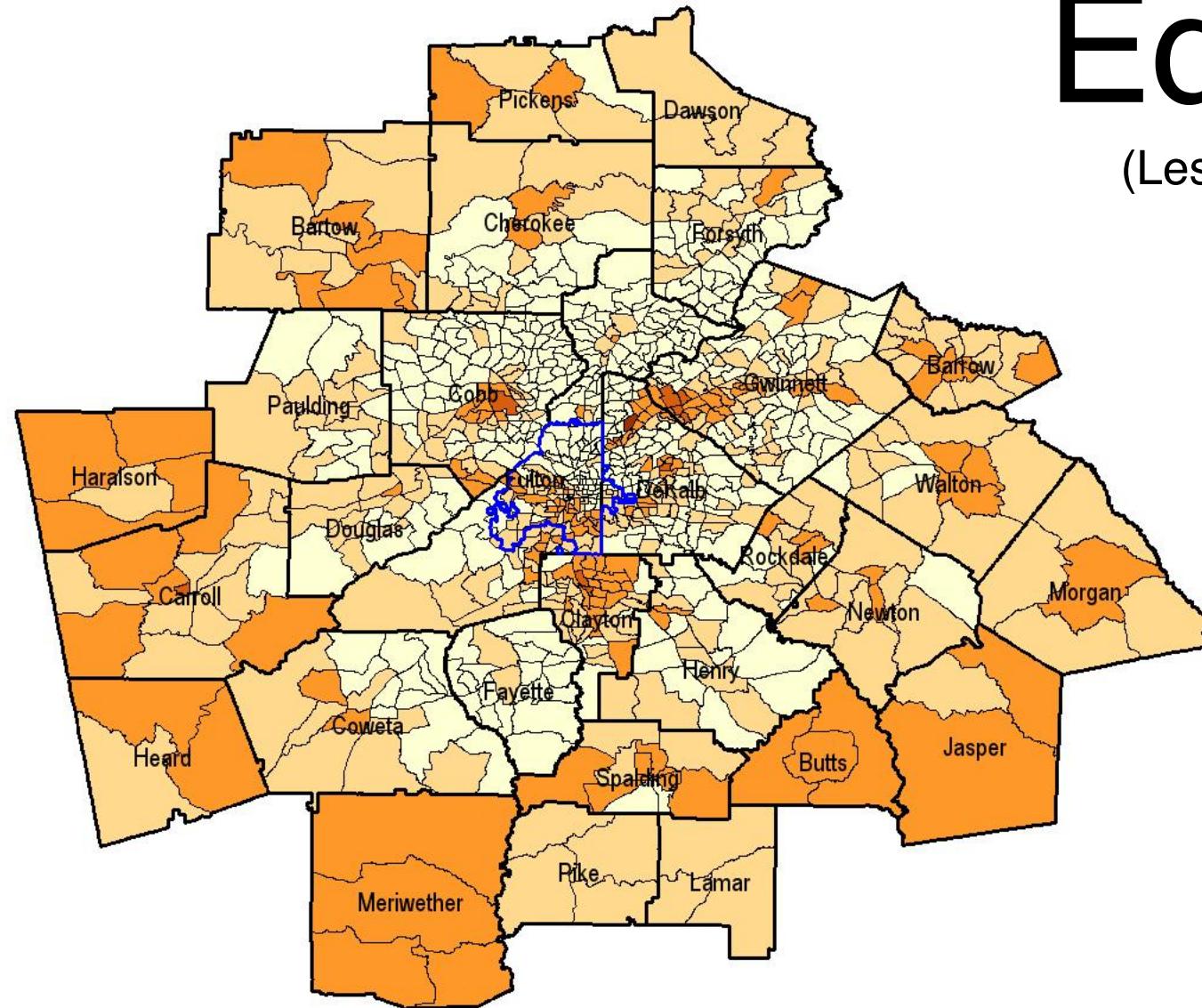


Percent Population of Age 25+ with Less than HS Education 2000

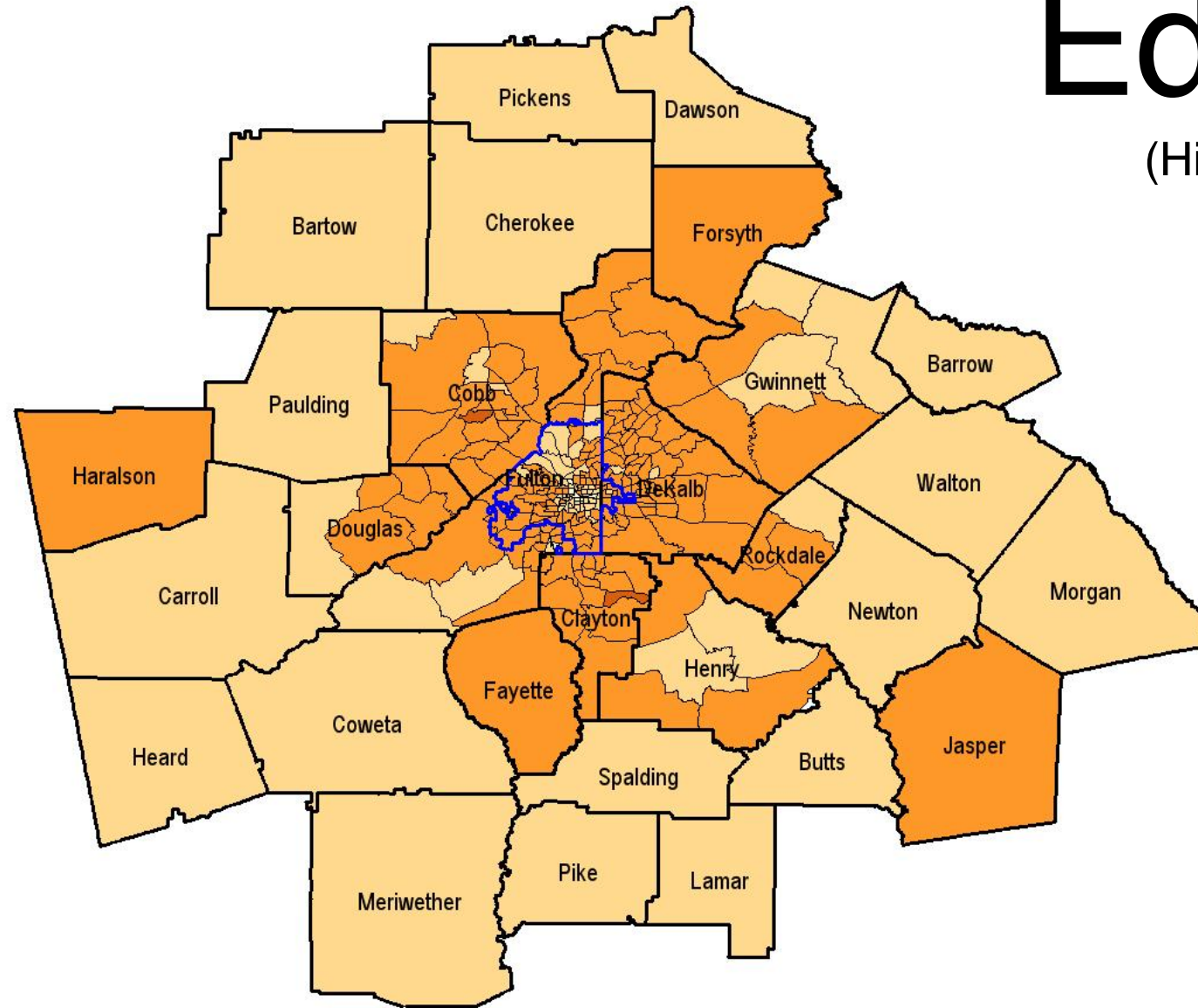


Percent Population of Age 25+ with Less than HS Education 2015

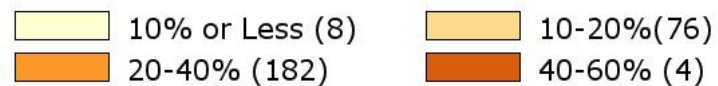

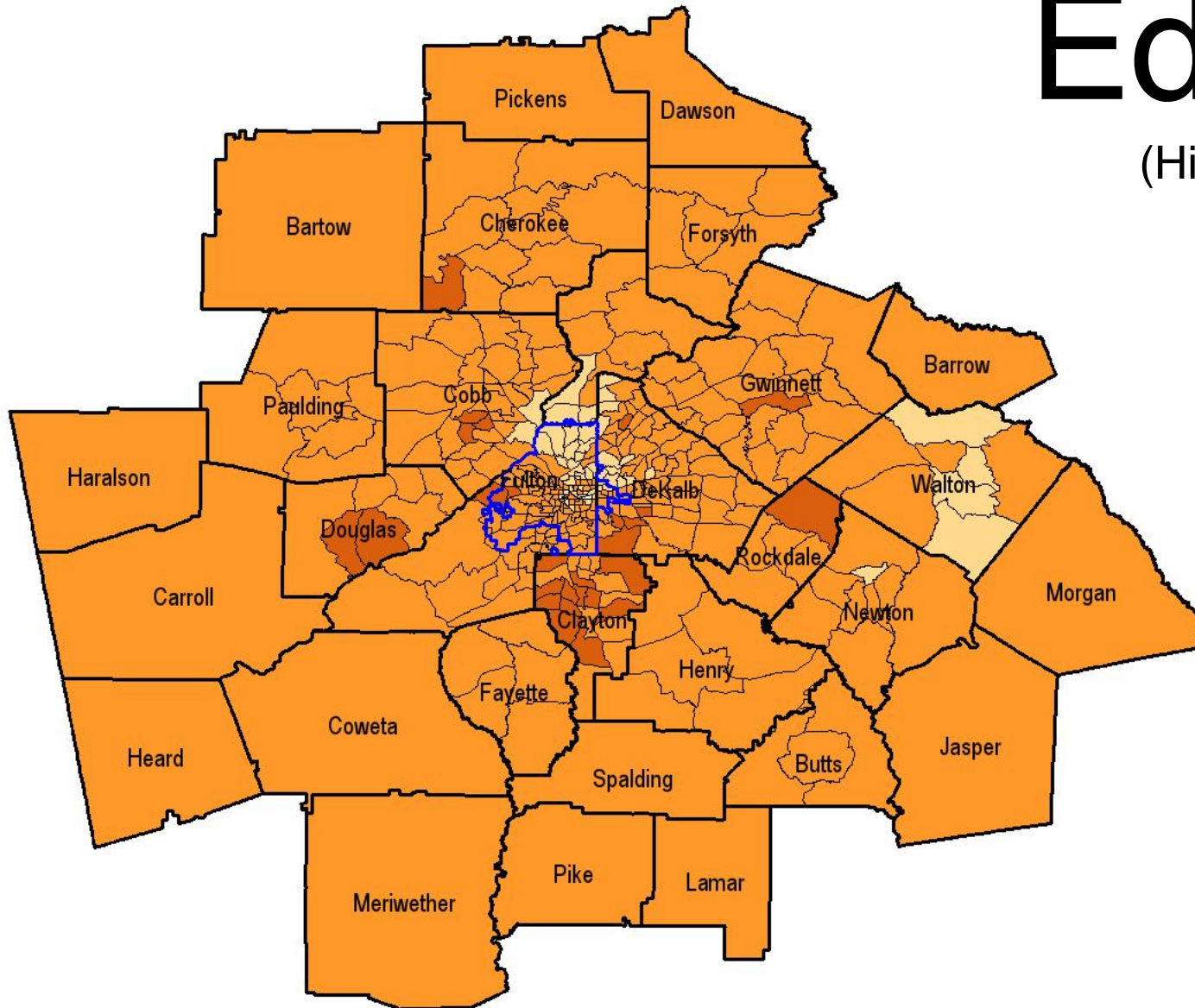


Percent Population of Age 25+ with HS/GED Education 1970

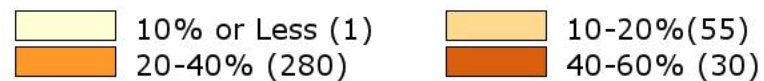

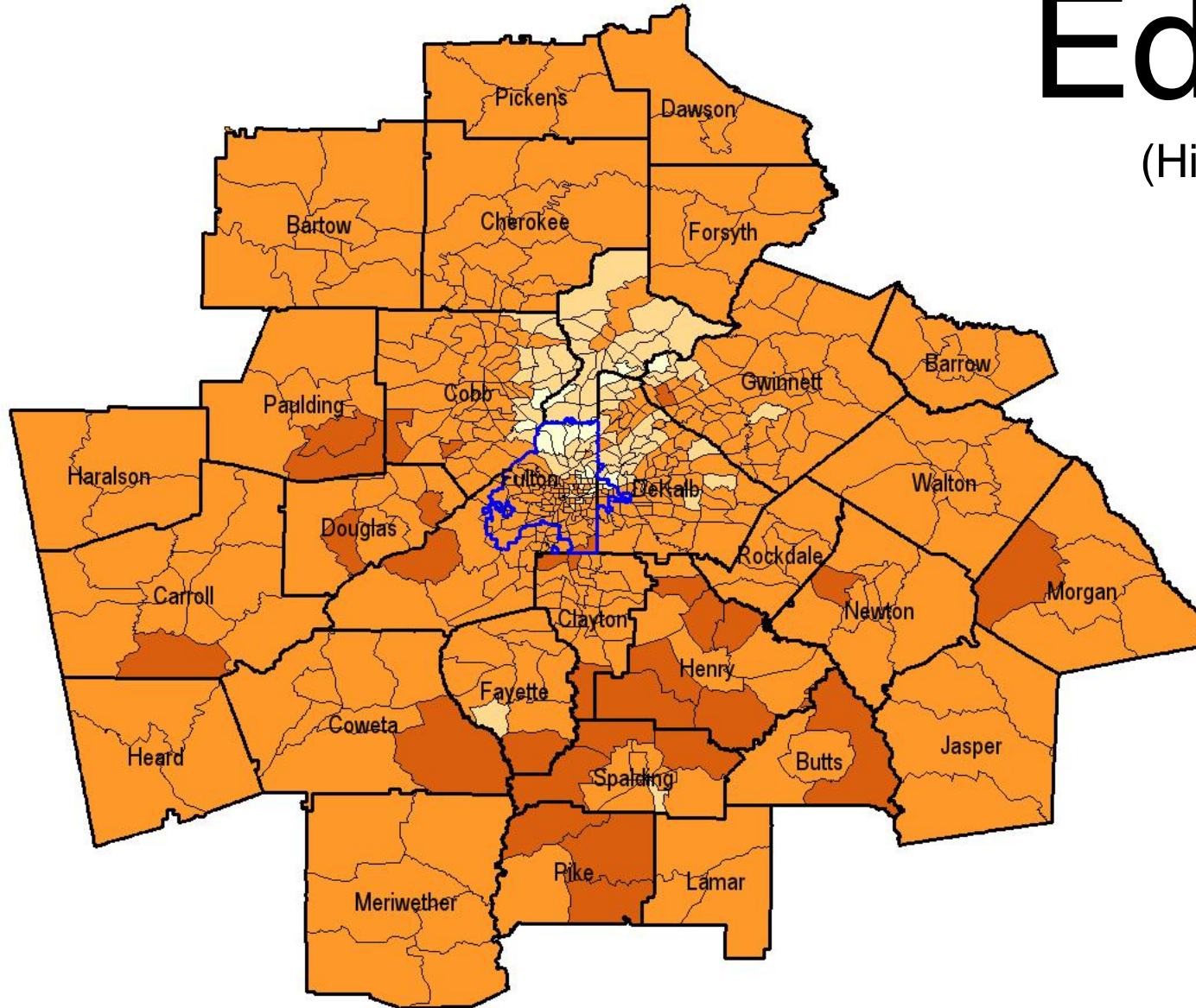


Percent Population of Age 25+ with HS/GED Education 1980

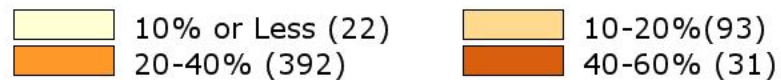

(High school or GED, 1990)

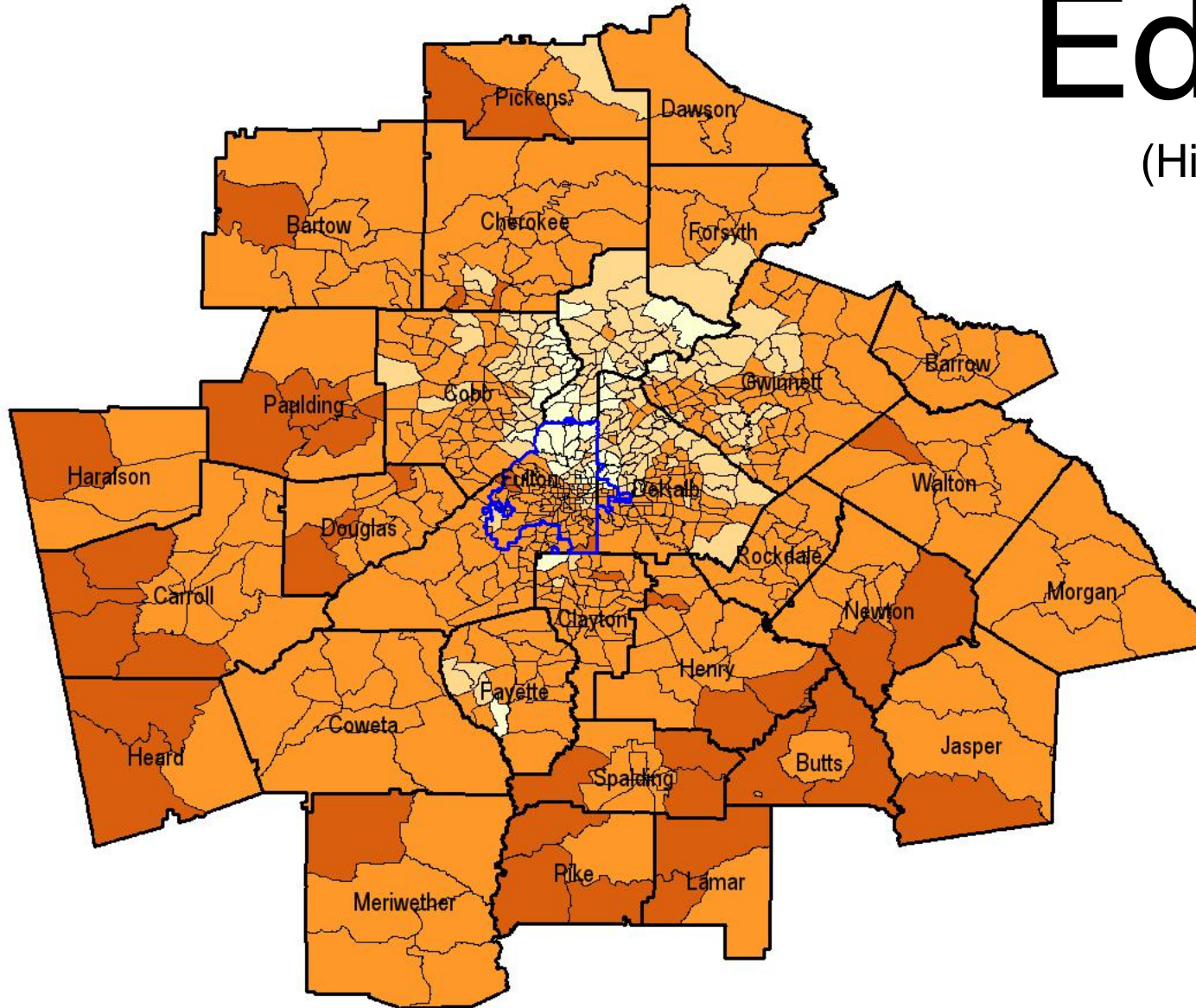


Percent Population of Age 25+ with HS/GED Education 1990

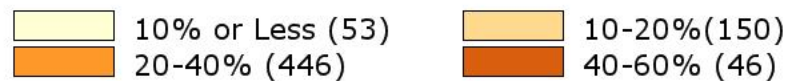

(High school or GED, 2000)

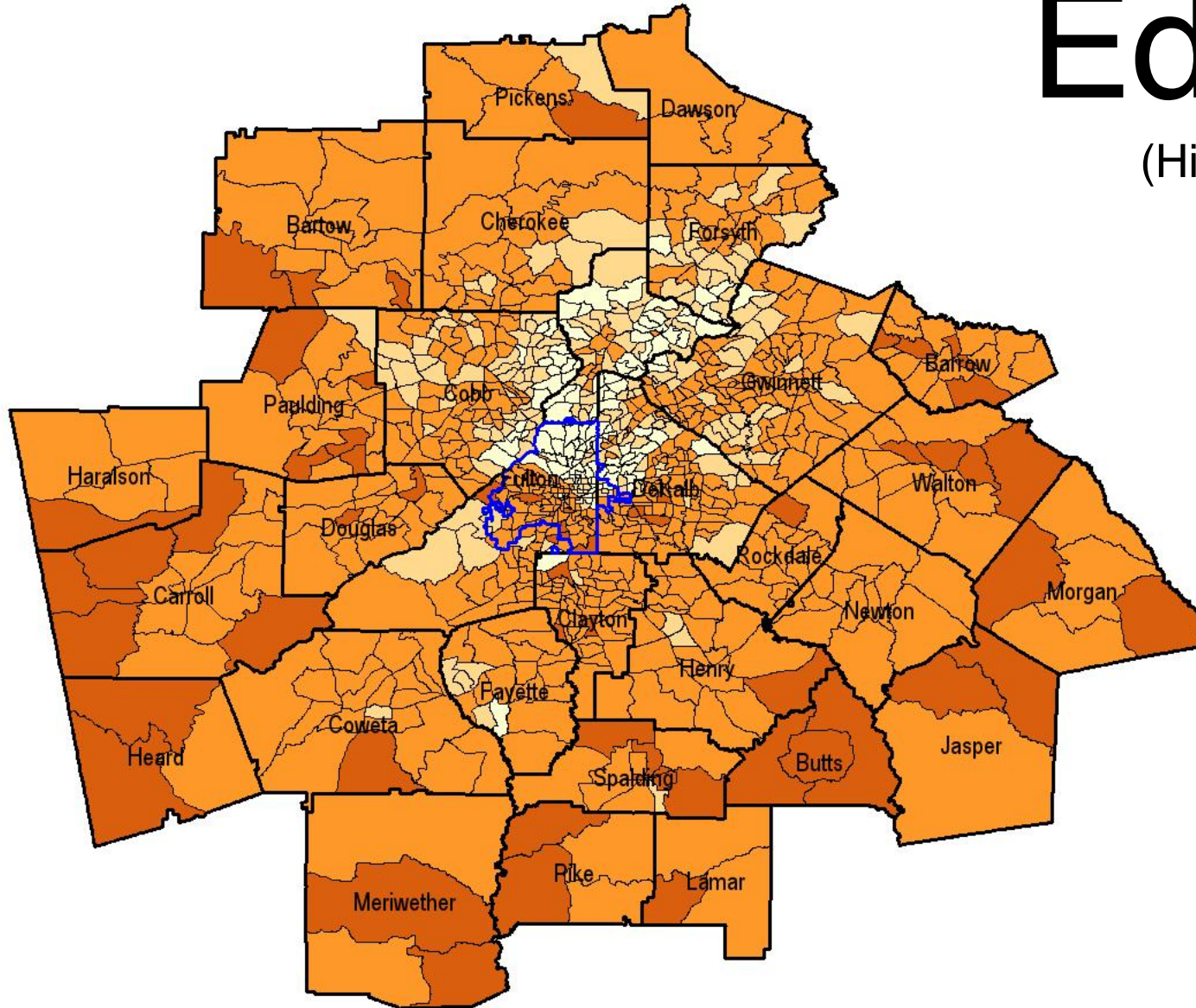


Percent Population of Age 25+ with HS/GED Education 2000

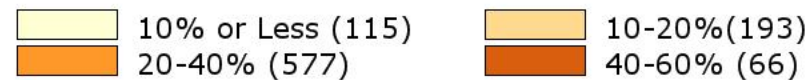

(High school or GED, 2015)

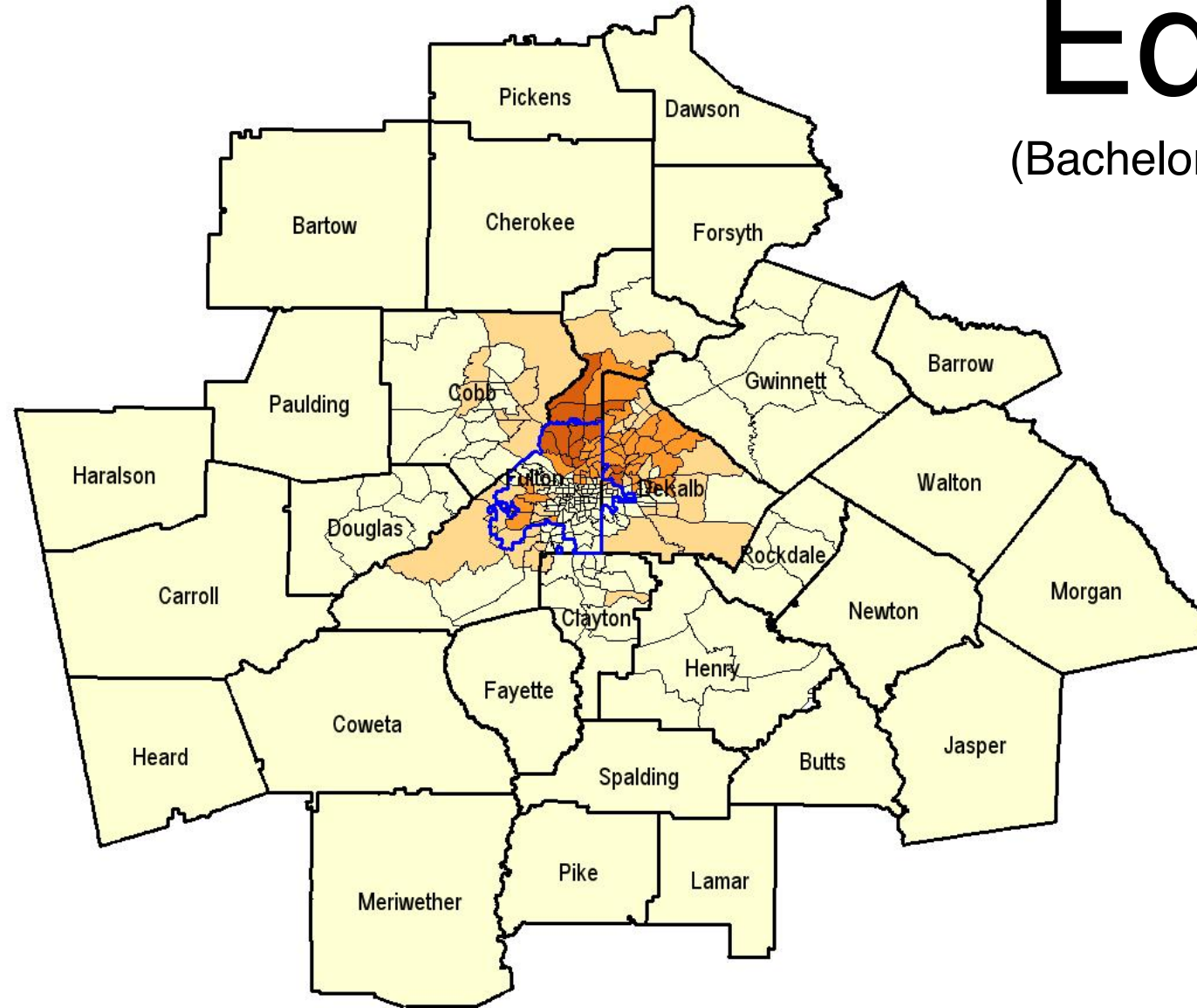


Percent Population of Age 25+ with HS/GED Education 2015

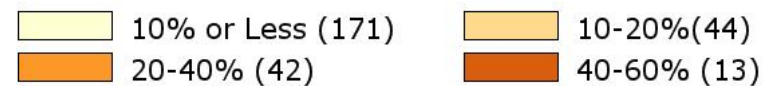

(Bachelor's degree or more, 1970)

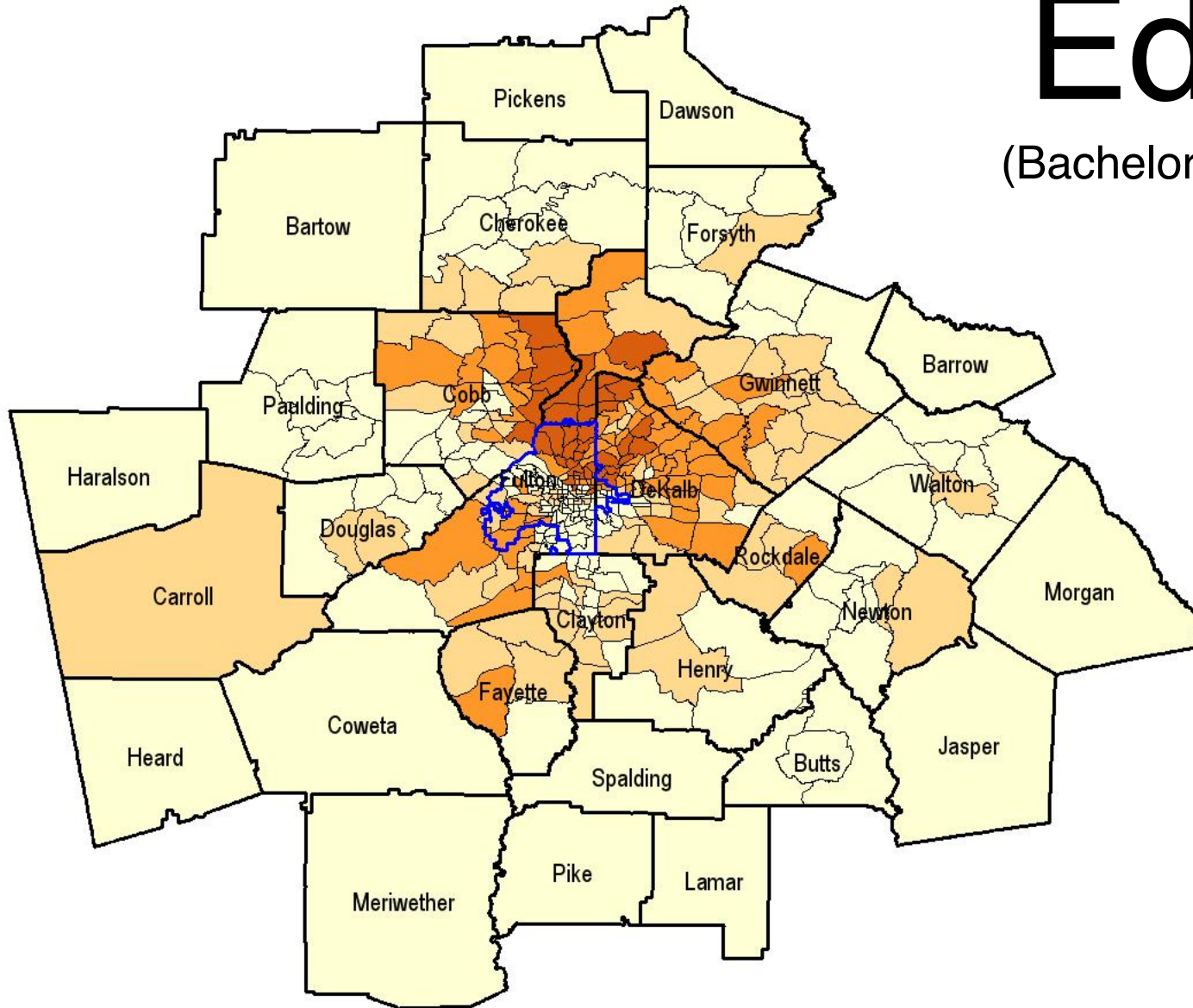


Percent Population of Age 25+ with Bachelor's Degree or More 1970

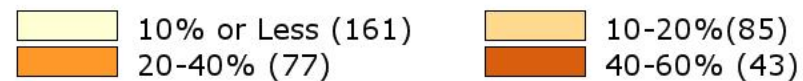

(Bachelor's degree or more, 1980)

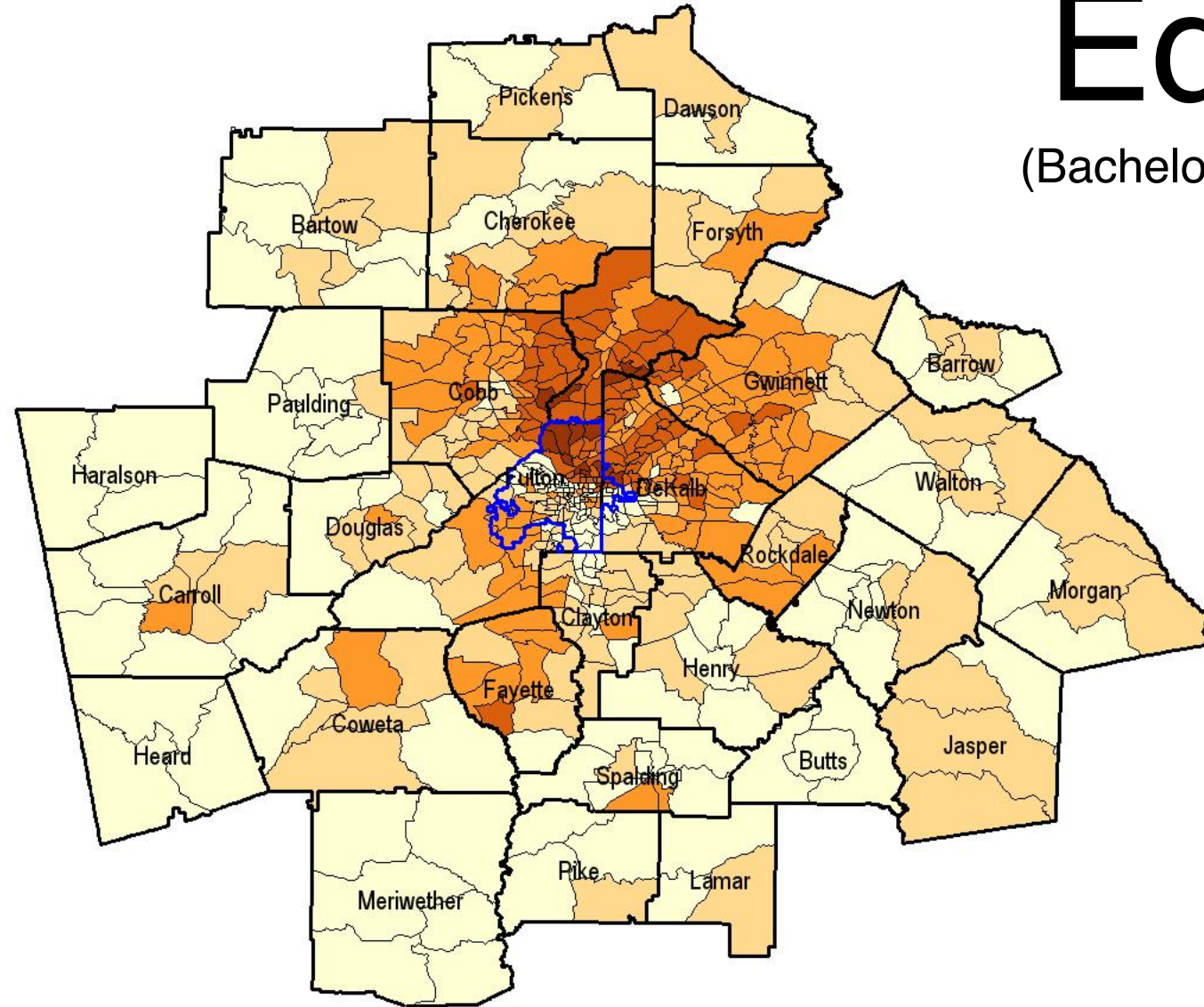


Percent Population of Age 25+ with Bachelor's Degree or More 1980

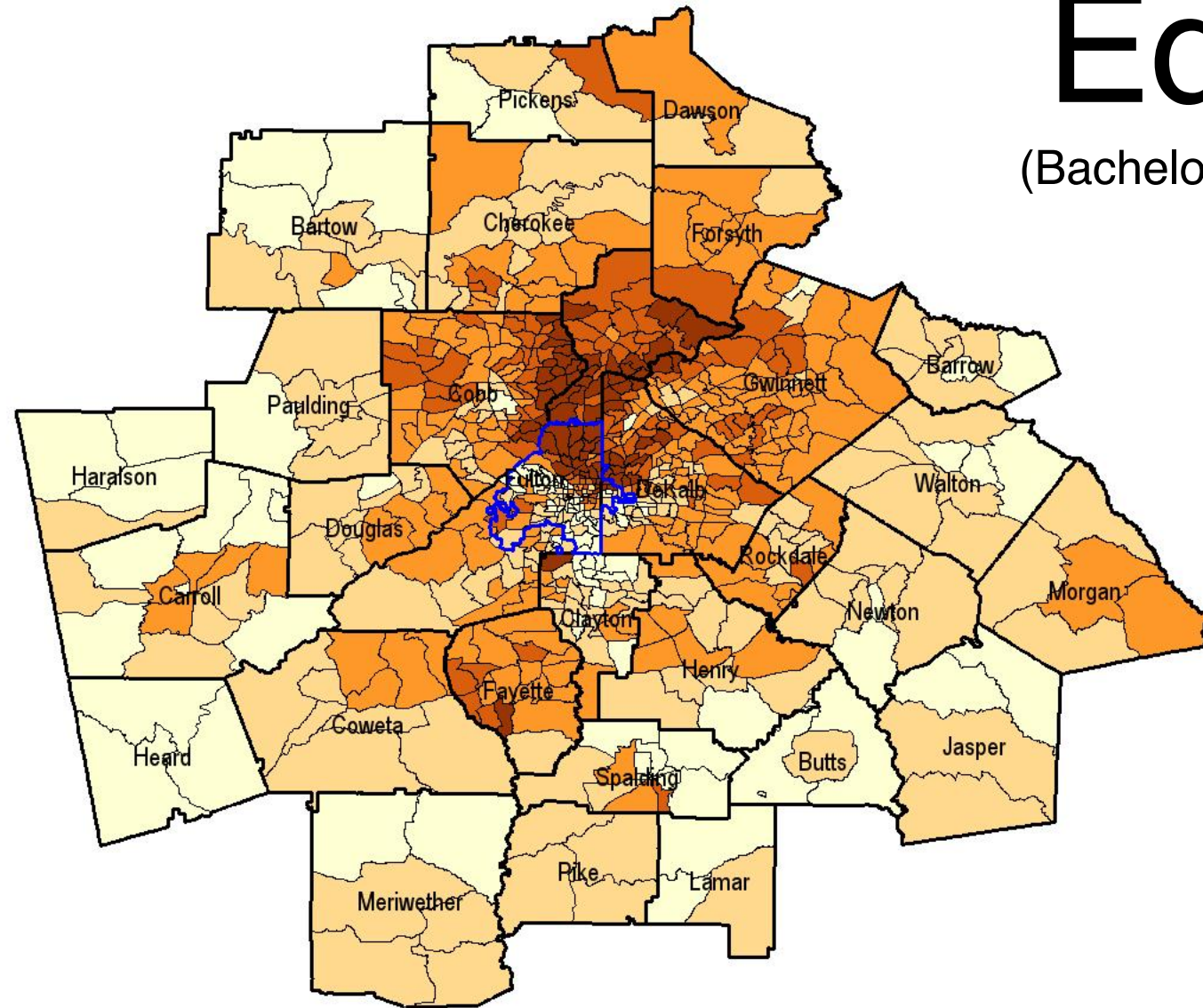


Percent Population of Age 25+ with Bachelor's Degree or More 1990

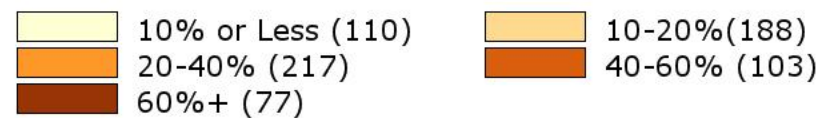

(Bachelor's degree or more, 2000)

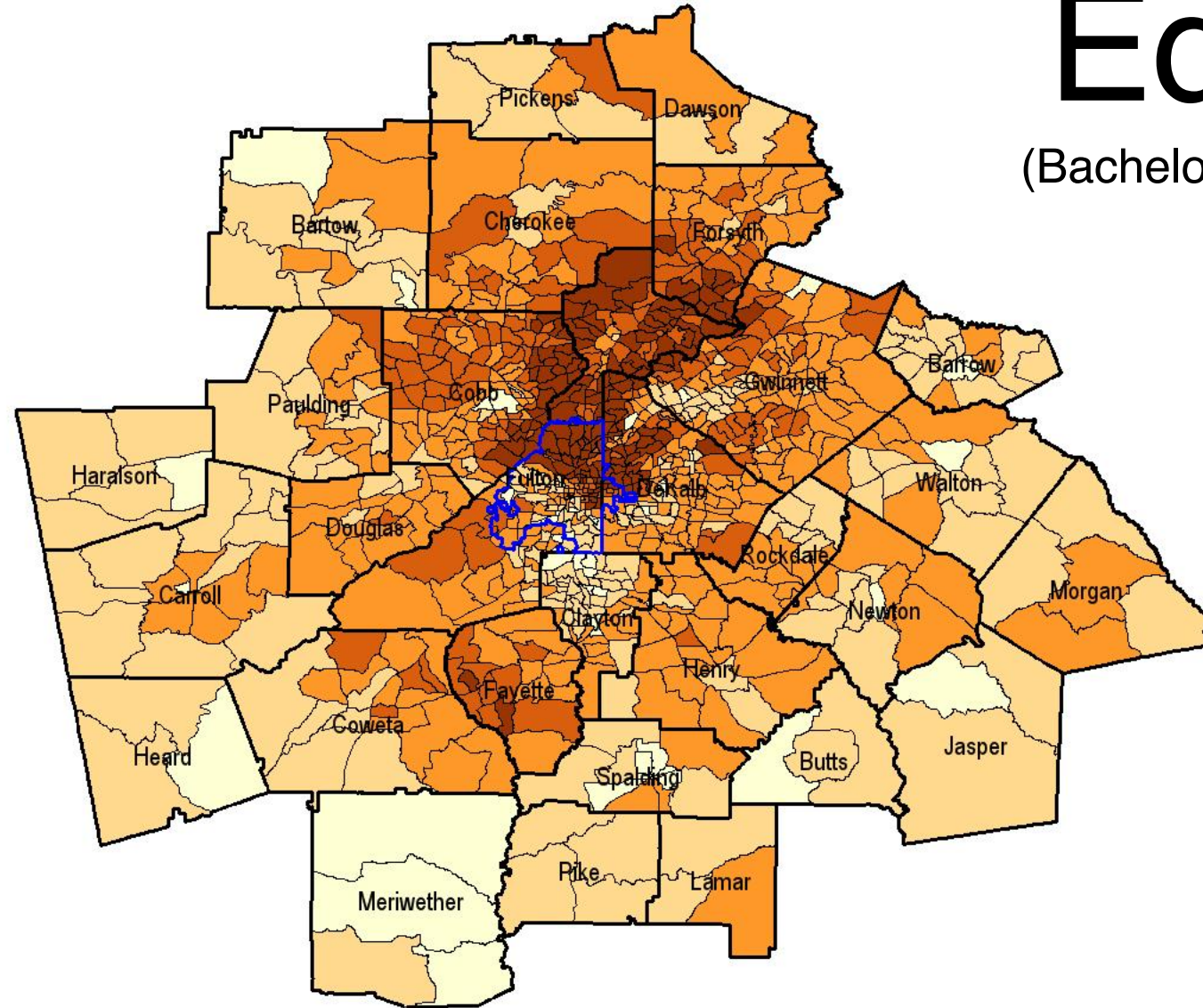


Percent Population of Age 25+ with Bachelor's Degree or More 2000
